BIDs through GeM portal are invited from reputed agencies with their <u>Registered/corporate Office</u> <u>anywhere in Bihar</u> providing Attendant/Office Boy/Gardener & Caretaker Services with at least Three years experience of providing Attendant/Office Boy & Caretaker Services to any Government organization /Public Sector undertaking of repute etc. Schedule for the tender process is as given below:-

Decision of the Corporation will be final, conclusive and binding on the bidders and the Corporation takes no responsibility for any delay whatsoever for submission of tender after the last date and time given in the schedule.

The Technical papers of the bidders will be evaluated on the basis of the following **five mandatory** conditions duly supported by the relevant papers: -

- 1. Bidder must be registered under Bihar Shop and establishment Act 1953.
- 2. Bidder must have registered / Corporate office anywhere in Bihar.
- 3. Bidder must have average annual Turnover of at least 1200 lacs in last three Financial Year (i e. 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25)
- The Bidder should have executed at least 3 number of projects with supply of 50 number of Manpower in each contract of providing Manpower for Office Boy / Attendant / Caretaker Services in last three Financial Year taking together (2022-23,2023-24 and 2024-25).

 Out of three as mentioned in serial no-4 there must be one existing work order as on 01/08/2025 for providing unskilled Manpower services in Bihar or Jharkhand.

After qualifying the above five mandatory conditions, remaining papers of Bidders as mentioned in Annexure "D" will be evaluated / examined.

PART B - GENERAL RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

- 1. Life Insurance Corporation Of India, Bhagalpur Divisional office (hereinafter referred to as "The Corporation") invites BIDs from reputed, licensed organizations / Agencies with their registered Office at anywhere in Bihar for Attendant/Office Boy & Caretaker Services for its premises at Divisional office and BOs SOs situated and Bhagalpur, Deoghar, Araria, Munger, forbesgani, Purnia, Gulabbagh, Katihar, Banka, Sahebgani, Godda & kishanganj with there SOs, under Bhagalpur Division (Please refer to scope of work herein below) for a period of 3 Years (Thirty six Months) from date of awarding contract extendable by one year depending upon the experience and at the discretion of Competent Authority of the Corporation and to the satisfaction of the Corporation.
- 2. Location for Attendants (unskilled) Services requirements are at Bhagalpur Divisional office and its Branches and SOs as mentioned for which requirement of Attendants/Office boys/caretaker/gardener is 100 approx. Corporation has the right to increase or decrease the requirement of Attendants / Office Boys / caretakers and also may decide whether Attendants or office boy or Caretakers services are required or not at any location.
- 3. LIC of India reserves the right to call for missing / additional requirements or otherwise from the applicant at the time of analysis of the technical bids received as per GeM in response to this notice.
- 4. The Bidders should be a registered body for providing Attendant/Office Boy & Caretaker Services having valid requisite license.
- 5. Bidder should have sound financial status.
- 6 Bidder should be a profitable Company.
- 7. Satisfactory service certificates must be enclosed from any one of the bidder's existing major clients in Bihar **having at least 50 man powers** with details of contact person, Telephone No. email etc.
- 8. The Bidders should ensure and confirm that they have the entire mandatory compliance certificates / registrations / license under various applicable laws including labour laws applicable for the state of Bihar. The Bidder shall ensure that none of his employees are paid salary / wages which are less than the prescribed amount under the Minimum Wages Act 1948 by the Government of India or by the State Government or any other Authority constituted by or under any law, whichever is higher, for the category of workers employed by them from time to time. The Bidder should comply with various provisions of Contract Labour (R & A) Act 1970 and Central Rules 1971 and other related Acts should enclose the copies of the following:



- License from Labour Commissioner to employ contract labour under the Contract Labour Act (R &A) ACT, 1970.
- Registration certificate under Employees Provident Act.
- Registration under Employees State Insurance Act.
- Latest Income tax clearance certificate, if any and PAN Card of the Contractor.
- GST registration Certificate.
- Copies of Audited Balance Sheets for the past 3 years.
- The average <u>Annual Turnover</u> during last 3(2022-23,2023-24,2024-25) years should be at least <u>Rs.</u> 1200 lacs per annum.
- NEFT details.
- Others.

The Bidder should not have defaulted in providing similar services and should not have been black-listed with any office of LIC of India or any other establishment on the date of submission of tender. The Bidders should have adequate resources for providing Attendant/Office Boy /Caretaker Services under jurisdiction of LIC of India, Bhagalpur Divisional Office.

- 09. The Bid shall be signed by a person or persons as authorized by the Bidder. In case, the Bidder is a Company, the officer authorized by the Company shall sign the Bid and affix the seal of the company.
- 10) While discharging the duties, the Bidder shall be responsible for any injuries to persons, damage to building structure, streets and footpaths and shall rectify it at his own cost.
- 11. Any Bidder submitting the tender shall be deemed to have read and understood the terms and conditions, scope of the work etc and quote accordingly.

PART C - GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- 1) None of the personnel deployed by the Bidder/Contractor shall indulge in any act other than that provided under this contract.
- 2) The Bidder/Contractor shall follow all prevailing rules / regulations / laws and should possess valid license for providing Attendant/Office Boy & Caretaker Services and shall take all safety measures for the personnel deployed by him. The Bidder/Contractor shall follow all the provisions of labour law and shall alone be responsible for any lapse in this regard.
- 3) The Bidder/contractor shall carry out the entire work having full regard to the safety of his own personnel as well as Corporation's staff and officers in the complex. All safe practices shall be strictly adhered to by the Bidder/contractor. The Bidder/contractor shall protect sides of opening in floor slabs, edges of slabs, stair, stairwells etc. with barricade, warnings signs / lights and educate all his workmen to follow safe working practices. The Bidder/contractor shall provide first aid boxes wherever required. Despite observing safe practices if any unfortunate incident occurs, the Contractor shall bear all expense or claims towards treatment or compensation.
- 4) The Corporation shall not be responsible financially or otherwise for any injury or death caused to any of the personnel of the Contractor during the performance of duties in the premises of the Corporation. The Bidder/contractor shall be solely responsible for providing compensation, if any and / or providing for expenses towards treatment for any injury or loss of life during performance of duties by the personnel deployed by him.
- 5) The Bidder/contractor shall not cause or allow any of his personnel to act in any manner, which may cause unnecessary disturbance or inconvenience to the Corporation, employees of the Corporation, owners / tenants / occupants of nearby properties or to the general public.
- 6) Nothing in this tender shall by implication or expression be taken to mean or imply that any of the persons deployed by the Bidder/contractor for rendering Attendant/Office Boy & Caretaker Services are employees of the Corporation or deployed by the Corporation. The Bidder/contractor shall deploy workers who shall be in his sole employment and he shall be solely and wholly responsible for their acts, salaries, wages, remunerations or any other statutory liabilities or other payments. Under no circumstances shall the Corporation be liable for any payment or claim or compensation (including but not limited to compensation on account of injury, death or termination). In case any liability falls on the Corporation for any reason, the Bidder/contractor shall keep the Corporation indemnified against the same. In order to give effect to this, the Contractor shall incorporate suitable clause in the appointment letters to be issued to his workers mentioning that the workers mentioning that the workers mentioning that the workers mentioning that the workers mentioning deployed by him, periodically as well as whenever necessary, at his own cost.
- 7) The Bidder/Contractor will be responsible for all members of the staff deployed by him and shall submit police verification of their antecedents. A certificate to this effect along with police verification report shall be furnished by the Bidder/Contractor to the Corporation before deployment of the staff. Further, in respect of the workers deployed at the Corporation's premises, the Bidder/Contractor shall submit details such as Names, appointment letters issued by the Contractor, age proof, address proofs & police verification

reports. The Bidder/Contractor shall ensure that the character and antecedents of the Attendant/Helper/Office Boy & Caretaker deployed by him are duly verified before such deployment.

- 8) The Bidder/Contractor shall be responsible for any loss due to theft / pilferage / damage caused in the course of performance of duties to the Corporation's property including fittings, furniture, fixtures or any other equipment(s). The Corporation shall assess the amount payable by the Contractor towards damages / loss / theft / pilferage and the same shall be recovered by the Corporation from the monthly payment to be made to the Contractor and or from security deposit.
- 9) The personnel deployed by the Bidder/Contractor must be healthy, neat and clean. They should display good conduct & courteous behavior. They should be in proper uniform and should be provided photo identity cards by the Contractor at his own cost.

In case of any complaint against any of the personnel deployed by the Bidder/Contractor, he shall remove such person immediately and arrange for replacement of removed person within 24 hours. The person(s) so removed should not be deployed again or allowed to work in the premises of LIC of India.

- 10) If the staff deployed by the Contractor is found to be indulging in any undesirable activities in the premises of the Corporation, the Bidder/Contractor will solely be responsible for all the consequences. Besides, the Corporation shall be at liberty to lodge complaints before appropriate authorities.
- 11) No residential accommodation shall be provided by the Corporation to Bidder/Contractor and / or to the personnel deployed by him.
- 12) The contract shall be for a period of <u>Three years initially</u>. However, the same may be extended by one year subject to satisfactory performance and approval of Competent Authority.
- 13) The Bidder/Contractor shall make payment to his personnel as per Minimum Wages Act only by electronic mode. Monthly payments to the Bidder/Contractor will be made only after submission of certificate mentioning names of personnel, amount paid, name of the bank and bank account number. The names mentioned should only be of those personnel who were actually deployed for providing Attendant/Office Boy & Caretaker service to the Corporation by the Bidder/Contractor. Any violation of the Minimum Wages Act will entail forthwith termination of the contract in addition to such penal consequences as may be deemed fit by the Corporation.
- 14) All work must be carried out to the entire satisfaction of the Corporation. If the standard of services is not maintained to the satisfaction of the Corporation, appropriate penalty will be imposed and the same will be deducted from the monthly bill and / or Security Deposit.

15) Personnel required:

Location for Attendants (unskilled) Services requirements are at Bhagalpur Divisional office and its Branches and SOs as mentioned for which requirement of **Attendants is 100 approx**, to carry out respective Attendant, Office Boy & caretaker jobs. Corporation has the right toincrease or decrease the requirement of Attendants / Office Boys / caretakers and also may decide whether Attendants or office boy or Caretakers services are required or not at any location. The Attendants or office boys or Caretakers so deployed by the contractor are expected to carry out Attendants or office boys or Caretakers job and other related Misc work as deemed fit by the Corporation.



Assessment of Attendants or office boys or Caretakers requirement is only to provide an equal footing to all the bidders so that they have equal weightage on this factor. This tender must not be construed as a tender for deployment of Attendants or office boys or Caretakers. It is also reiterated that this tender is inviting offers to providing Attendants or office boys or Caretakers services and not for deployment of Attendants or office boys or Caretakers.

- ii) The outsourcing of the Attendants, office boys or Caretakers is purely on temporary basis. The duty hours will be limited to <u>8 (eight) hours</u> for each Attendants/ Caretakers/ Office Boy. No Attendant/office Boy/ Caretaker should be permitted to work for two shifts continuously. No Attendants / Office Boys/ Caretakers will be permitted to work for more than **48 hours in a week**.
- iii) The Attendants office boys or Caretakers deployed by the Contractor are expected to provide services as per terms of the contract and their services may also be utilized for any other work related to Attendants and Caretakers such as meetings, conferences or any other day to day work in different department or locations in Bhagalpur and its BOs and SOs comes under the jurisdiction of Bhagalpur Divisional Office. In addition to the schedule of various activities that are required to be carried out as mentioned in Part D-scope of work, it should also be ensured that all the Attendants and Caretakers are available for carrying out any Attendants or Caretakers activities that may arise intermittently.
- iv) The Attendants/ Office Boys / Caretakers deployed by Contractor for required jobs should be of sound mind & major with <u>age not more than 60 years</u>.
- v) The average <u>Annual Turnover</u> during last 3 years (2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25) should be at least **Rs. 1200** LACS per annum.
- vi) If necessary, the Attendants / Office boys & Caretakers deployed by the Contractor may also be called upon to perform any other duties in addition to those explicitly stated in this tender. The Contractor shall ensure due compliance of such instructions, issued from time to time, by authorities of the Corporation.
- vii) Complete details of the Attendants/office boys & Caretakers deployed daily by the Contractor shall be maintained by Contractor and made available for verification as and when demanded by the Corporation.
- viii) The Contractor shall not deploy any relative(s) of any serving/retired/resigned/deceased employee(s) of the Corporation for providing Attendant/ office boys & Caretaker services.

16. Responsibilities of the Contractor will be as under: -

- i. To provide disciplined, courteous, trained and quality personnel ever ready to attend to their work politely.
- ii. The Contractor shall ensure excellent standards of service.
- iii. Attendants/office boys & Caretakers deployed by the Contractor shall be required to display their photo identity card issued by the Contractor.
- iv. It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to provide all benefits, remuneration & amenities prescribed under any applicable law to the persons deployed by him.

- v. The Contractor shall be responsible to maintain all Registers, Records and Accounts required for the compliance of any and all statutory provisions / obligations.
- vi. The Contractor should ensure that his employees do not smoke while working in the premises of the Corporation. They will also not indulge in drinking alcohol or any other intoxicants. They will not consume drugs and eat pan / khaini / tobacco etc. They will not play cards or indulge in gambling in the complex.
- vii. The Contractor shall comply with the feed-backs, if any, given to it by Official/s of Corporation at any point of time till contract exists.
- viii. All complaints received during normal working hours should be attended to as early as possible. No complaints should be left unattended / postponed.

17. The Contractor shall:

- ix. Provide proper neat and clean Summer and winter uniform at least one set every year during the contract period of two years to all the persons deployed by him for providing services and ensure that the same is worn by them during the course of their duties in the premises.
- x. Ensure immediate corrective action on receipt of any complaint against the services provided or against any individual deployed by him in the premises of the Corporation.
- xi. Arrange and pay for the Policy under the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991 and insure and keep insured all materials which are or have been declared to be hazardous under the notifications issued or that may be issued from time to time under the above Act or any rule framed there under.
- xii. Obtain Insurance Policy of adequate value in respect of all persons deployed by him for providing services, towards meeting the liability of compensation arising out of death, injury, disablement of work etc. and shall pay premiums regularly as when the same shall become due during the currency of the Contract.
- xiii. Be obliged to continue providing the services on the same terms and conditions as provided in the Contract, till such time as CORPORATION, is able to make any alternative arrangement or CORPORATION has agreed in writing to allow the Contractor to discontinue earlier.
- xiv. Comply with the instructions issued by the authorities of the Corporation from time to time relating to the performance of the services, duties and obligations. The services rendered by the Contractor shall be subject to regular review by the Corporation and its decision as to the quality thereof shall be final and absolute.

 - 18. Nothing in this tender shall be deemed to create any Partnership, Joint Venture, Agency between CORPORATION and the Contractor or their representatives and employees and nothing herein shall deem to confer on any party, any authority to incur any obligation or any liability on behalf of the other party. The Contractor is an independent entity and not an employee, agent, associate or authorized representative of Corporation. The Contractor is not authorized to undertake any obligation or liability in the name of or on behalf of Corporation what so ever.
 - 19. The Contractor & the workers deployed by him at the Corporation's Premises shall maintain confidentiality of any information in their possession during their deployment in the premises of the Corporation & thereafter.
 - 20. In case the Contractor fails to fulfill his obligations for any day to the satisfaction of the Corporation, for any reason whatsoever, the Contractor shall pay damages commensurate to the nature of loss / damages from a minimum of Rs.2000/-(Rupees Two thousand only) per day to any appropriate amount depending upon LIC's discretion for the entire number of such days and Corporation shall without prejudice to their rights and remedies including termination of Contract, be entitled to deduct such damages from any amount payable to the Contractor.
 - 21. Upon expiry of the Contract or termination of the Contract, the Contractor and his Attendants /office boys & Caretakers shall vacate the premises and handover the same in good working condition.

22. The bidder is required: -

- To enclose photocopies of the following documents duly self attested along with the Technical Bidsfailing which their bids shall be summarily rejected.
 - a. Registration certificate with Labour Department under contract labour (R &A) act 1970
 - b. Copy of PAN/GIR card
 - c. Copy of Income Tax Returns filed for the last three financial years
 - d. Turnover Certificate from chartered accountant for last 3 years
 - e. Copies of EPF certificate
 - f. Copy of ESI certificate
 - g. Copy of GST Registration
 - h. Copy of Registration under Bihar Shop and Establishment Act 1953.
 - Audited Account statement like Profit & Loss A/C and Balance sheet for last three years (2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25) for average turnover should be at least Rs. 1200 lacs per annum.
 - j. Certificate for Registration of firms
 - k. Proof of registered / corporate office in Bihar.
- 23. The bidder shall give an Affidavit on stamp paper of appropriate value that they are complying with the provisions pertaining to various Acts as amended from time to time as mentioned below. It will be the sole responsibility of the Contractor to abide by the provisions of the following Acts as to the workers deployed by him for performance of the service.
 - a] Child Labour Abolition & rrehabilitation Act,2006
 - b] Workmen Compensation Act 1923
 - c] Labour & employment Act 1972

- 24. The bidder will discharge all legal obligations in respect of wages of his personnel and their service conditions & shall comply with all the rules & regulations & provisions of Law in force that may be applicable to them from time to time viz. statutory obligations under Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act 1970, Minimum Wages Act, Workmen Compensation Act, EPF & MP Act, Industrial Dispute etc. The Contractor will indemnify & keep indemnified the Corporation from any claim, loss or damage that may be caused to the Corporation on account of the failure of the Contractor to comply with his obligations under the various laws towards the Attendants, Office boys and Caretakers deployed by him for any loss or damage to the Corporation due to the acts / omissions of Contractor.
- 25. All the bidders shall execute and submit Integrity Pact as per Annexure A as and when required.
- The bidder should neither be a sub-contractor to any other entity / person, nor should, at any time, sub- let to any other person, the contract awarded to him. He should not be a party to any cartel at any time for processing any contract including the present Tender.
- 27. The bidder shall submit only one tender either by himself or as a partner in joint venture or as a member of the consortium. If a bidder or if any of the partners in a joint venture or any one of the members of the consortium participate in more than one bid, their Bids are liable to be rejected.

28. PAYMENT TERMS:

The billing and payment will depend on actual number of personnel deployed and actual number of working days and their stipulated minimum wages, according to the respective category.

The Contractor will be paid on monthly basis by NEFT / RTGS only for the services rendered during the particular month for which he shall submit the bill for the agreed amount latest by 7th of the following month along with Proof of remittance (copy of challan) of EPF, ESIC of the previous calendar month along with list of employees for whom the amount stands remitted. The list shall mention all the particulars like name of Attendant and Caretaker, amount credited (With bifurcation like BASIC+VDA+ EPF + ESIC+ BONUS as per bonus act + STATUTORY payment), Bank name, Bank Branch and bank account number.



The Corporation reserves the right to withhold bills if the contractor fails to produce the proof for having remitted the ESI/PF dues.

The Contractor shall disburse the minimum wages (in vogue as on date of payment of wages) to Attendants and Caretakers/Gardeners by electronic mode only.

- TDS at the prevailing rates will be deducted.
- The Contractor shall alone bear all taxes, rates, charges and levies or claims whatsoever as may be imposed or levied by the State/Central Government(s) or any local body or authority for and in connection with rendering services except Goods and Services Tax (GST) raised by Contractor in the monthly bill & same will be paid by Corporation along with the other agreed charges for the services of Attendants and Caretakers.
- All the taxes which the Corporation may be liable to deduct or called upon to so deduct, during the currency of the Contract which are liable to be paid by the Contractor under the law, if not paid, shall be set-off against the bills raised by the Contractor and paid to the respective government department(s) or authorities as may be required under law and the Contractor shall have no claim / objection in respect of any or all such payments.

29. TERMINATION:

Corporation reserves the right to cancel or terminate this contract / agreement by giving one month's notice in writing without giving or assigning any reasons whatsoever for doing so. In the event of the Contractor wishing to terminate this Contract, the Contractor shall give at least three months notice to Corporation in writing.

In the event of earlier termination of the Contract by either parties or on expiry of the contract, the contractor shall be obliged to continue providing the services on the same terms and conditions as provided in the Contract, till the Corporation is able to make alternate arrangements for Attendants Office Boys and Caretakers services, even if Corporation has agreed in writing to allow the Contractor to discontinue earlier.

The contract is also liable to be terminated by the Corporation if:

- a. The Contractor abandons the work or
- b. The Contractor assigns or sublets the work in whole or in part thereof or
- c. The Contractor makes default in proceedings of the work under the contract, at any time during the contract period, with due diligence and continues to do so even after a notice is issued by the Corporation or
- d. The Contractor becomes bankrupt or insolvent or goes into liquidation or is ordered to wind up or has a receiver appointed on its assets or
- e. The Contractor persistently disregards the instructions issued by the Corporation or
- f. The Contractor fails to adhere to the agreed schedule of the work or
- g. The information submitted by the Contractor in the Tender is found to be incorrect or
- h. The Contractor fails to perform its obligations as per terms and conditions of the contract or
- i. The Contractor fails to maintain records / registers as required under the terms of this contract.

30 DISPUTES & DIFFERENCES:

- i) In case of any dispute between the Agency and Corporation, the Corporation shall have the final authority to decide.
- ii) The matter will be referred to the Senior Divisional Manager, L.I.C. of India, Bhagalpur Divisional Office and its decision shall be final and legally binding on the contractor.
- iii) All disputes shall be settled within the territorial jurisdiction of city of Patna (Bihar) only.

31. SECURITY DEPOSIT:

The selected Contractor will have to remit security deposit of 5% (valid till expiry of contract which may change as per Gov. and LICI Circular time to time and if it increases balance will be deposited by the Contractor) of estimated value of the contract. The amount will be kept interest free with the Corporation for the entire period of the contract. The Security Deposit shall be refunded with in a period of two months from the date of expiry or termination of contract (whichever is earlier) provided there are no defects or loss or damage caused to the Corporation. In case of defects or loss or damage caused to the Corporation, the same shall be recovered from the Security Deposit and balance, if any, shall be refunded without interest to the contractor.

33. PROVISIONS OF SECTION 33(3) and 33(4) OF THE INSURANCE ACT, 1938 AS AMENDED BY THE INSURANCE LAWS (AMENDMENTS) ACT, 2015:

In terms of provisions of Section 33(3) of The Insurance Laws (Amendment) Act, 2015, the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI), is authorized to verify such books of account, registers, other documents and the data base in the custody of the Contractor in respect of services outsourced by the LIC of India. It shall be the duty of the Contractor to provide such documents / statements/ information as may be required by IRDAI within such time as may be specified by IRDAI.

In terms of provisions of Section 33(4) of The Insurance Laws (Amendment) Act, 2015, the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI), if it considers expedient to do so, may direct any person hereinafter referred to as "Investigating Officer", to make an investigation as specified under Sec.33(1) or carry out an inspection as specified under Section 33(2) of The Insurance Laws (Amendment) Act, 2015, who may examine on oath any Manager, Managing Director or Other Officer of the Contractor or agency where the services are outsourced by LIC of India.

WHEREAS the BIDDER/Seller/Service Provider is a private company/public company/Government undertaking/partnership/registered export agency, constituted in accordance with the relevant law in the matter and the BUYER is performing its function under the LIC Act 1956.

To avoid all forms of corruption by following a system that is fair, transparent and free from any influence/prejudiced dealings prior to, during and subsequent to the currency of the contract to be entered into with a view to:-

Enabling the BUYER to obtain the desired said stores/ equipment/ item/service at a competitive price in conformity with the defined specifications by avoiding the high cost and the distortionary impact of corruption on public procurement, and

- 1.1 The BUYER undertakes that no official of the BUYER, connected directly or indirectly with the contract, will demand, take a promise for or accept, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, consideration, gift, reward, favour or any material or immaterial benefit or any other advantage from the BIDDER, either themselves or for any person, organization or third party related to the contract in exchange for an advantage in the bidding process, bid evaluation, contracting on implementation process related to the contract.
- 1.2 The BUYER will, during the pre-contract stage/evaluation stage, treat all BIDDERs alike and will provide to all BIDDERs the sam information and will not provide any such information to any particular BIDDER which could afford an advantage to that particular BIDDER i comparison to other BIDDERs.

- 1.3 All the officials of the BUYER will report to the "Chief Vigilance Officer" of the Buyer any attempted or completed breaches of the abov commitments as well as any substantial suspicion of such a breach.
- 2. In case any such preceding misconduct on the part of such official(s) is reported by the BIDDER to the BUYER with full and verifiable facts an the same is prima facie found to be correct by the BUYER, necessary disciplinary proceedings, or any other action as deemed fit, including crimin proceedings may be initiated by the BUYER and such a person shall be debarred from further dealings related to the contract process. In such case while an enquiry is being conducted by the BUYER the proceedings under the contract would not be stalled.

Commitments of BIDDERs

- 3. The BIDDER commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corrupt practices, unfair means and illegal activities during any stage of ir bid or during any pre-contract or post-contract stage in order to secure the contract or in furtherance to secure it and in particular commit itself to the following:-
 - 3.1 The BIDDER will not offer, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, gift, consideration, reward, favour, any material or immaterial benef or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any official of the BUYER, connected directly or indirectly with the biddin process, or to any person, organization or third party related to the contract in exchange for any advantage in the bidding, evaluation contracting and implementation of the contract.
 - 3.2 The BIDDER further undertakes that it has not given, offered or promised to give, directly or indirectly any bribe, gift, consideration, reward favour, any material or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any official of the BUYER of otherwise in procuring the Contract or forbearing to do or having done any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of the contract of an other contract with the government for showing or forbearing to show favour or disfavor to any person in relation to the contract of any other contract with the Government.
 - 3.3 Foreign BIDDERs shall disclose the name and address of their Indian agents and representatives in India, and Indian BIDDERs shall disclose their foreign BUYERs or associates.
 - 3.4 BIDDERs shall disclose the payments to be made by them to their agents/brokers or any other intermediary, in connection with this bid/contract.

5. Sanctions for Violations:
