### • Vishwas Vision for Health Welfare and Special Needs - Project Krida-To make a basketball court, Project Vyayam – North Zone – Delhi DO III

Vishwas Vision for Health Welfare and Special Needs was formed in 2005 with a vision to ensure equal rights and opportunities to every individual irrespective of disability, gender class or caste. Vishwas Vidhyalaya is an Inclusive education school for underprivileged children. The school imparts free education to its 305 students. Around 18% of them are children with special needs. They have 45 staff members who are taking care of the inmates. Education and other activities are providing totally free of cost. They want funding for sports activities.

# Financial assistance of Rs.5,50,470/- has been provided for Project Vyayam -To make an outdoor gym unit.

#### • Seva Vahini Trust - South Central Zone – Udupi DO

Seva Vahini Trust, Koppa is engaged in imparting quality education to rural students who hail from poor economic back ground. At present they are running 4 institutions to cater to the educational needs of the poor students. Out of which, Navachethana School is for differently abled children. Total strength is 482 children as at 31.03.2022. They have requested funds for construction First Floor which will be helpful for the education and overall development of the special students.

Financial assistance of Rs. 25,50,000/- has been provided for construction of first floor of Navchethana Special Children School to provide a facility for learning through to academic classes, physiotherapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy etc. which are being undertaken every day for physically challenged students.

#### • Hyderabad Karnatka Disabled Welfare Society - South Central Zone – Raichur DO Smt. Ambubai Residential School for Blind Girls run by the Hyderabad Karnataka Disabled Welfare Society Kalaburgi provides free education, boarding and lodging facilities to 75 blind girls. The State Govt. is giving financial aid as food allowance to 50 students only and the rest of the students are taken care by the Management. There are 7 teachers and 2 non teaching staff. They are requested funds for construction of 06 class rooms measuring 17.09 \*12 sqmt i.e. plinth area of 152.06 sqmt at ground floor for primary classes which will help to accommodate more blind girls for imparting education.

Financial assistance of Rs. 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of 06 class rooms at ground floor for primary classes which will help to accommodate more blind girls for imparting education.

• Taljai Prathisthan Bahuddeshiya Sanstha - Western Zone – Aurangabad DO Taljai Prathisthan Bahuuddeshiya Sanstha Pangaon is established in the year 2000. The trust works for the neglected and poor people of the society. The main aim of the trust is development of the mentally challenged girls. The Trust has started Swaadhar Prakalp in 2008 for the development of the mentally challenged girls. Presently 110 special challenged students are taken care by the Trust under Swaadhar Project Swaadhar Matimand Mulinche Balgruh, Alni. The school is providing shelter to orphan special girl child. The school is proving education and training to these special girl students. All students are mentally challenged and orphans. The organization gives them free education.

Financial assistance of Rs. 24,99,650/- has been provided for construct five class rooms on the First floor of the building for training and special education to the mentally challenged student.

#### • Meerut Children Welfare Trust -North Central Zone – Meerut DO

Meerut Children Welfare Trust is a charitable organization registered as NGO with the UP Govt. to run special school for mentally handicapped children. They have established Disha School of Special Education in 1994 to meet the necessities of mentally challenged children. They are providing education and training to mentally challenged children. They are also providing Occupational training, Physiotherapy, Speech Therapy, Clinical Psychology, Music Therapy etc to them. The Society has requested funds for purchase.

Financial assistance of Rs 8,53,000 /-has been provided for purchase of small school vans on many route for transportation of mentally challenged children.

• Seva Trust for the Blind- Shree Renuka Yallamma Residential School for the Deaf- South Central Zone – Dharwad DO

Seva Trust for the blind has been conducting a residential school for the Deaf and Blind Children (Hearing and Visually Impaired) at Maruti Nagar, Ranebennur, and Haveri District. They are providing free education including accommodation, food and medical facility Currently, 165 students are receiving special and innovative education. 135 students are residing in the school hostel and remaining 30 students are day scholars, coming to school from far away rural places. These day scholar special children travel from remote villages to the school and back by a school bus being used since 2007. They are providing free bus facility (in small bus) in 16 seater vehicle to 30 students from rural areas that are from below poverty line. Now they are in need of a new school bus in place of the old one for the safe and convenient commutation of 30 students coming from remote rural areas.

Financial assistance of Rs 15,42,180/-has been provided for purchase of School Bus in place of the old one for the safe and convenient commutation of 30 students coming from remote rural areas.

#### Aadarana – South Central Zone - Secunderabad DO

Presently Aadarana has about 100 children of different ages studying in different classes. Aadarana provides them food, shelter and education besides clothing and other accessories needed. All these children made Aadarana their Home and feel very happy to be inmates of Aadarana. Aadarana' also has established a free school not only for its inmates but for other deserving and needy day scholars too. The school has about 15 highly qualified and experienced teachers, a Principal and Vice Principal to look after the administration. There is a bus and a van to transport students from far-flung distances. As a number of children at their Centre are high, they have requested funds for purchase of School Bus.

• Financial assistance of Rs.25,49,553/- has been provided for purchase of School Bus which could provide comfortable commutation of children from their homes to School every day.

• Bannu Arogyada Seva Society -South Central Zone – Warangal DO Bannu Neuro Health and Rehabilitation Institute is a day scholar programme established with a motto " One world for everyone with zero fee, wherein they provide special education, early intervention, physiotherapy, & speech therapy, extra cultural activities like sports and dance, life skills, vocational skills like crafts, candle making, divas designing etc. Currently, the school has 125 students with Intellectual disabilities. There are 34 full time staff members. Bannu Arogyada Seva Society is providing service in the field of Social play groups, Physical occupational and speech therapy, Sensory integration, Behaviour therapy, Goal and objective development, Social Work-Support, Individual and group counseling, support for transitioning to school. Currently the school has 3 old buses purchased during the start of 2014 which needs complete set of repairs due to continued usage.

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• Financial assistance of Rs 23,78,000/- has been provided for purchase of Bus.

#### • Srotoshwini Trust, Vadodara - Western Zone- Vadodara

Srotoshwini Trust, Baroda was formed in 2006, registered in 2010 with motto of spreading Bengali Culture. The members had been performing musical shows, plays and dance shows at Kamatibaug Amphitheatre, Sayajinagari Gruh, and CC Mehta Auditorium and at different Durga Puja gatherings.•Srotoshwini Trust is providing education to underprivileged people of rural area of Vadodara. They established informal schools at three locations. These schools called Pathshala.

Financial assistance of Rs24, 77,301/- has been provided for purchase of school bus for students to travel to Baroda for taking part in sports tournaments, education excursions, and dance and drama performance.

#### • Avishkar Shikshan Sanstha -Western Zone – Nashik DO

Avishkar Shikshan Sanstha is registered in April 1999 under Mumbai Charity Commissioner at Nashik under MPT Act 1950. The Trust has started an "Experimental School" Anand Niketan in 1998. It is a Marathi medium school running without Government aid or support of any funding agency. Now there are 523 students from Pre-primary to X and 40 devoted teachers are working in school.

Financial assistance of Rs. 22,24,319/- has been provided for purchase of bus for transporting the students of Anand Niketan School &Nashik Municipal Corporation students to Dr Kamla Sohonie Vidyan Kendra (Science Centre) for Science Workshop round the year & field visits by Anand Niketan School as an integral part of pedagogy/ learning mode.

• Ved Vignan Mahavidya Peeth (VVMP) -Udaan–Purchase of 25 seater bus for education activity for children of the sex workers. – East Central Zone\_ KMDO II

Project Udaan, under the VVMVP has been working for the children of the sex workers of Sonagachi, Kolkata for the past ten years. The Organization is actively involved in rehabilitation of the girl children of sex workers. At present there are about 27 girl children residing in the centre. LIC GJF had already funded for Construction of dining hall/recreation room on Ground Floor of the Hostel building for rehabilitation of the children of sex workers in 2018-19.

Financial assistance of Rs 20,38,900/- has been provided for purchase of Star Bus 8KL 25+A+D, L P410/22

Ramakrishna Mission - Vidyapith, Purilia -Improvement & renovation of Toilets - Eastern
Zone –Asansol DO

The Ramakrishna Mission Vidyapeet, Purulia, was established in the year 1957 with the object of giving a practical and concrete shape to some of the educational ideas of Swami Vivekananda.Education, in order to be effective and fruitful, must bring about total and integrated development of the personality of the students. This can be achieved only when the students are brought up in surroundings where their body, mind and spirit can be looked after in a congenial environment. The Vidyapeet has adopted theancient Gurukula system of education system, prescribed by Swami Vivekananda adapted to modern conditions of life. The proposal is for renovation/repair for 4 toilet blocks in 4 sadans of Vidyapeet premises and each toilet block consisting of 4 toilets, totaling 16 toilets for resident students.

Financial assistance of Rs 43,19,917/- has been provided for renovation and repair of 4 toilet blocks each in 4 sadans of Hostel Building, totaling 16 toilets for the use of resident students.

• Service Agency for Rural Women and Children – South Central Zone-Bangalore DO II Service Agency for Rural Women and Children (SARWC) Society aims to rehabilitate and reintegrate both physically and mentally disabled people in the Kolar District of Karnataka. SARWC is running Ashakirana Mentally Challenged Children School at Mulabagilu taluk, Kolar District, Karnataka. 104 mentally challenged people are studying in this school. Out of that 53 children's are residential and 51 children are non resident day scholars They have been running a

special residential school for mentally challenged poor and orphan children since 22 years in Kantharaja circle of Mulabagilu taluk. They have rehabilitated more than 500 mentally challenged children since their inception. Since 22 years, they have been facing acute problems for commutation of children and therefore, are hiring Auto –Rickshaw/Mini Bus. These severe mentally challenged children are incapable of expressing their emergencies towards nature's call and soil the vehicle. Hence most of the times, autos/mini buses are also not willing to cater to these children.

Financial assistance of Rs 21,26,474/- has been provided for purchase of School Bus.

 Prerana Special School of Multipurpose Society–Purchase of School Bus- Western Zone – Nagpur DO

The school is situated in Ghorad Village in Nagpur District of Maharashtra and is run under the aegis of Prerana Multipurpose Society which is completely of charitable nature. The school takes proper care of intellectually challenged kids in the neighbouring villages since two decades. The school has recently been selected as one among the four special schools for intellectually challenged in Nagpur District by the Disha Project of the Government after considering 35 schools of its kind in the District. The Prerana Multi Purpose Society is in need of a Bus or Multi Purpose Vehicle for collecting students of their special school from nearby villages and to drop them back in the evening.

Financial assistance of Rs 20,01,516/- has been provided for purchase of Force Motors School Bus.

 Shri Guru Gobind Singhji Welfare Trust-Shri Dashmesh Jyot School & Junior College-Western Zone – Nanded DO

Shri Guru Gobind Singh Ji Welfare Trust is running the Dashmesh Jyot English Medium School which was started to provide quality education in English Medium to the weaker sections of the society. The school provides education to children from BPL and other families. They are having more than 1000 students currently and they aim to add more admissions in each passing year. For this constant expansion, they require more busses to bring students from long distances. The trust provides better educational facilities and value based quality education as prescribed by CBSE.

### Financial assistance of Rs 26,78,552/- has been provided for school bus.

#### <u>2022-23</u>

#### The Gregorian Community, Roha -Western Zone, Thane DO.

The Gregorian Special School at Gregorian Community, Roha was initiated with a vision to empower intellectually disabled children and help them to become socially integrated and function as independent adults. Besides, the Gregorian Community also runs the Gregorian Public School affiliated to CBSE which started in the year 2007. The Gregorian Shelter Home set up in 2006 in Roha provides food, medical facilities and all basic requirements to the old aged inmates.

Financial assistance of Rs 24,49,202/- has been provided for purchase of occupational therapy tool, audio visual equipments and Mahindra Bolero vehicle for rehabilitation and transportation of specially abled children.

• Ashadeep Day Care & Rehab Centre for Mentally Disabled - Eastern Zone - Guwahati DO

Ashadeep's Day Rehabilitation Centre which has been serving children and adults with intellectual disabilities and those recovering from mental illness at Guwahati for the last 25 years is operating from rented premises. A component of another initiative Home Again/Shared Home for homeless persons with mental illness also requires permanent accommodation. To facilitate permanent infrastructure for these two services of Ashadeep,



they are proposing to construct a building on a plot donated by Shri Ajit Narayan Kachari. Financial assistance of Rs 23,90,703/- has been provided for Construction of 5 class rooms and a common hall in the Ground Floor for their rehabilitation centre for specially abled children.

• Rajasthan Mahila Kalyan Mandal Ajmer – North Zone, Ajmer DO.

Rajasthan Mahila Kalyan Mandal, Chachiya was working in the field of community development and disability since last 46 years to empower persons with disability. They provide services like education, therapeutic interventions, mobility aids & appliances, advocacy, mental health & livelihood through vocational training focus on skilling up PWDs so that they can live dignified lives. Now there are 65 children from nearby rural areas and villages who need conveyance services to attend school regularly.

Financial assistance of Rs 18,68,600/- has been provided for purchase of school bus 31+D seater for transportation of mentally challenged children.

• The Leprosy Mission Trust India – Wellesley Bailey Vocational Training Centre, Motinagar-North Central Zone, Faizabad DO.

The organization provides free accommodation facility for children affected with leprosy and disabilities who are pursuing their vocation training. It has been reported that there is seepage from the Hostel roof, walls are damp and water is dripping at multiple locations. Ceiling plaster is falling at several places. The proposed project aims for a safe and dignified stay for the children by carrying out repair works which include water proofing of boys' and girls' hostels, repair of fallen roof, plastering of hostels' painting. The new hall near the girls hostel will be used for recreation for girls. This will be used for the girls to play indoor games and watch TV and read magazines and newspapers.

Financial assistance of Rs 12,97,765/- has been provided for Renovation of existing building and construction of one hall attached with girls hostel building.

Jnana Vikasa Education Trust, Mandya- South Central Zone, Mysore Division. Jnana Vikasa Education Trust started a Residential school for deaf and dumb children at Chinakurali Village, Pandavapura Taluk and Mandya District in 2003-04. This institution has been striving hard to bring consolation to the families of the poor children by providing free education with residential facility to 116 special children. They have about 40 day scholars who are commuting from the rural area of Mandya District. For transportation of the day scholars, trust has requested funds for purchase of school bus.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for purchase of School bus (46+A+D seater) for transportation of specially abled children of Chinakurali village.

• Bhagavan Sri Ramana Maharshi Asramam Trust, Anantapur- South Central Zone, Kadapa Division.

In 2008, The Raman Maharshi Ashram Trust started "Sri Ramana Maharshi Orphan School' and children were admitted to the primary school i.e std 1st to 7th. The school buildings, labs, library, dormitory sports facilities, kitchen and dining hall were all constructed to accommodate up to 100 students in the village of Avulappayyapalli four kms away from the center at Tadipatri. The school covers all expenses connected with education of the children and their welfare including boarding and lodging, stationary, text books, apparel and laundry, all personal maintenance items, health needs and medicines. Now school needs buildings for a high school including playgrounds.

Financial assistance of Rs 24,00,000/- has been provided for construction of one laboratory, one room and lab equipments in school building.

 Sri Shanimahatma Education and Charitable Trust, Tumkur– South Central Zone, Bangalore DO I

rural students of the surrounding areas and it also supports many underprivileged, economically deprived students to get quality education. They are facing difficulties to bring students from Pavagada to the campus which is approx 5 km from the main town. Hence they have requested funds for a 50 seater College bus for the smooth running of their transportation facilities.

Financial assistance of Rs 2500000/- has been provided for purchase of College Bus.

• Dr D S Erram Society for Physically Handicapped, Karad– Western Zone, Satara DO. Dr. D.S.Eram Society for Physically Handicapped works for handicapped students. The Organisation is active in the field of services to the differently abled children. The main objective of the Institute is to enable the deaf and dumb to acquire skills to enable them to stand on their own feet and live with self respect. The Mook Badhir Vidyalaya presently has students from rural and hilly areas from around 5 Kms from Karad Bus Stand. Sanstha requires a Bus to pick up and drop students from their homes and nearby students not staying in the hostel will be benefited.

Financial assistance of Rs 23,97,709/- has been provided for purchase of school bus for transportation of handicapped students from their homes to school.

Uddipan Educational Trust, Habra -Eastern Zone – KSDO Since 2009 Uddipan Educational Trust has been selecting and admitting economically under privileged families based on admission test result, door to door scrutiny of economic status and interview. The Trust is having 117 students studying in Class IX, X, XI and XII. The Trust provides subject wise coaching in the evening by 32 teachers and also provides all educational materials to students. Spoken English and computer awareness are offered compulsorily to all students. Music classes are conducted every Saturday and Sunday for deserving students. Motivational classes, Counseling sessions are arranged at regular intervals. The Trust also sponsors higher studies of students and regular coaching classes are arranged to prepare for competitive exams. Trust is proposing to construct Skill Development Institute for Women in a two storey building

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for Construction of Skill Development Institute for women on Ground floor.

 Ramakrishna Mission, Kamarpukur – Eastern Zone – Howrah DORamakrishna Mission Junior Basic School Kamarpukur is catering to the needs of the very poor as well as rural students of this area for many decades. Many of the students cannot even pay their nominal annual fees. There are 30 teachers & employees and 500 students and the existing toilets are in a dilapidated condition. It is highly called for to build two toilets (one each for ladies & gents). The RKM sought financial assistance for construction of two toilets in existing school building which will be a great help for school.

Financial assistance of Rs 8,83,000/- has been provided for Construction of two toilet blocks in existing school building at Kamarpukur.

• Mahesh Foundation – South Central Zone- Belagavi DO Mahesh Foundation is working for the welfare of HIV-positive and underprivileged children for the past 13 years. The foundation is providing shelter, nutrition, healthcare and education to HIV- positive and underprivileged children. During the last 13 years, 800 girls and 1200 boys have benefited from this care home. The Foundation had requested funds for construction of 2 class rooms at 3rd floor at an estimated cost of Rs 34 lakhs

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for Construction of two classrooms on the third floor for providing free education to HIV infected underprivileged children of Belagavi.

school has 36 students, 14 staff members to train these special children. The school imparts training for various vocations to these special needs children to enable them to contribute to their family and their lives. The School organizes health check-up camps conducted picnics, and creative exhibitions of handicrafts made by these special children at the school are also arranged. Children also participate in sports and one student; Arun Sharma, even got selected for Special Olympics to be held in Australia in October 2022 and represent their school on a global platform. Trust had requested funds for purchase of school bus.

Financial assistance of Rs 23,29,055/- has been provided for purchase of School Bus for ferry children from their homes to the school

#### • Carmel Jyothi Charitable Society – South Zone- Kottayam DO

Carmel Jyothi Charitable Society is functioning under the Congregation of Mother of Carmel. They had started with 8 students now there are 203 students. Out of this 110 students are residents and remaining 93 students are Tribals coming from their homes. The School is up to High Secondary level and the medium of instruction is Malayalam and the school is Coeducational. They are running a training institute for mentally retarded children. Majority of their students are day scholars. Society had requested for funds to purchase of school bus.

Financial assistance of Rs 27,03,500/- has been provided for purchase of School Bus.

#### • Shri Swami Samarth Seva Sanstha –Western Zone- Pune DO

Shri Swami Samarth Seva Sanstha Trust was established in 1991 to provide education to **Tribal students**. They started a girl's school in 1992 for the 10th fail students and for those who could not complete their education. In rural remote area due to non availability of Bus facility many students could not join / attend the school/ college .To overcomes this, the Trust felt the need of a Hostel for the needy students.

Financial assistance of Rs.25,00,000 has been provided for construction of Hostel Building (four rooms and ten toilets).

#### • Suganami School of Martial Arts Club - North Zone – Chandigarh DO Suganami School of Martial Arts (Club) has been setup in 1989 at Chandigarh to select children from poor families from different villages to educate train and take them to the level of Olympians. They are providing free education, boarding and lodging facility to such children. They are in need of a school bus for their upcoming sports academy named Shaheed E Azam. There are about 30 trainees who are all resident students to go to schools. They have requested funds for purchase of Bus which will be useful for inmates of the Residential Sports Academy and local children who join the academy can take advantage of the bus whenever they participate in various sports and other social activities.

Financial assistance of Rs. 28,00,402/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

#### • M.S. Chellamuthu Trust & Research Foundation - South Zone – Madurai

In 1995, M.S. Chellamuthu Trust had started Aakaash Special School with a spectrum of rehabilitation services for children (aged six years to 16 years) with diverse conditions such as mental retardation, autism and down's syndrome. They provide free special education, food, uniform, transportation, treatment and therapeutic services to 60 differently abled children coming from rural villages around Madurai district. They are in dire need of a 50 seater bus for Aakaash Special School a rehabilitation hub for mental health services, running from Chellamuthu Gardens Campus, Alagarkivil, Madurai, Tamilnadu.

Financial assistance of Rs. 24,06,800/-has been provided for purchase of school bus.

#### • The Spastics Society of Tiruchirapalli- South Zone – Thanjavur DO

The Spastics Society is providing day care and home management program for the children affected by cerebral palsy and also conducting rural camps & awareness program regarding cerebral palsy. Their services include physiotherapy, speech therapy and special education. They also provide free lunch for all the children and spend a huge amount towards training cost for a

child. The Society has requested funds for purchase of Tata Winger 13-seater vehicle which would be helpful in streamlining the work and coordinating with various programmes effectively. The Bus would be used to bring children from selected areas to school on a daily basis, take the staff to their branches for monitoring the activities there and also for conducting rural camps and awareness programmes.

Financial assistance of Rs. 16,14,436/- has been provided for purchase of vehicle.

#### • Rural Education Society, Patla - South Central Zone – Udupi DO

Rural Education Society, Patla founded on 30.11.1977 is running 3 schools and a Kinder Garten School for children aged between 4 to 6 years in Patla, a remote village in Udupi Taluk and District for imparting free formal and quality education to the students in deep rural areas. More than 400 students are studying in the schools. Most of the students are day scholars and coming from surrounding villages on an average distance of five kilometres. At present they reach school through an ad-hoc arrangement. Hence, the School has requested funds for purchase of School Bus for bringing poor children from their homes to the School and dropping them back home in the evening.

#### Financial assistance of Rs 24,88,227/-has been provided for purchase of school bus.

#### Shri Bharathi Vidya Samsthe (A unit of Dharma Chakra Trust)- South Central Zone – Udupi DO

Dharma Chakra Trust is providing education to poor students coming from rural area of Shimoga Dist. There are 275 students studying in Shree Bharthi Vidhya Samsthe, Uruvalu post and Village, Betthangady Taluk D. K. Dist. This area is coming under our Belthangady S.O area of Bantwal Branch. Students are travelling from remote villages like Barya, Kaniyooru, Mogru, Illanthila, Uruvalu, Karaya etc where about 25000 village house are inhabited, The Trust has requested funds for purchase of school bus which would help in solving the problem of travel of rural students from remote villages in reaching their school.

Financial assistance of Rs 24,21,878/-has been provided for purchase of School Bus.

#### • Karunasri Seva Samiti – South Central Zone - Hyderabad DO

Karunasri Seva Samithi provides education and vocational training to children coming from BPL families through Karunya Sindhu ashram at Krishana Nagar Colony, Saidabad, Hyderabad and Karunya Bharathi Ashram at Keshavgir, Chandrayangutta Hyderabad. More than 150 students have benefitted from stay, education, cultural values and settled in life. Most of them have done Diplomas and Graduation in Engineering and other streams. Trust had requested funds for purchase of school bus for students commuting from Karunya Bharathi Ashram to Sri Saraswathi Vidya Mandir Kandikalagate for studies.

Financial assistance of Rs 17,13,725/- has been provided for purchase of School Bus.

#### Sadvichar Parivar- Sadvichar Parivar Viklang Punarvasan Kendra, Uvarsad Gandhinagar - Western Zone - Gandhinagar DO

Sadvichar Parivar Ahmedabad has started residential school for physically challenged children in 1981 Sadvichar Parivar Viklang Punarvasan Kendra, Uvarsad Gandhinagar. The centre provides residential education and skill development training to these physically challenged children. They take care of 190 especially abled children from various villages in Gandhinagar District. They provide physiotherapy treatment at nominal charges of Rs 10/-per treatment, especially to people belonging to weaker sections of the society. The Trust wants to buy a Bus for ferrying people from surrounding villages for physiotherapy treatment to their physiotherapy centre and for use of Divyang Students to visit exhibitions, museums and other institutions, which would be helpful for patients and students.

### **Financial assistance of Rs 20,91,223/- has been provided for purchase of Bus.**

 Sarvoday Higher Education Society- Western Zone – Gandhinagar DO Sarvodaya Higher Education Society runs two institutes 1. S.D. Arts & Shan B R College Mansa

and 2) Sheth L.H. Science College Mansa. More than 3000 students enrol every year for various degree level courses in various steams like Science, Arts and Commerce. They are also planning to upgrade their existing traditional classrooms to smart class rooms, walk way etc. To reduce the electricity consumption and saving energy the Trust has planned to install two 20 KW solar power plants on their college building (Terrace of Library Building & S D Arts & B R Commerce College)

Financial assistance of Rs. 24,58,080/-has been provided for Installation of 2 Solar Plants Survodaya Trust - Western Zone - Thane DO

Suryoday Trust was established in 2010 and runs a school for intellectually disabled children in Nalasopara. The school, started in 2010, aims at providing quality education incorporating necessary therapies for development of these special children. The existing School has presently 46 special students and is functioning from rented premises. The Trust has planned to build a new school (G+3 Floor) at Bhugaon to educate 100 special children and start a vocational training skill centre for these special children

Financial assistance of Rs. 18,83,000/- has been provided for construction of administrative block with 610 sq ft carpet area on the ground floor

#### • Devrukhj Shikshan Prasarak Mandal - Western Zone – Kolhapur DO

Devrukh Shikshan Prasarak Mandal founded in 1927 and registered in 1952 is one of the oldest educational institutions in Konkan area of Maharashtra. The total strength is about 4100. The college has received "A" grade from NAAC and is the first autonomous college from Konkan region. The Institute is establishing Science innovation & Activity Centre. The Trust has requested funding of Rs 25 lakhs for construction of Exhibition Hall at Ground Floor (2340 sq.ft.) which would be useful for displaying permanent interactive scientific exhibits on Air, Space, Human Body, Ecology, Physics and Mathematics etc.

Financial assistance of Rs. 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of Exhibition hall at ground floor.

Ananda Margaa High School- East Central Zone -Cuttack DO

Ananda Marga School,Kalipur was established in 1991 and is a Pvt. Unaided Institution. It is located in a rural area in Sadar block of Balasore district of Orissa. Earlier the School was from Grade 1 to 7. At present, it is up to X std. The Institution promotes free education for 300 poor children from Class 1 to Class X and free residential facility to 50 students. The School is running from a dilapidated building on leased land for a period of 30 years from 10/02/2022 to 28/02/2056 on annual rent of Rs 5000/- The School has requested for funds for construction of single storey building having 6 classrooms, 1 hall, 1 common room, 1 Principle room, 2 Toilets, 1 store room, 2 Stairs, etc.

Financial assistance of Rs. 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of school building at ground floor.

 Centro Educador Society –Shiksha Sadan, Priol, Mardol -Western Zone –Goa DO Centro Educador Society is a premier education Institute in the state of Goa founded in 1929. The society manages four secondary schools & two village libraries in the rural areas of Ponda Taluka. Shiksha Sadan started its journey as a primary school during Portuguese rule in 1929 in a small hamlet in the village Priol. The school was subsequently upgraded to middle school and was called as Centro English School. After liberation of Goa the school was affiliated to Poona SSC Board and subsequently rechristened as Shiksha Sadan.

Financial assistance of Rs 23,96,000/- has been provided for construction of 2 class room at second floor, electrical fittings and for 40 benches to accommodate more students. 2021-22

• Udayan - Eastern Zone – KSDO

LIC GOLDEN JUBILEE FOUNDATIO

Udayan a residential centre for the rehabilitation of children of patients suffering from leprosy was founded by Revd. J.G.Stevens,OBE on March 25th 1970. Children at Udayan come from leprosy colonies in and around West Bengal, where their families suffer from leprosy and live in substandard, outcaste conditions. Udayan has provided all essentials of life safe shelter, wholesome food, clothes, medical care and opportunities for formal schooling, skill development, vocational training and higher education. All children are enrolled in regular local schools, whilst Udayan operates a primary school of its own where Hindi & Bengali are the languages of instruction. They are providing scholarship to children to attend college or vocational training institute. The Project Authorities sought financial assistance for purchase of school bus, as distance from Udayan to School is 8 kms and it is difficult to cover the same by walking to attend the school. The bus will support the children to go to school regularly.

Financial assistance of Rs 24,43,424/-has been provided for purchase of school bus.

#### • Ramakrishna Mission Sevashrama, Gerbeta - Eastern Zone – Kharagpur DO

Ramakrishna Mission Sevashrama, Gerbeta, a branch centre of Ramakrishna Mission, Belur Math, Howrah is carrying on education work, running medical units, doing cultural and social welfare service and charitable work among the masses in its Mission campus as well as in remote rural areas since 1915. This project aims at social and economic upliftment of children through quality education in an area which has good chunk of Tribal population and does not have educational institutions offering qualitative education at the foundation level (Nursery onwards). The Mission is running a school where 220 students are studying and fee is waived for 20 students. They have 10 teachers and other staff to provide education to all students. This project is to construct a building for an English Medium School to create a good learning atmosphere having 15 class rooms, 1 computer lab, one seminar hall, room for cultural functions, teachers' common room, store and two toilets in each floor. The project authorities sought financial assistance for construction of building at ground floor which could accommodate 600 children.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of ground floor.

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- Ramakrishna Mission Ashram, Rajahmundry South Central Zone Rajahmundry DO
- Ramakrishna Mission Ashram, Rajahmundry Mission is rendering charitable services for the last 60 years in various fields like Medical, Educational, Relief and Rehabilitation during natural calamities. They are running a charitable dispensary near Pushkarghat, Rajahmundry, treating around 250 patients every day at a nominal OP fee of Rs 20. The centre is equipped with diagnostic centre and all the tests are done at very subsidized rates. Medicines are distributed to the patients at 50% discount. In addition to the above centre at Rajahmundry. The Mission is also running a Mobile Medical Dispensary every Sunday at Sirigindalapadu around 7 KM from the agency area of Rampachodavarm. For this purpose, the Tribal Welfare Department, Government of Andhra Pradesh, allocated 7 acres land to provide free medical service to the tribal. RKM has developed necessary infrastructure and running the dispensary in the area of Dental, Medical, Ophthalmology and Physiotherapy. Around 250 poor and needy tribal from remote areas will be provided the above medical services totally free of cost. The dispensary is having diagnostic equipment viz, Pathological Lab, ECG, X – Ray and ultra sound scanning. After diagnosis, the patients will be supplied medicines free of cost. Every Sunday, 3 to 4 doctors along with 5 paramedical staff will be attending the dispensary. Ophthalmology patients who are identified for cataract operations are brought to Rajahmundry and the operation is performed totally free of cost. The project authorities sought financial assistance for purchase of Bus to provide conveyance to the Doctors and Paramedical staff to reach the remote tribal areas. The bus will be also used to bring the needy tribals for conducting cataract operations at Rajahmundry.

Financial assistance of Rs 17,51,906/- has been provided for purchase mini bus for the Dispensary.

Gramin Shikshan Prasark Mandal -Western Zone –Kolhapur DO

Gramin Shikshan Prasark Mandal, Kondgaon, was registered under Society Registration Act 1860 and Bombay Public Trust Act 1950 in 1992. The Trust has established "Shriman Tukaram Ganshet Gandhi Vidyalaya in 1992. The School is providing education up to Higher Secondary level. They have 249 students, 10 teachers and 3 non teaching staff. 230 students are coming from economically backward class (EBC). The school is not charging any fee from the 230 Students. The Trust is also running health centre, has conducted medical and education camps for the welfare of the poor rural people. The project authorities sought financial assistance for construction of four class rooms at first floor of the existing building to start Junior College in the same premises.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of Four Rooms at First Floor of the existing building.

#### Ramakrishna Mission, Kadapa – South Central Zone – Kadapa DO

Ramakrishna Mission, Kadapa has been running Sri Ramakrishna Balakashrama a free Students' Home, Vivekananda Vidya-Value Education programmes in schools and colleges of Rayalaseema region and also Prakasam, Nellore Districts, Training camps for rural youth in agriculture and allied subjects, Sabhangana for conducting various religious and cultural programmes. The

RKM, Kadapa is providing free medical aid through Ayurvedic, allopathic and homeopathic dispensaries thrice a week. They hold Workshop for teachers on value education, conducting English Speaking courses and provide meditation, Library and Reading room facilities. The project sought financial assistance for purchase of a school bus which will be useful to the poor students and also Balakashramam Semi Orphans for their educational tour etc.

Financial assistance of Rs 20,13,000/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

 Devbhumi Shiksha Prasar Samiti -Devsthali Vidyapeeth College of Pharmacy – North Central Zone – Haldwani DO

Devsthali Vidyapeeth, with a vision of "Carving future professionals with human values" is one of the prestigious professional institution of Kumaun Region of Uttarakhand State. The Institute, with its sprawling lawns, world class majestic buildings, class rooms, library, conference hall, auditorium and laboratories is ideally located in a calm, serene and healthy environment, near city of Rudrapur. Devsthali Vidyapeeth offers degree programs in Pharmacy, Bio-technology & Management i.e M. Pharm., B.Pharm., D.Pharm., M.Sc. (Biotechnology), B.Sc. (Biotechnology) and BBA. Majority of students belong to small farmer's family or labour class having very low income. Hence the Institute charges minimum fee from the students. The project sought financial assistance for construction of multipurpose hall on the second floor of the building which will be helpful for providing latest technology in Pharma Sector and organizing various conferences, meetings and seminars for poor students.

Financial assistance of Rs 20,00,000/- has been sanctioned for construction of multipurpose hall on second floor.

#### Satawali Panchkroshi Shikshan Sanstha- Western Zone - Kolhapur DO

The Satawali Panchkroshi Shikshan Sanstha (SPSS) Trust was registered in the year 1969 and the school was started in 1969 at village Satawali in Lanja taluka of Ratnagiri District, Maharashtra, which is a hilly and economically backward region. Children from Satawali and other neighboring villages are benefitted by the school. The school provides education to poor students of the area and so far nearly 1100 students have passed out from the school, some of them are doctors and engineers. Due to lack of transportation facilities, students studying in Satavali Panckkroshi

Shikshan Sanstha are facing difficulties to come to school which results in disruption of their education. The SPSS has requested funds for purchase of one school bus which will help in transportation of students to school easily.

Financial assistance of Rs 1342225/- has been provided for purchase of School Bus.

• The Bajaj Institute of Learning for Deaf Children - Deeds Public Charitable Trust - North Central Zone -Dehradun DO.

The Bajaj Institute of Learning (BIL) is an educational Institution in Dehradun. It was set up in Oct 1999 to impart education and vocational training to Deaf students, through the medium of Indian sign language. The activities in BIL are designed to nurture the talent and creativity of the Deaf students. This helps them to develop an all – round personality giving them confidence to face the world and become contributors in mainstream society. The emphasis is on providing free education vocational training and ensuring placements for the Deaf. The Institute sought financial assistance for purchase of School Bus for the use of deaf children to travel from Hostel to School and playground twice/ daily.

Financial assistance of Rs 18,55,000/- has been provided for purchase of School Bus.

Peoples Action for rural advancement and sustainability - Faizabad DO, North Central Zone. Peoples Action for rural advancement and sustainability (PARAS) Foundation was established in 2005 by local workers of PANI Sansthan in village –Jai Prabha Gram (Bhawaniyapur) post-Prikhauli Faizabad. The Foundation is working for rural women, marginal farmers, landless family, children and teenage girls in integrated approach of development. PARAS aims at strengthening capacities of people so that they are able to understand their own situations recognize their challenges and face them. PARAS foundation is running primary school from nursery to class VIII. They contact school dropout girls from different villages and motivate them to restart their education. They sought financial assistance for purchase of vehicle which would help them to reach interior locations of villages to provide education facility.

Financial assistance of Rs 17,71,000/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

• Vanavasi Kalyana ® Karnataka (VKK) - South Central Zone- Mysore DO.

Vanavasi Kalyana **(VKK)** was established in 1989 as a charitable trust for the comprehensive development of the Tribals of Karnataka. Trust was established with an aim to enable these tribes to achieve social inclusion, education, economic growth and stability while retaining their core values and social fabric. Vanavasi Kalyana **(VKK)** has taken initiative for educating tribal children by providing free hostel, education and healthcare facilities in various parts of Karnataka. Presently there are 8 hostels in Karnataka and around 200 students are availing free education and stay in these hostels. This is in addition to 243 home tuition centers (Mane Paata Kendra) because of which yearly around 7000 students are getting benefited. Vanavasi Kalyana, Karnataka has requested for funds for construction of Skill Development Centre on the second Floor of their existing building. This facility would be utilized for the overall development of tribal community living in Karnataka. Out of total population of 50 Lakhs in Karnataka, this project would provide access for education, health and skill development to around 6 to 8 lakhs tribals.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of 2nd floor.

#### • SKR Pupils Welfare Society - South Central Zone - Nellore Division.

SKR Pupils Welfare Society was established in the year 1999 as a Non-Government Organization with a noble concept to render all sorts of services to the disabled for their education, welfare and rehabilitation, running a special school for the deaf and Mentally retarded at Chimakurthy and Kanigiri. The institution functions with the objective to educate the hearing impaired and mentally retarded children in and around Chimakurthy Mandal and is being run successfully with the support of local influential people. The institution is being run in their own building. Presently they are giving free education from Class I to X to deaf and mentally retarded children with residential facility. To mobilize more children on Day scholar basis they required a Mini Bus so that more children could travel from the village for the purpose of education.

Financial assistance of Rs 8,23,440/- has been provided for purchase of Mini Bus.

#### • Sabitha Educational Society- South Central Zone- Secunderabad Division.

Sabitha Educational Society is a Nonprofit organization established by Sri S.Raju and Mrs Saritha to provide free special education & vocational training to rural, poor & deprived disabled persons. It was started with 6 children, and is now serving 70 children aged from 4 to 25 years. The society rehabilitates the mentally challenged and hearing impaired students to empower them to live independently and to familiarize their parents in regards to Govt policies and subsidiaries. Sabitha Society offers day school facilities, speech therapy, behavior modification, vocational training, physiotherapy and parents' counseling for the rural, poor and deprived disabled children. The Society requested for funds for purchase of Van which would be helpful to provide transportation facility to students.

Financial assistance of Rs 725,851/- has been provided for purchase of Van vehicle.

### Daya Special Children School, Capuchin Krishik Seva Kendra, Vimukti – South Central Zone - Udupi Division.

Capuchin Krishik Seva Kendra, rendering humanitarian service since 50 years in various Talukas of Karnataka. Its main aim is to uplift the most vulnerable children and women through education, organization and rehabilitation. With the help of donors they have started Daya Special School in 2017 with 15 students and within a year 45 children enrolled themselves and started availing the benefits. Currently 75 students are receiving special and innovative training in this school. It is reported that more than 700 children are affected by Endosulfan in this area and many differently abled children are not in a position to join this school due to transportation problems. The school is transporting the students by two existing tempo traveler buses which are insufficient.

Financial assistance of Rs 15,81,000/- has been provided for purchase of School Bus.

### • Karunya Special School and Rehabilitation Centre –South Central Zone - Udupi DO Karunya Special School and Rehabilitation Centre under Dr Shaina Memorial Trust was established in 2017 for providing academic classes, physiotherapy, speech therapy occupational therapy etc to intellectually deficient children of Udupi and surrounding areas. Karunya Special School and Rehabilitation Centre has requested grant for School Bus.

Financial assistance of Rs 17,10,000/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

Phondaghat Education Society Phondaghat – Western Zone - Kolhapur DO.

Phondaghat Education Society, Phondaghat (PES) was formed on 28.4.1952. The Society is now functioning in education sector, promoting Primary, Secondary and Higher Education in the rural area of South Konkan in Maharashtra. PES is providing the quality education to the students coming from rural, hilly region and socio-economically deprived, to make them self- confident and empowering youth, particularly women, to become socially responsible citizens and equip them to compete in a multi- cultural environment. They have proposed new construction of 7 classrooms in the area of 554.4 sq.mts. Costing of entire project is Rs. 81,49,360/-, out of which they sought financial assistance for 2 classrooms for an area of 157.32 sq.mt.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of two class rooms at the Ground Floor in a new Building.

#### • St. George Balikagram – Western Zone- Pune DO I

St. George Balikagram was formed in 1993 with an objective of helping the female children of leprosy patients coming from across the country towards their education. St. George Balikagram is working towards education and upliftment of female children of leprosy patients from the economically backward and weaker communities of the Society by providing them proper education. The institution takes care of these children up to their marriage and getting them settled in life. St.George High School is having around 1000 students from Nursery to Std.X. Children come from outskirts of Mamurdi Village. Over 50 female children of leprosy patients from 3 years to 18 years from various castes, religion and regions , not affected by leprosy are the inmates of this Balikagram who study in various classes from LKG to Std XII at St. George English School, managed by Balikagram. Free education is provided up to Std. X. Those who study in STD XI and XII are admitted to the nearby Junior College. The School had requested for funds to purchase one 38 seater Tata Star School Bus for travel arrangements for coming to school.

Financial assistance of Rs 23,00,179/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

#### • Amhi Sevak Sevalay – Western Zone - Aurangabad DO.

Amhi Sevak Sansthan, Latur founded the shelter home 'Sevalay' in 2007, a home for HIV infected poor children to provide such children with food, shelter clothing, medical treatment, education and normal life. Sevalay provides health care, education and residential facilities to 85 children living with HIV/AIDS since past 11 years. There are 15 teachers and staff to take care of these students and they are provided all services free of cost. All the students are between age group of 6-24 years. For primary and higher education students have to travel from shelter home in Hasegaon to different schools in Latur. Up to standard X, education is available near Hasegaon and the average distance is 2 Km. Higher / technical education is available only at Latur District level, which requires on an average 18 km travel from the shelter- home. Amhi Sevak Sevalay had requested grant for Purchase of School Bus.

Financial assistance of Rs 20,00,000/- has been provided for purchase school bus.

#### Jodhpur Adarsh Shikshan Sansthan, HO- Bhinmal – North Zone, Jodhpur Division.

Adarsh Shikshan Sansthan, HO- Bhinmal was registered in 1986-87 and has affective presence in Jalore District. Institute is presently running 31 Adarsh Vidhya Mandir schools across Jalore District. The Institute spreads quality education to inculcate patriotism, promote primary, middle &

secondary education, yoga & sports activities for all round development of students. They also conduct cultural & patriotic camps for weaker sections at free of cost. Adarsh Shikshan Sansthan has an affective presence in Jalore District. A new building is under construction which is 1.5 Kms away from the main village. After completion of the building, 8 villages would be benefitted. Hence, they have submitted a proposal for a school bus to be used for travel arrangements of students from nearby villages to come to school.

Financial assistance of Rs18,85,550/- has been provided for purchase of School bus.

#### • Ek Pahel -B.R. Memorial Welfare Society – North Central Zone, Agra DO.

Ek Pahel -B.R. Memorial Welfare Society was founded in 2009 by a team of youngsters in Agra who had the zeal to transform the lives of the less fortunate. EK Pahel believes that 'Quality Education' is a key to empower children and remove poverty in a single generation. With the aim to catalyze education among underprivileged children, they started a project called 'Prakashpunj'.Ek Phael is working for Improve the infrastructure of "Prakashpunj- Ek Pahel Pathshala" with special focus on Increasing the number of classrooms so as to run parallel classes for students of different age groups. Construct large play grounds, Construct hygienic washrooms, Start yoga classes for children, Facilities and equipments for outdoor sports, Arrange a van for providing pick and drop facilities to the students coming from far off places, Sponsor education of more number of high potential students in good recognized schools. Hence society has requested funds for purchase of school bus which will cater to children (500 approx) of weaker sections of the society to pick up & drop them from their home to school and vice versa.

Financial assistance of `22,03,820/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

• Keladi Vidya Samsthe – Bharathi High School – South Central Zone - Shimoga DO...

Bharathi high school Keladi was started in 1963. There was no high school education facility for the people of Keladi, Masura, Malve and Hirenellur gram panchayath range. At that time the children especially girls of economically backward families were out of high school education. Hence at bandagadde which was the centre for all these villages, Bharti High School was started by Keladi Education Society. Approximately 50 to 80 students are passing SSLC exams every year from this school. High School achieved 100% result in S.S.L.C this year. Under the scheme of AKSHARA Dasoha institute is providing mid day meal to students. School has 127 students and no fee is charged from the SC & ST students. There are 6 teaching and 1 non teaching staff. Salary of staff is given by the Government. Keladi Vidya Samsthe Bharathi High School has requested funds for construction of Laboratory and Library at ground floor of their building which would be helpful for education of rural children.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of Laboratory and Library building at ground floor.

 Trimurti Vikas Mandal- Trimurti Madhyamik Vidyalaya Shirvande –, Western Zone – Kolhapur DO.

Trimurti Madhyamik Vidyalaya Shirvande initially started classes in June 1993 in one of the villager's house. Now they have a school building consisting of 7 class rooms, science lab, gym, 2 bore wells and a big playground. Approximately 700 students have passed out after SCC since inception. They are not charging any fees from students and the aid received from Govt. is not

sufficient to pay salary of school staff and meet day-to-day expenses. The School is on the top of a hill and away from locality and is surrounded by jungle on two sides. There is always a threat of wild animals attacking students. Hence a compound wall of 830 running meters is being constructed around the school out of which 250 metres construction has been completed using local MLA/MP funds. They have requested funds of Rs. 23.06 lakhs for construction of compound wall for the remaining 580 meters.

Financial assistance of Rs 23,06,000/- has been provided for construction of compound wall .

#### • The National College, Jayanagar, Bangalore- South Central Zone - Bangalore DO I

National College, Jayanagar is one of the constituent colleges managed by NES of Karnataka and providing quality education at a nominal cost for nearly 60 years. The National Degree College, Jayanagar, Bangalore, an autonomous college, is one of the seventeen institutions, being managed by the National Education Society of Karnataka. The Society was established in 1917 with nationalist ideals as the driving force. The College was started in 1965 with strength of 110 in the Pre- University Course and it has now grown into a leading institution of higher learning in General Education. It has well equipped laboratories, a good computerized library and a vast sports field. Opportunities are provided to students to express their talents in Fine Arts and Popular Science. There are 966 students and 73 staff members including 49 teaching staff. They charge lesser fees from SC/ST students. College has requested funds for setting up of Computing and Collaboration Laboratory which will address the issue of skill development and making students industry ready. Financial assistance of `37,39,040/- has been provided for setting up Computing and Collaboration

Laboratory in National College, Jayanagar Bengaluru.

#### • Rural Development Trust (RDT) – South Central Zone – Kadapa DO

Rural Development Trust was established in 1969. Since inception, it has been striving for the integrated development of disadvantaged rural communities by implementing various programmes in the fields of Education, Women Empowerment, disability inclusive development, permanent housing, rural hospital and ecology and sustainable livelihoods. Currently it is operational in 3699 villages spread in the states of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. RDT had built 1,611 School building cum community centers, 79,065 permanent houses for the poor families and persons with disabilities, 26,766 Toilets under Swachh Bharat Mission, 126 Water supply projects, 16 Bridges & Causeways, 3,107 Water Conservation Projects. RDT has requested funds for construction of School Building cum Community Centers at five centres.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of three School cum community centers.

### • Shri Vivekananda Seva Kendra (R), Managuli- Vivekananda Residential School – South Central Zone – Belgaum DO

Shri Vivekanand Seva Kendra (R),Managuli was established in1988 to cater to the needs of economically and socially disadvantaged sections of the society and other destitute children including the Lambani Tandas. Kendra is running residential co- education school from classes 1st to 10th std. They got government aid up to 7thstd. School is providing free education for primary students and charging nominal fee for beyond Primary Class students. Students are securing excellent score percentage in SSLC in the past 10 years culminating into historic 100% first classes in the academic year 2017-18. School has staff of 20 members and serving to 96 inmates. Institute is also providing self employment training to adult destitute to stand on their own legs for livelihood after schooling. School has total strength of around 500 children, around 60 students commute to school from nearby villages & Tandas. The commuting distance ranges from 10 to 20 kms with poor bus connectivity. The project sought financial assistance for purchase of school bus to ferry the students from outlying areas.

Financial assistance of Rs 24,44,875/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

#### The Blind Relief Association - Central Zone – Bhopal DO

The Blind Relief Association is working for welfare of the blinds in Bhopal and providing food, clothing, residence, medical facilities, education up to 12th standard, vocational & recreation facilities to the blind inmates free of cost. The Organization is imparting basic computer training to 32 blind students of class X to XII. LIC GJF has given financial assistance of `2,92,155/- in 2009-10 for purchase of 10 computers to establish computer center. The existing computer system of the organization is very old and obsolete and the same is beyond repair and hence project authority has requested to replace the system with new. The project sought financial assistance for purchase of 12 computers and 2 printers for the use of students.

Financial assistance of Rs 4,15,200/- has been provided for purchase of 12 computers and 2 printers.

Muskaan -Jeevan Shiksha Pahal School –Central Zone –Bhopal

Jeevan Shiksha Pahal School is run by Muskaan to address the gap faced by the children due to an irrelevant curriculum and discriminatory treatment they face in mainstream schools. School was started with 20 working children in basti of Ganga Nagar, Bhopal - now they are catering to 160 children in school and 2000 children in bastis. They have 40 teaching staff. School is conducting many workshops for overall development of children like bal mela, drama presentation, writing workshop, measurement fair, workshop on religion and superstitions with youth, child protection issues, science mela, teachers' training, balwadi teachers etc. The project sought financial assistance for purchase of school bus for transporting the underprivileged children from bastis across the city to the school and back home. They also propose to use the vehicle to take children for study trips and excursions. This will be very useful for their learning as well as building confidence to speak and interact with more people.

Financial assistance of Rs 17,30,000/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

• Amar Jyoti Charitable Trust – Central Zone – Gwalior

Amar Jyoti Charitable Trust is providing inclusive education in a barrier free environment to a group of over 4900 students with and without disability in Delhi and Gwalior. Vocational skills and cultural activities are a part of the curriculum. The Trust is also providing mobility aids, appliances, corrective surgery, therapeutic services, X ray unit and pathological lab, OPD and immunization, Homeopathy treatment, prosthetics & orthotics, early intervention services program in the premises. The Trust is having 412 students at Gwalior Centre from whom no tuition fee is charged. There are 27 teachers and 24 other staff to take care of students.LIC GJF has given financial assistance of Rs 20,00,000 /- for Construction of rehabilitation centre in the year 2012-13. Now Trust sought financial assistance for installation of fire fighting system in the school and rehabilitation centre which in turn will provide safety from fire to the students, teachers and equipments.

Financial assistance of Rs 18,66,146/- has been provided for Installation of Fire Fighting System in the school and rehabilitation centre.

• Netra Vidyalaya Junior College- Unit of Jeeyar Educational Trust – South Central Zone-Hyderabad DO

Netra Vidyalaya Junior college for Blind, Hyderabadis a service unit of Jeeyar Educational Trust and was established in the year 2007 to provide higher education, i.e 11th& 12th standard level to blind students. All the students are provided with a Laptop each and given training to write their final examination on Laptop without taking the help of scribes. College provides free education, boarding, lodging, food, study material etc to blind students of all communities irrespective of religion, caste, color and gender. They have total 69 inmates and 14 teachers. The project sought financial assistance for the purchase of a Bus for Netra Vidyalaya Junior College for Blind for transportation of students from hostel to Hyderabad. The students as part of curriculum will be making frequent visits to Hyderabad which is almost 20 kms away from the campus. The students being blind have to be given utmost care while travelling.

Financial assistance of Rs 23,18,550/- for purchase of school bus for blind students.

Paramhansa Yoganand Society for Special Unfolding & Moulding - North Central Zone – Lucknow DO

Paramahansa Yogananda Society for Special Unfolding and Moulding (PYSSUM) Child Development Centre was established in 2005 at Lucknow. Since its inception more than 145 special need children and adults have been registered for the Day Care as well as Home Based Programme. PYSSUM is providing free therapy sessions to all the challenged children and adults since its inception under the supervision of qualified and experienced therapeutic staff. Therapy sessions are the foundation of all activities in the effective services of intellectually challenged individuals. Now they want to upgrade its therapeutic services to next level which would require good range of latest equipment and heavy –duty machine. The project sought financial assistance for purchase of upgraded equipment which will support the value addition to the existing services.

Financial assistance of Rs 11,00,000/- has been provided for purchase of music therapy equipment, group training interactive screen, therapeutic equipment.

Nalanda Seva Trust- Prajna Bharathi Vidya Kendra, Nittur- South Central Zone –Shimoga DO

Prajna Bharti Vidya Kendra, Nalanda Seva Trust (R), Nittur, Shimoga was established in 2004 to provide education to the under privileged children. Trust is also involved in many welfare activities including free medical checkup, free eye checkup and treatment, awareness programs on ill effects of plastic use etc. They are also running an unaided school and providing education at a minimum fee from lower kinder garten to 10th standard. School has strength of 258 students and there are 14 teachers and 2 non –teaching staff to take care of these students. The project sought financial assistance for construction of 4 class rooms, 1dining hall and one multipurpose hall as the class rooms are congested.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of 4 class rooms and dining hall.

 Sri Bharathi Higher Primary School – A Unit of Vivekananda Vidyavardhaka Sangh Puttur -South Central Zone – Udupi DO

Shri Bharathi Higher Primary School at Alankar in Puttur taluk was started in 1994. This is Kanada Medium School with due prominence to Sanskrit and English, one of the primary purpose of education is to make the students articulate well in their chosen language. The students who passed 8th standard of Kanada medium are on par with students of any English Medium school when it comes to expressing themselves in global language. School is providing free education to few students, free mid day meal to all students. School is having total 248 students out of which SC -8, ST -07, and OBC are 216 including girls and boys. Entire fee is waived for 25 students and there are 12 teaches who are taking care of all students. The project sought financial assistance for purchase of school bus as most of the students are coming to the school from interior places where adequate transportation facilities are not available.

Financial assistance of Rs 21,15,014/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

#### Param Prasad Charitable Trust run Asha Bhavan -Western Zone –Satara DO

Param Prasad Charitable society is running MDC Home, Asha Bhavan Special School, Asha College and Asha Gram works for past nineteen years for the empowerment of children and adults with intellectual disability along with multiple forms of disability. Asha Bhavan, an orphanage home established in 2000 by Param Prasad Charitable Society for children with intellectual disability. Now it has emerged as a model institution caring almost one hundred boys and is the only one of its kind in the entire state. The school is providing hostel facility free of cost. These special children are providing education as per their IQ level. School has teaching staff of 22 members at Asha Bhavan. They have 64 orphan inmates and 48 day scholars. Day scholars are coming from distance of 15 to 20 kms. The project sought financial assistance for purchase of school bus which will be helpful for commuting of such special children from home to school and back.

Financial assistance of Rs 21,80,040/- has been provided for purchase of bus.

- **Guru Ravidass Samaj Kalyan Sabha, Samalkha North Zone Karnal DO** Guru Ravidass Samaj Kalyan Sabha, Samalkha is providing education and coaching for employment to the weaker sections of the society. There are 140 students studying in the school and 50 are provided education free of cost. School has 10 teachers and 5 other staff for taking care of all students. School constructed a new hall for Library and sought financial assistance for purchase of 110 chairs. Financial assistance of Rs 1,65,000/- has been provided for purchase of 110 chairs for Library.
- Kodiyar Education Trust, Mehsana Western Zone Gandhinagar DO Kodiyar education Trust had established Disha Day School in 2003 for the intellectually challenged children at Mehsana. There are 110 students who are commuting from surrounding villages to Mehsana. There are 24 teachers and 15 other staff members to take care of these students. School is also providing music therapy, speech therapy, meditation, yoga, group activities, education picnic etc free of cost. The school sought financial assistance for purchase of school bus which will be helpful for special children to attend the school/ training center and return to home.

Financial assistance of 20,94,787/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

#### Sarvodaya Vidya Kendra – Western Zone – Kolhapur DO

Sarvoday Vidhya Kendra runs a non aided Marathi and English Medium School up to 10th standard. There are 400 students and 23 teachers. The school charges them only 50% of fees. The area of 5000 sqft has been given to run the school by Sahara Trust, Ichalkaranji. School is providing uniform, study material and mid day meal to all students free of cost. They are providing advance education to poor, backward and minority Muslim community students to bring them into mainstream of the society. Most of the students are commuting long distance. Even after running this school for many years, school is unable to get a school bus for students who come from the distances. The school sought financial assistance for purchase of two school buses for transportation of 400 students to school and back to home. School will also use the buses for the picnics and educational tours.

Financial assistance of 25,00,000/- has been provided for purchase of two school buses.

#### Vivekananda Rock Memorial & Vivekanada Kendra, Badarpur ghat Eastern Zonal Office-Silchar DO

Vivekananda Kendra is a reputed NGO working for the social upliftment of poor people. It is having headquarters at Kanyakumari. They have established Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya Badarpur(Assam) imparting socio cultural and nationalistic education.VKV, Badarpur is a CBSE curriculum based school having 191 students mostly from poor sections and it is aiming at all-round development of students for producing scientific temperanats among the students who will contribute constructively to the society. The functioning of VKV, Badarpur is not only limited to the students of the school but also reaches out to students of other schools of Badarpur locality and general public through various science & mathematics based activities. From June 2018, onwards 'Anandalaya' a non formal free education for the students of nearby government schools on daily basis has been started. This has resulted in space constraint and hence need for additional classrooms.

Financial assistance of 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction.

#### Rajasthan Bal Kalyan Samiti –North Zone – Udaipur DO

Rajasthan Bal Kalyan Samiti (RBKS) is actively engaged in imparting primary, degree and vocational education through a number of schools and colleges. They are assisting approximately 9500 hilly and deep rural families through horticulture development projects being financed by NABARD. RBKS has 8 Schools, 2 Creches, 15 Child Learning Centers, 12 Hostels, 12 UG, PG, Technical/ Professional Colleges in Udaipur, Dungarpur, Pratapgarh & Sirohi Districts. They are providing hostel accommodation, food and education to tribal girls free of cost and to other students at subsidized rate. The RBKS sought financial assistance for purchase of school bus. This bus will cater to the needs of tribal and rural children within a periphery of approx 25 km who otherwise do not have means of transportation for attending school.

Financial assistance of 24,18,980/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

#### Rajasthan Netraheen Kalyan Sangh, Jaipur - North Zone – Jaipur DO -2

Rajasthan Netraheen Kalyan Sangh (RNKS) is providing education to blind students up to secondary school. School is providing education, computer training, boarding and lodging facility free of cost. Presently there are 79 students out of which 23 are girls. They have also14 teachers and 24 employees to take care of these students. School has requested funds for purchase of School Bus which will be used to bring & drop visually challenged students from residence to school, play ground, events, Govt Functions etc. as and when required.

Financial assistance of 7,95,355/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

#### Baleram Brijbhushan Sarswati Shishu Mandir Shiksha Samiti, Merrut – North Central Zone – Meerut DO

Baleram Brijbhushan Sarswati Shishu Mandir Shiksha Samiti, Merrut branch of Vidya Bharti was established in the year 1984 to provide education to children of deprived sections of the society. Baleram School is providing quality education to students that include economically and socially weaker sections of the society and fee waiver is also provided for about 40% students of the school. School has 2266 students and all students are coming from about 20 villages and they have only one bus. The school sought financial assistance for purchase of school bus which will be helpful for children to commute to school and return home safely.

Financial assistance of 21,61,099/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

#### Samarthan Trust for the Disabled - South Central Zone –Bangalore DO -II

Samarthan Trust for the Disabled runs residential primary (established in 2008) and High School (2004) located in Bengaluru. For holistic development of the students, they are providing free tuition, accommodation and study support through volunteers, training in extracurricular activities and accessible infrastructure study material in digital format and so on. Samarthan has supported over 50,000 beneficiaries as of now through their various strategic interventions like education, skill training, environment, sport, art & culture & women empowerment through 13 centers located in seven states of India. The project sought financial assistance for purchase of Bus for children with disability to go to school and day care center.

Financial assistance of Rs 23,16,125/- has been provided for purchase School bus.

#### Sri Guru Raghvendra Seva Trust R) Karkala - South Central Zone – Udupi DO Vijetha Special School and Vocational training centre under Sri established in 2015 for providing academic classes, yoga, physiotherapy, speech therapy, occupational

therapy etc to intellectually deficient children of Karkala Taluka. School is providing special and innovative training to 75 students and not charging any fees. Out of 75 students 35 are residing in the school hostel and 40 students are day scholars coming to school from faraway places. Day scholar special children are transported from remote villages to school and back in a small 17 seater school bus, in two three trips. The school sought financial assistance for purchase of school bus which will provide transportation facility to IDD children to attend the school and go back home safely and also be helpful for many more families in sending their physically/ mentally challenged children to the above school/ center in time.

Financial assistance of 19,79,500/- has been provided for purchase School bus.

#### Kalkeri Sangeet Vidyalaya – South Central Zone – Dharwad DO

Kalkeri Sangeet Vidyalaya, Kalkeri started as an informal music school in October 2001 in Dharwad. School started with a few children and two teachers, now they supports 220 children, teenagers and young adults, and employ over 70 members of staff, comprising of teachers (academic & performing arts), the administration team, wardens, cooks and maintenance workers. School is not charging any fees from the students. The school sought financial assistance for replacement of old bus with new one, as the old existing bus is nine years old and in need of frequent repairs and also not safe for transportation of the children. New vehicle will be helpful for the children to attend local music programs which adds a great deal of value to their performing arts education as they are able to physically see and listen to state level and national level artists that regularly perform in music programs in Dharwad.

Financial assistance of Rs13,70,118/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

#### <u>2019-20</u>

#### • Ehssas-Purchase of Tata Winger Van 13+1 Seater-Central Zone-Gwalior DO

Ehsaas is working since 2003 in Gwalior City for Divyang children with cerebral palsy, autism and slow learning disabilities, helping them with therapies and rehabilitation programs. Ehsaas has a team of about 20-25 persons (including staff &volunteers). In addition the members (parents of children & otherwise) too contribute. For quality education and services, one teacher takes only 1-4 students at a time. This ensures that every child is getting appropriate attention and progress in education and the therapies given. They have strength of 57 students, 40 of whom regularly attend school. They provide physiotherapy, speech therapy, music and dance therapy, occupational therapy, yoga to improve physical and mental development of the students. Society has requested funds for purchase of 14 seater TATA winger Van which will be useful for transportation of the disabled children and enable assistance of therapist and special educators providing education and training to these special children. Financial assistance of Rs.9,41,816/- has been provided.

• Chetana Child Development Centre- Unit of Seva Bharathi - Purchase of Bus (Tata Model BSIV 36+1 seater) – South Central Zone-Udupi DO

Chetana Child Development Centre (CCDC) was established in 1993. This center is for the children and young adults with mental retardation, cerebral palsy, Downsyndrome, autism and other developmental challenges. They are providing therapeutic and educational services encompassing early intervention, academic and non formal education, vocational training and respite care to the children. The CCDC functions in a similar way as academic school, from 9.30am to 3.30 pm. As on date, 97 children are on roll in the age group from 5 to 30 years. They are brought daily from their residence and drop them back. For these children they have a team of 29 staff members in all, i.e Head Mistress, special teachers, physiotherapists, speech therapists, occupational therapists, music teachers plus staff. Chetana has requested funds of Rs 19,56,322/- to replace the existing mini bus by new Tata Model BSIV 36+1 seater for transportation of the Centre inmates, who are physically or mentally challenged children, who come from their residence for education , training and treatment. Financial assistance of Rs 19,56,322/- has been provided for purchase of Tata Model BSIV 36+1 seater bus for transportation of the center inmates.

• SOS Childrens villages of India- Hermann Gemeiner School -Construction of classroom & furniture for teachers & students - Central Zone – Bhopal DO SOS Children's Villages of India is a voluntary child care organization providing direct and indirect care to children of India. It has 32 villages in 22 states in the country. It is a member of the world wide SOS family in 134 countries with SOS-Kinder of International as the umbrella organization. Hermann Gmeiner School is a community project of SOS children villages of India. There are 770 students in the school from nursery to std VIII. The school is having 16 classrooms, 2 halls and 2 playgrounds for students.

Financial assistance of Rs 24,99,948/- has been provided for construction of 3 classrooms on the Ground and purchase of furniture to provide educational needs for under privileged, orphan and weaker section students of the society.

• **RKM Narendrapur Blind Boys Academy-Purchase of vehicle - Eastern Zonal office-KMDO II** The Ramakrishna Mission Blind Boys' Academy (BBA), Narendrapur, has been engaged since more than 6 decades in the education and training of the visually challenged persons to improve their livelihood prospects and stimulate their integration in the society at large. It provides education to 180 such students in Class-I to Class-XII as well as the vocational training in an ITI and in agriculture and animal husbandry training, completely free of cost to the students and their families. RKM Narendrapur BBA requested for a vehicle to enable a far higher level of interaction of its students with the general public through participation in music and cultural programmes appearance in the annual school board examinations, medical check-ups, participation in outside swimming, sports and athletic competitions.

Financial assistance of Rs 16,13,609 /- has been provided for purchase of Vehicle.

Santhigiri Ashram- Santhiri Vidyanbhavan Senior Secondary School-Construction of Auditorium & toilet block for girls - South Zone – Thiruvanthapuram DO Santhigiri Ashram is a non-profit charitable organization, established in 1968 engaging in the noble activity of catering to the education, cultural and spiritual needs of the people. Santhigiri Vidyabhavan Senior Secondary School was started as a unit of Santhigiri Ashram in 1978 and is providing quality education to the under privileged children. The school provides education to around 1000 students mainly from weaker sections of the society at affordable cost out of which 30% of the students are provided with 100 % waiver of school fee. They sought funds for construction of Auditorium and Toilet Block for Girls on second floor of the School.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of Auditorium and Toilet Block for Girls on second floor of the School.

• Handicapped Development Council- Purchase of School Bus - North central Zone – Agra DO Handicapped Development Council, Shastripuram, Agra has started an institute for mentally handicapped children called "Tears" on 10<sup>th</sup> July 1992 with only a handful of kids to impart sound psychological and behavior modification techniques. TEARS is now a school with over 150 children and staff of 50. It is situated on a self-owned land with 27 rooms, 4 halls and 8 sheds in shastripuram, Sikandara, Agra. They sought funds for purchase of school bus.

Financial Assistance of Rs 13,83,300/- has been provided for purchase of school bus (19 + 1 seater) for transportation of especially abled children to school.

• Samarpan Badhir Vidyalaya – Purchase of School Bus - North Central Zone – Agra DO Samarpan Badhir Vidhyalaya is a charitable organization engaged in dealing with hearing impaired and intellectually disabled children. This NGO is started with the sole aim of providing free education, training and other facilities to the Deaf and Dumb children and mentally retarded children. Currently, there are approximately 135 students enrolled on this day, out of which 66 are suffering from hearing impairment and 69 are intellectually disabled. Education is totally free at the school and besides education they also provide vocational training to these students so that they can earn their living in the future. They sought assistance for purchase of school bus.

Financial assistance of Rs 13,21,586/- has been provided for purchase of CNG Force Traveler School Bus (20 + 1 seater) for transportation of the children from their home to school.

• Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya, Tezpur - Construction of principal room, conference hall and two class room - Eastern Zone – Guwahati

Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalayav, Tezpur was established in the year 2009 and is very prominent education institute in Sonitpur District of Assam. At present 563 children from the rural area of Sonitpur District are studying in the school for a very nominal cost. Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya, Tezpur is planning to construct the Building for school. They sought funds for construction of principal room, conference hall and two class rooms which will be helpful in providing higher education to the poor students coming from the rural area of Tezpur.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction principal room, conference hall and two class room.

• Sreekarunya Mission Charitable Society – Purchase of Mini Bus 16+A+D - South Zone – Thiruvananthpuram DO

Sreekarunya Mission is a residential school for mentally challenged children. The School now has 124 children with several disabilities, out of which 70 children are inmates of the school. There is 34 staff including teaching and non teaching to look after these children with good care. They are providing education and vocational training, physiotherapy, speech therapy, medical facility etc to all students. They sought funds for Purchase of Mini bus which will be helpful to provide education to more students.

Financial assistance of Rs 13,98,728/- has been provided for purchase of Mini School Bus.

- Nethra Vidyalaya A unit of Jeeyar Education Trust at Varija Purchase of TATA Winger (18+1) school non AC 2.2L Dicor BS4 Model South Central Zone Visakhapatnam DO Nethra Vidyalaya school for visually challenged under the aegis of Jeeyar Education Trust (JET), founded by Sri Sri Sri Tridandi Srimannarayana Ramanuja Chinna Jeeyar Swamiji. The school now has 114 students, who are accommodated in spacious hostel and school premises with all amenities for free. They sought financial assistance for purchase of school bus which will be useful for carrying students to sports venue and also to drop the sick students to city hospital which is far away from school. This bus will be also used for transporting visually challenged students who wish to be day scholars.Financial assistance of Rs 11,98,115/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.
- Ashadeepa Trust, Raichur Purchase of Star school bus- 30+1 seater, BS –III- LP 407/34, Marcopolo (3\*2) model - South Central Zone – Raichur DO
   Ashadaepa day aera ashaal is taking aera of mentally retarded and Carebral polay shildren since

Ashadeepa day care school is taking care of mentally retarded and Cerebral palsy children since 2005. They have 44 inmates and 15 members including teaching and other members. School is providing primary education, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, vocational therapy and also help them to be Independent. They sought funds for purchase of school bus, which will enable the school to bring children who need special care.

Financial assistance of Rs 17,93,434/- has been provided for purchase of school bus .

• Vivekananda Rock Memorial &Vivekanda Kendra-Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya, Badarpur Ghat, Karimganj, Assam – Construction of 2 classrooms, 1 staff room, 1 store room on Ground floor - Eastern Zone - Silchar DO -

Vivekananda Kendra is a reputed NGO working for the social upliftment of poor people. It is having headquartered at Kanyakumari. They have established Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya Badarpur(Assam) imparting socio cultural and nationalistic education. The Sangha is recognized for their community works, Relief Works and provide quality education at rural and semi urban areas to the lower strata of the Society, especially poor ST students and health care to the common masses. They sought funds for Construction of school building at East Hurna Gram Panchayat, P.O. Dharmanagar, and North Tripura, where students of the surroundings can stay and continue their education unhindered.

Financial assistance of Rs25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of co-educational English medium School at PurbaHurua, Dharmanagar, Tripura.

 Malenadu Education and Rural Development Society Sirsi - South Central Zone – Darwad DO

Malenadu Education and Rural Development Society (R) Sirsi was registered under Bombay Public Trust Act at Karnataka in 1998. Chandana School which was established in 2002 and run by the Malenadu Education and Rural Development Society is providing activity base, creative childcenter education in Narebail, a backward village of Sirsi Taluka. Trust has established Chandana Creches and Nursery in collaboration with Social Advisory Board, Government of Karnataka during 2006 for overall development of children. School is providing quality education to children to enable them to develop physically and emotionally healthy, thinking and creative individuals, who can intelligently and sensitively face the challenges of the future. The project sought financial assistance for purchase of school bus, as this school is situated in remote village which has no private bus service. School has seven second –hand buses which are 15 years old and have to be discarded soon.

Financial assistance of Rs 21,81,988/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

Agra Residential Blind School -Radha Swami Institute for the Visually Handicapped, Agra –
 Purchase of 14 seater School Bus - North Central Zone – Agra

Radha Swami Institute for the Visually Handicapped, Agra was registered in 2006 and started functioning in 2007. The school is providing necessary support and education to the blind /vision impaired students. School has 11 staff members and 10 volunteers to take care of all the students and they are providing all facilities, free of cost. They are running residential school in rental building. Residence facility is available for students coming from distance. School is not providing residential facility to students coming from nearby area. Commutation to school is very difficult for blind students. Hence School has sought funds for purchase of 14 seater bus for picking up the students and drop them back home.

Financial assistance of Rs12,37,785/- has been provided for 14-seater school bus.

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#### <u>2018-19</u>

# • Construction of 3 rooms and gallery in the ongoing construction of building for Teachers training college and Hostel for blind, deaf & dumb and mentally challenged people - Netraheen Vikas Sansthan-Northern Zone - Jodhpur DO

Netraheen Vikas Sansthan is working for rehabilitation of blind, deaf & dumb and mentally retarded students since last 35 years in Jodhpur by providing free education, boarding and lodging facility separately for boys and Girls. The School was started on 15th August 1977 with two blind students, now there are 514 students out of which 167 are girls. NVS is the only institute for girls with hostel facility in Rajasthan. The School is having two separate hostel buildings for girls and boys in the school campus only. The lodging and boarding facility is provided free of cost to all the students. Morning tea, breakfast, lunch, afternoon tea / fruits and dinner is served daily to more than 575 persons at a time.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of 3 rooms in a building meant for providing training to teachers (B.Ed) and hostel facility to the blind, deaf and dumb people.

• Construction of Residential School for Underprivileged Girls - Nai Dharti - East Central Zone -Patna Do II

Nai Dharti is an NGO, was registered in Sept 2005 for providing food, shelter and education to the deprived girls engaged in rag picking in and around Patna. They have started a project ANKUR at Gandhinagar, Patna in 2009 with 20 ragpicker Musahar Girls. LIC of India provided a Tata Winger School Bus in 2009. They are also running Sister Nivedita balika Vidyalaya Since 2011 in a rent free building temporarily provided by trust and this school was converted in residence in 2015. Apart from ANKUR girls, they enrolled 50 local slum girls.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of residential school for underprivileged girls (ground floor portion only).

 School Bus (SML ISUZU Model No SML S7) - Vijaya Mary Integrated School for the Blind -South Central Zone -Machilipatnam DO

Vijaya Mary Integrated School was formed in 1987 to undertake activities associated with the education, training and employment of the blind and disabled in the Gunadala, Vijayawada District, Andhra Pradesh State. The School has a many facilities for blind students i.e sports & games, yoga, cultural activities, many extracurricular activities are included with studies, computer training to each and every student, special care and special classes for slow learners The organization is having 600 students coming from tribal areas and BPL families, out of which 120 students are blind and 40 students are orphans. Organization is providing free education and other service to these 160 students.

Financial assistance of Rs 15,53,000/- has been provided for the school bus so the students may easily commute to school. Also there are some hostel children who have talent of music and dance, they can go by bus and exhibit their talents in and around the Vijayawada District and get recognition from the public.

#### 22 Smart Boards for Deaf and Dumb - Rotary Club Nadiad Samaj Seva & Sanshodhan Trust Western Zone - Nadiad DO

Rotary Club NadiadSamajSeva&Sanshodhan Trust is working for rehabilitation of deaf & dumb and mentally retarded students since last 42 years in Nadiad by providing free education, boarding and lodging facility separately for boys and girls. The School was started on 24<sup>th</sup> September 1976 with one teacher and seven children, now there are 360 deaf and dumb students out of which 246 students are living in hostel. These students have passed with good marks in SSC & Higher secondary examination as well as normal students. After passing the exams some students got good job and some of them are imparting education to deaf children. Financial assistance of Rs 23,09,538/ has been provided for purchase of 22 smart boards as they have 27 classrooms and they have only 5 smart boards. Smart board in classroom will cater to the needs of the deaf and dumb students of the school, so that every deaf & dumb student can receive the study material in Audio/ Video mode in all subjects which will assist them and enhance their learning process.

# • Construction of 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Vocational Training and Entrepreneurship Development Institute, at Koparkhairane, Navi Mumbai - ManavSadhan Vikas Sanstha, Mumbai - Western Zone - Thane DO

ManavSadhan Vikas Sanstha(MSVS) is a public charitable Trust registered in 1997.MSVS is running Jana ShikshanSansthan (JSS) with support of Govt of India, at Sindhudurg and Ratnagiri districts of Maharashtra, providing non formal education to the marginalized and underprivileged people living in the region and making them self-reliant and empowered. More than 63,158 men and women have taken advantage of this programme. MSVS also runs School and College of Nursing, where 280 students have completed their course and got employment so far. They have launched employability skills program in Mumbai's shanties. Training provided include driving, beauty and hair care, tailoring, fashion designing, embroidery, welding and fabrication, refrigeration and AC repair, etc. Since 2011, MSVS has trained 1408 beneficiaries.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for vocational training centre for promoting "skill development programs for underprivileged in Koparkhairane, Navi Mumbai.

## • Construction of classrooms - Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya, Tumpreng - Eastern Zone / Guwahati DO

Vivekananda Kendra, a spiritually oriented service organisation head quartered at Kanyakumari, has been functioning since 1972 through varied service activities such as educational, rural development, natural resources development, health care, publications, etc. They have 800 centers and 74 Vidyalayas all over India. Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya, Tumpreng, established in 2015, is a coeducation English medium school. The school aims to have classes up to 10+2 level under CBSE curriculum. Presently it has classes up to VIII. The students are coming from 10 villages, 5 ethnic communities and 10 different language groups. They are being provided active, joyful & original learning in primary classes through activity based learning. The school has 332 students and fee is waived for 9 students.

Financial Assistance of Rs 24,98,500/- has been provided to trust for construction of three

class rooms which will be helpful for providing spacious classrooms, well equipped library, science laboratory, class rooms with audio visual aids, online career guidance classes, various trainings for students and teachers and an environment for all-round development.

• School bus- Generation Yuvaa Welfare Society – South Central Zone – Vishakhapatnam DO Generation Yuvaa was established in 2007 at Andhra Pradesh to eradicate Child begging and giving a better future for the children. Trust was started by a group of 30 odd graduate students who were interested in the welfare of the underprivileged children, now the organization has more than 5000 members. Generation Yuvaa Children Home is a shelter for children who have lost their parents, children living on streets and involved in begging. Trust is working for overall development of the children and provide them shelter, clothing, food, healthcare and education free of cost. They have around 186 children at their home, most of who were begging. Generation Yuvaa has four wings that works on different social issues of the society, such as providing employment to elder beggars & poor people, blood donation ,providing information and serving as data base for public and NGOs ,motivating Youth regarding social service and Inducing ethical value in there. Presently above 150 children are going to various private schools/college by auto rickshaws which is not safe or affordable for the children.

Financial assistance of Rs 16,00,000/- has been provided for purchase of School Bus which will be useful for transportation purpose.

### • School bus- KannaAshrai Foundation, Burugupudi, EG district – South Central Zone – Rajahmundry DO

The KannaAshrai Foundation (KAF) was established in 2010 with an aim to run an education and livelihood special training school for mentally challenged children. The objective was to create a caring and nurturing environment that would speed up the learning process of mentally challenged. The school is located on 2 acres land, 10 kms from Rajahmundry. The school is empowering mentally challenged students from both rural and urban areas and organizing skill building and therapeutic activities. The school is having facilities that include spacious classrooms, early intervention center, therapeutic services, vocational services, residential facility, transport facility. All facilities are provided free of cost. The school has 50 students and 12 teachers. The KAF has conducted survey and indentified around 250 mentally challenged children in the surrounding area to whom they planning to extend their services and for this purpose, as well as, to replace their old vehicles KAF has requested for funding for purchase of school bus.

Financial assistance of Rs. 14,99,280/- has been provided for purchase of School Bus – SML ISUZU Sartaj Standard Model.

## • Vehicle (Mahendra Bolero SLE)- Action for Ability Development and Inclusion (AADI) – Northern Zone – Delhi DO-II

Action for Ability Development and Inclusion (AADI) was started in 1978 as a small centre for special education for children with Cerebral Palsy and is now an established National

level organization working for the rights of people with disability. AADI is working towards

individual rehabilitation and other needs of persons with disability through visiting homes, aanganwadis, hospitals and vocational training centres. It aims at capacity building of parents, community workers and community resources, besides conducting awareness raising programmes for the community as a whole. They have provided opportunities for education to more than 3000 children, facilitated mainstream education to 1000 children, trained around 3500 teachers, special educators and therapists, sensitized more than 20000 people through workshops and orientation programs.

Financial assistance of Rs 8,57,820/- has been provided for purchase of a vehicle, which will be used by them to travel to various villages for individual rehabilitation and other needs of disability.

 Construction of Laboratory Building at VKV School- Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya, Roing -Eastern Zone - Johrat DO

Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya (VKVs), Roing started in 1977. It is located in the Lower Dibang Valley district of Arunachal Pradesh. This is a co-educational school and is up to Higher Secondary level, with Science Stream. VKVs have been striving to provide an all round nationalistic education to the **tribal children of the remote Himalayan States of India**. They have a hostel for Vanvasi children, non- formal school for preservation of Vedic Vidya, education through audio-visuals. School has organized awareness camps, residential yoga, vocation training classes, seminars, lectures etc. They have 30 teachers and 13 non- teaching staff. Total strength of the school is 792 students out of which they have waived fees for 13 students.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of Laboratory Block for Higher Secondary School.

#### • Mahindra Bolero (Nine Seater)- Integrated Development Society – East Central Zone Berhampur DO

Integrated Development Society (IDS) has been working for Scheduled Tribes and other indigenous marginalized people for the last 26 years in Koraput District of Odisha. They cater to the basic needs of disadvantaged and vulnerable children who have been denied their basic rights like food, health and education due to socio-cultural and economic problems. Adarsh Girijan Pragati Vidyalya of IDS is a residential school where children belonging to Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Castes and

children from economically weaker sections and destitute children are given education up to 10<sup>th</sup> Std. Presently there are 65 children staying with lodging and boarding facilities in the school. Financial assistance of Rs 9,80,471/- has been provided for purchase of vehicle, which will be useful for transporting children from the 3 remote districts of Odisha to SAA and also required to carry children to hospital in Koraput and other medical institutions for treatment.

#### • School Bus - PardadaPardadi Education Society – North Central Zone - Aligarh DO

Pardada Pardadi Education Society (PPES) was established in 2000. They have been improving lives of women in over 65 villages of Anupshahar tehsil, district Bulandshahar, which is one of the most backward districts in Uttar Pradesh.PPES runs four schools affiliated to U.P. Board and provides free education, job opportunities, healthcare, and livelihood enhancement for girls and women from the marginalized sections of society and enables them to break out of the cycle of poverty. Since inception, 3000 girls have been educated and 437 girls cleared 10<sup>th</sup> Std, 215 girls cleared 12<sup>th</sup> Std and 84 girls had enrolled for higher studies till 2017, whereas 72 of PPES graduates are working in fields like medicine, IT, etc. They are also working for community development, inculcating dairy best practices and have also constructed 92 individual toilets and community toilets in 2 villages.

Financial assistance Rs 20,30,000/- has been provided for purchase of school bus to extend the transport facility for more needy girl students from the rural areas to commute to and from the school.

#### • Mini Bus (24+1 seater) - Association for Mentally Handicapped Adults (AMHA) - South Zone -Thrissur DO

Association for Mentally Handicapped Adults (AMHA) was established by Dr. Bhanumathi. She is a sister of 3 mentally challenged brothers and a strong aspiration sprouted in Dr. Bhanumathi's mind in her early childhood to explore the possibilities to work for the welfare of intellectually impaired community as a whole that inevitably requires a helping hand throughout their life. AMHA runs a special school cum rehabilitation centre at Karyatukara and an early intervention cum sensory integration therapy and speech therapy center at Ambadikulam Ground, Olarikara, ThrissurDist Kerala. AMHA's adult center at Karyatukara is now home to 57 Adults and their families. It is a shelter for mentally challenged adults belonging to under privileged families from adjoining areas, providing residential and day care facility to them. Free education and vocational training is imparted to them on regular basis. Out of 57 adults, 28 are residential and 29 come daily from nearby areas, 10 are orphans. They are also running an Autism center where more than 30 children (from age 2 to 14) are availing occupational and sensory therapy. They are providing service of occupational therapist, clinical psychologist, special educators, physiotherapist and speech therapist. Financial assistance of Rs 18,45,569/- has been provided for replacement of 15 year-old bus by new

Mini Bus for transportation of students to school and back home.

### • School Bus i,e SML ISUZU (26+1) - Aarambh Association for Autism – South Central Zone - Rajamundry DO

Aarambh Association for Autism was registered in .2010 to work for the benefit of children with Autism, training of parents, free counseling, advocacy etc. They are running a school for autistic children, which is the first of its kind in the state of Andhra Pradesh. The school has up to 40 students and has four classes. The average teacher: student ratio is 3:7. Teaching of students with Autism is highly expensive, because each student is to be given personal care by specially trained teachers. The school has full time special educators, teacher assistants, two full time speech therapists and a visiting occupational therapist. Aarambh also has an active vocational unit and creates a host of handicrafts ranging from key chains, diyas, jewellery, paper bags and has been able to generate a continuous demand for their products.

Financial assistance of Rs 14,99,280/- has been provided for purchase of school bus which will be useful for providing transport facility to students suffering from autism , many families having Autistic children would be benefitted in availing services in places in and

around Rajahmundry.

• Construction of Indoor Hall - MangirishVidyadayiniSamstha`sWagle High School – Western Zone -Goa DO

MangirishVidyadayini Sanstha'sWagle High School was registered in 1965 with the aim to impart school education to children of all castes and communities. Wagle High School is a co-educational secondary level school. They have 26 teachers and 9 non teaching staff with strength of 710 students in secondary section. SSC board exam results have always been maintained at around 94% since inception of the school. School has a gymkhana furnished with table tennis, carom boards, chess boards to develop students' physical and mental skills. School has conducted many workshops and seminars for students and teachers to improve the standard of education and quality of teaching. The students of the school have been awarded medals and prizes at district levels and national levels in various fields of education, sports and talent search competitions.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of Indoor Hall for sports, it will be useful to organize State Level tournaments of Table Tennis and Chess and skill development of the students.

• Installation of 20 Kva Tata Power Solar Plant in Late ParvatibaiKelker Ladies Hostel of Ratnagiri Education Society - Ratnagiri Education Society - Western Zone - Kolhapur DO Ratnagiri Education Society (RES) was established in 1933 by social worker and visionary Late Baburao Joshi with the objective of womens' educationand empowerment of students through modern learning techniques and participation in curricular, co-curricular, extracurricular and extension activities. RES is running 18 different schools, colleges and vocational & professional training institutions including a Management Institute, a Law College, an Information Technology institute and a music academy for Indian classical music and dance. Over 2 lakh students have benefited so far and presently RES is catering to the educational need of about 13500 students from Kindergarten to Post Graduate levels. 2316 students belonging to SC/ST/NT/DT/OBC/SBC categories are availing concessional fees and scholarships/ free-ships are given to economically, physically and socially challenge students. RES is running a Girls' Hostel viz. Late ParvatibaiKelkar Ladies Hostel having capacity for 180 students. The RES has undertaken a project for construction of a toilet block, weather shed and solar power plant at the hostel campus.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000 /- has been provided for installation of a 20KVA Tata Solar Power plant at the girls hostel campus.

• Tata Winger 9+1 Seater BS-IV- National Association for Blind, Bhopal – Central Zone -Bhopal DO

The National Association for the Blind (NAB) is the largest self-help organization for the Blind, in India. It is the voice of the blind, founded on the philosophy, "Let the Blind, lead the Blind". NAB is actively engaged in the field of social, economic rehabilitation of visually impaired people for the last 50 years in India, through its network of Branches in 22 States, district branches and associate organizations. NAB,Bhopal is working for last 32 years for the education, health , skill development and value building for the underprivileged specially abled visually impaired children. NAB, Bhopal has started hostel and rehabilitation centers

for visually impaired students in 1996, the organization is providing completely free hostel and food facility to the visually impaired students belonging to extremely poor families living in rural areas. Since 1996, an average of 50 visually impaired students has been getting hostel facilities free of cost. Financial assistance of Rs 10,46,673/- has been provided for purchase of TATA Winger Van for transportation of blind children from hostel to school and back, as they have a 13 year- old Maruti Van which is used for all purposes and work of the organization.

### • Mahindra Tourister 40 BS4 55 + DseaterExcelo School Bus (3\*2) - St Gregorious Balagram – South Central Zone - Hyderabad DO

St GregoriosBalagram at Yacharam was established in 1985 as a home for the healthy children of leprosy patients. The Organization is running a charitable institution to take care of children whose parents are affected with leprosy. It is a part of the Christian Mission services which is taking care of all people irrespective of caste and creed. They are also running a school for these children. In the year 2001 they started a 20 bedded eye hospital in collaboration with renowned L V Prasad Eye Institute and has treated more than 70,000 patients. They have also done 12000 cataract surgeries, most of them free of cost. The eye hospital is approved for "KantiVeugu" Program of the Telangana Government and also for the program of District Blindness Control Society. It has helped in declaring many villages blindness – free. An old age home serving the neglected elders of the society was also started on the campus. St. GregoriosBalagram has been awarded the "Eminent Institution Award" by the Government of Telangana for its social activities for the society especially in the medical field.

Financial assistance of Rs 19,34,000/- has been provided for purchase of school bus, at present they have two buses which are not sufficient to carry all the students. It is in urgent need for a third bus to cater to the overcrowded children.

• Construction of Hostel Building - Srotoshwini, Vadodara - Western Zone -Vadodara DO Srotoshwini Trust, Vadodara was formed in 2006, registered in 2010 with motto of spreading Bengali Culture. The members had been performing musical shows, plays and dance shows at Kamatibaug Amphitheatre, SayajinagariGruh, C.C. Mehta Auditorium and at different Durga Puja gatherings. In May 2013, they started teaching children of construction labourers who used to work at Swati Sports Complex, Vadodara. They named it as "Pathshala" a mobile informal school for the underprivileged children, as these children cannot go to traditional schools due to their dire circumstances. Pathshala has had many homes over the years. They started in the Sama Sports Complex while it was under construction with 60 children. From there they moved to having 3 different branches of Pathshala being run from the footpaths of Vadodara, followed by the Police Training academy for one year and then MSU's Management Department for few more years. Presently they are based out of Parshuram Bhatta at Jetalpur, Vadodara. They cater to 80 children in Pathshala and 18 children at hostel, who go to school regularly and do age appropriate activities. They are planning to build up a hostel for 100 children where children would stay free of cost and will study in nearby school. Children will stay there until they pass 12<sup>th</sup> class or get admitted in any vocation training course.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of hostel building for underprivileged children.

## • S74240 School Bus (32+1) Seated - SOS Children's villages of India -Eastern Zone - Guwahati DO

SOS Children's village of India was established in 1964 for taking care of parentless and disadvantaged children. SOS has expanded its programs for children at a rapid pace, presently they are taking care of more than 24000 children and their families through 33 SOS children's villages. Two SOS Bhakatpara and Hojai came into existence in 1984 after the ethnic violence of Assam in 1983 to accommodate the additional number of 65 needy children. SOS Children's Village Guwahati was planned and established in 1989. The village consists of 16 family homes and two Youth Houses, catering the needs of 268 parentless children. They are running allied & community based projects like family strengthening programs, kindergartens, school, vocational training centre and a Nursing School in 22 states of India.

Financial assistance of Rs 17,98,698/- has been provided for replacement of 9 year-old bus by the Purchase of New School Bus for commuting convenience of the children, mothers and co-workers.

### • Construction of Hostel Building (G+3 Floors) for Blinds- DivyaJyothi Charitable Trust South Central Zone -Mysore DO

DivyaJyothi Charitable Trust is piloted by M.A. Shiva Prakash who is himself a visually challenged person from an age of seven, but by his determination, he completed his post graduation and has been running this institution. The Trust was registered with Registrar of Societies, Govt. of Karnataka to provide quality education to the Blind and Physically Challenged students of the area. The school has 120 students and provided Braille script to more than 4800 students across Karnataka. The trust has been running computer classes for visually impaired since 2011 and so far have trained more than 120 blind people in basic computer skills which is recognized by National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology. They have conducted English learning program to enhance linguistic skills of the blind, about 300 visually challenged persons were benefited. Trust is running training centre and hostel in rental building and now they have purchased plot from Mysore urban Development Authority and planning to construct multistoried building.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction third floor of the school building which will be used as a computer training Lab.

• Construction of ground floor of the Hostel Building for mentally and physically challenged inmates - SG Special School- South Zone – Trivandrum Division

SG Charitable Society started SG Special School in 2012 at Kuttichal PO, Taluka Kattakkada, and Trivandrum for the mentally and physically disabled children. School was started with 5 students in a rented building. Now they have 85 students. School has conducted many programmes like training for preparation for competition, counseling to face the SSLC exam without any fear, awareness programme, medical camps, felicitation and awards, HIV/AIDS programmes, workshop on poultry layer birds management and organic vegetable cultivation, women empowerment through self help group, women and children rights etc. School is running in rental premises. They purchased a land measuring 20 cents for construction of the school and hostel building for disabled students.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of ground floor of the hostel building to accommodate more physically and mentally challenged students.

• School Bus i,e Model S7 30+1 - Shree Yogishwar Multipurpose Society Jnanasindhu Residential School for the Blind – South Central Zone – Dharwad Division

Shree Yogishwar Multipurpose Society Jnanasindhu Residential School for the Blind was established in 2010 at Holealur village of Ron taluk of Gadag District(Karnataka state, India). It is India's first Yoga based school for blind children. Initially they started with 4 students and now the number has reached 32. The institute is basically for Blind students but they also accommodate orphans, physically disabled, homeless children. They rehabilitate these students by establishing their self-esteem through moral, cultural, occupational and regular school education so that they come out as healthy and responsible citizens of this society, to lead an independent life in future without becoming a burden on their family. School has conducted many activities like Braille, music, yoga, general knowledge, sports, mallakamba and computer education. School has 12 teachers and presently they serve 95 visually challenged students.

Financial assistance of Rs 16,91,837/- has been provided for purchase of school bus to transport visually challenged children from different places for treatment and demonstration programmes.

• Construction of school building (Ground Floor) to accommodate 100 special children - St. Mary's Snehalaya Opportunity School Trust –South Central Zone- Bangalore DO II St Mary's Snehalaya Opportunity School is managed by an efficient and experienced team of professionals from prestigious Institutes like NIMHANS, Mental Health Industry, Chandrasekhar Institute of Speech and Hearing Bangalore. School is currently functioning in rental premises with 25 students. School has facilities to provide training in life skills, speech and hearing, yoga and vocational courses in candle, artificial jewelry making. School has noticed that the demand and requirement of special education have been growing in Bangalore. Hence, School has planned to set up a full – fledged special school with an intake of 100 special children and provide them multiple vocational training facilities. School has acquired 3100 sq ft land in the Hennur Agara in Banglore and they would like to construct a school building with ground plus three floors approximately total measurement of 10,000 sq.ft.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of school building (Ground Floor) to accommodate 100 special children and provide them multiple vocational training facilities.

# • Installation of 18.5 KW on-grid Rooftop Solar PV System - Shishuvihar - Western Zone – Bhavnagar Division

Shishuvihar is one of the pioneering NGOs in Gujarat in the social service activities like blood donation, eye donation, body donation, Bal-Kridangan projects, informal education, tailoring training to men and women, first aid and disaster management training, scout and guide activities, women empowerment projects bal-mandir and respectful care taking of retired and elderly persons. Shishuvihar is doing more than 400 activities for uplifting backward and poor families since last 80 years. Shishuvihar has own building with the facility of school, toilet blocks , laboratory, Bal Mandir, Training centre, teaching classes, stage, Atithi Bhawan, water room, yoga ghar, prayer hall, office etc.

Financial assistance of Rs 14,47,875 for installation of 18.5 kw Solar System in their auditorium (Stage) premises to save electricity expenses of Rs 1.95 lakhs per year.

#### • School Bus - Kalinga Institute of Social Science- East Central Zone- Bhubaneswar DO

Kalinga Institute of Social Sciences (KISS) Bhubaneswar, India is a fully free residential home for 27000 poorest of the poor indigenous children who are provided holistic education from Kindergarten to Post Graduation along with lodging, boarding, health care facilities besides vocational, life skills empowerment. KISS has produced 5000 sports personnel who have been playing in International, National and State Level in 32 events and also participated in Olympic, Asian and Commonwealth. KISS is also working in the field of health care, skill development, career opportunities, afforestation & literacy and livelihood.

Financial assistance of Rs 20,64,268/- has been provided for purchase of school bus to facilitate internal as well as external mobility of the students. Bus service would enable students to go for study tours and routine intra campus transport of tribal children.

#### • Women empowerment project – Light of Life Trust – Western Zone – Nasik DO

The NGO Light of Trust established in the year 2002, is working towards addressing the problem of poverty in rural India. Their vision is to transform the lives of underprivileged rural communities in India by economic upliftment through education and skilling for employment. The NGO has 10 centres and 2 offices in Nandurbar. The NGO has submitted Proposal for women empowerment Project for setting up & operations of the Project for 3 years in Nandurbar. They have done a survey of the place and identified likely beneficiaries. The training will be provided to the

beneficiaries during a span of 3 years. Financial assistance of Rs 31,10,809/- has been sanctioned for 3 year project

#### Year 2017-18

• Construction of Hall - Ramakrishna Sarada Mission – Sri Sarada Math, Indore DO/CZ

Sri Sarada Math & Ramakrishna Sarada Mission, Indore, the only centre in Madhya Pradesh commenced its activities in March 1991. The aim and object of this center are to carry on educational, cultural and religious activities among women and children. Presently, a high school for girls with a total strength of nearly 400 is being run at minimum fees aiming at all round development of the children. They are also running a rehabilitation centre for handicapped children, vocational training of Computer and English classes for house-wives and Physiotherapy center for women & children, many other facilities at free of cost or concessional rate.

Presently Various activities which are being conducted in the centre are Hydrotherapy, Hippo Therapy, Specialized Dance, Music, Yoga and Art Therapy, Simple Kitchen activity, Dressing-Undressing, Dining etiquette etc. will assist the child with special needs in improving self care skills. All these facilities are not available at Indore. They will provide all facilities at subsidized rate. Funding of Rs. 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of Hall for Occupational

Therapy centre will assist the child with special needs in improving self care skills.

• School Bus –(EICHER – 10.75E/32515 WB (30+1) seats) - Spandan School for Mentally Challenged, Banyan City Jaycees Education Trust, Vadodara - Vadodara DO/WZ

Spandan School for Mentally Challenged (SSMC) was started by the Banyan City Jaycees Education Trust, Vadodara in 1975, to provide affordable education to children with mental disabilities. Beginning with only 12 children and 2 special educators in 1975, SSMC has grown into an integrated facility with 30 staff members taking care of almost 200 special children from age 2 onwards, studying in various divisions. SSMC provide various therapies like Multi sensory therapy, Physiotherapy, Speech and Communication Therapy, Occupational therapy, Sensory Integration Therapy, Psychological Testing and Counseling, Music Therapy, Yoga therapy, Dance therapy. The SSMC is not charging any educational fees but are only taking therapy charges.

Financial assistant of Rs 15,29,256/- has been provided for Purchase of a school bus for safe transportation of children from their homes to the school and back who belong from economically weaker families and cannot afford the cost of transportation.

• Vehicle - The Lok Biradari Prakalp - Project of Maharogi Sewa Samiti, – Nagpur DO/ WZ The organization is registered under the Public Charitable Trust and was set up at village Hemalkasa of Bhamragadtaluka in the district of Gadchiroli on 23rd December 1973 by Late Baba Amte under the auspices of Maharaogi SewaSamiti, Wanora to extend a hand of help to the tribal people such as Madia and Gond community. Lok Biradari Ashram School is partly

Government aided. The hospital receives grant for 30 patients from 'The Navajibhai Ratan Tata Trust. Apart from providing education and healthcare facilities to local tribes, the project is also running an animal orphanage and rescue center which maintains near about 100 rescued animals. The institution has 650 students from Hemalkasa and 75 students from Nelgunda. No fees are charged from the students.

The Trust runs school, hospital and animal orphanage by providing education and health care facilities to the tribal people. The hospital provides treatment free of cost to the tribal's. Funding of Rs15,00,000/- has been provided for Purchase of Vehicle for transportation of school staff along with children of surrounding villages, to serve the remotest tribal's of Madia & Gond community of the region for upliftment of the tribal society.

### • Tata Winger 32 School (AC) School Bus - Centre for Autism Therapy Counseling & Help, Bhubaneswar DO, ECZ

Centre for Autism Therapy is an organization working in the field of Autism since last 12 years. The management of CATCH is presently carried by the parents of the autistic children. It is fully funded by the voluntary contribution from the parents and the occasional contributions from the friends and well wishers. The organization is working from an rented premises on lease for a period of 3 years commencing from 22.04.2015. There are around 30 special students attending the school. The organization is running therapy centre by assessing the specific disability of each child and suitable activity is planned in a systematic manner for them. Since most of the autistic children are having problems related to eye contact and lack concentration, various teaching aids are being to improve their concentration.

Financial assistant of Rs 11,47,500/- has been provided for purchase of School bus for transportation of special students.

• Construction of Maths and Physics Lab in school - Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya, Ramnagar, Silchar DO /EZ

VKV is having branches all over the country which carries out various activities such as yoga, rural development programmes, education, health, development of natural resources etc. Keeping in view its objectives, VKK has established 52 schools in Northeast India and the VKV, Ramnagar, Silchar is one amongst these which was established in the year 2005 and is affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi. Trust has 594 students, 24 teachers and 7 non-teaching staff and fee is waived for 8 students. With the help of teacher, remedial classes are conducted for slow learners and extra-curricular classes like martial arts, fine arts, music etc are conducted for all-round development of children. They conduct various workshops like making scientific toys from trash, science experiments and working models, 3 dimensional mathematics model making etc.

For extending education facility to the poor people, funding of Rs 20,14,000/- has been provided for construction of Maths and Physics Lab in school.

#### • Computer for Computer Lab Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya, Tripura Eastern Zone – Silchar Division

The Ramakrishna Mission with its Headquarters at Belur Math, in West Bengal, has 179 Branch centers spread all over the world. In West Tripura Ramakrishna Mission has a branch center with two sub-centers .The main center situated at Viveknagar, 9 k.m. from Agartala town started in 1989. The Ramakrishna Mission undertakes various kinds of social activities and free medical service to the poor and downtrodden people of the society and also undertakes relief activities during natural calamities. Financial assistance of Rs7,40,810/-- has been provided for purchase of computer , computer table and chairs for computer laboratory.

#### • Construction of School building for Handicapped Children -Assissi Holistic Research Centre- South Zone -Ernakulam Division

Assisi Holistic Research centre is a charitable institution, started in the year 2003 (Registered in 2005) with holistic medical system for treating the sick. This system is a combination of Electro homeopathy and Acupuncture. They provide various therapies like Physiotherapy, Speech Therapy, Occupational therapy, Acupuncture, Moxa, Acupressure, , Psychological Testing and Counseling, Music Therapy, Dance therapy, Prayer, Picnic, Recreation activities, Yoga therapy. The hospital has a capacity of 50 beds and nearby 100 patients on an average avails the service as out- patients. On an average 50-60 special children are treated free of cost. Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,00/- has been provided for extending their facility towards education for special children, and construction of School Building for these disabled children.

 Construction of 3rd Floor for training and other income generation programmes for the special children - Chetna Association Bilaspur - North Zone - Shimla

Chetna Association Trust was established in 1998 at Bilaspur. Special school has been set up by Chetna at Bilaspur, Ghumarwin and Jhandutta providing overall development facilities like, need based education, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, vocational training, Sports and games, culture activity etc to nearly 150 children. Presently they have registered 800 athletes with all disabilities for sports under Special Olympics in district Bilaspur. They have also provided many training like SSA home- based Program, income generation program and targeted intervention project for Truckers, Training of Care Givers

etc. Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of 3rd floor,

which is useful for carrying out activities like running 2 special school for intellectually challenged and community- based program of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan and also helpful for rehabilitation of the mentally retarded children in the field of health, academics, sports, vocational training etc.

• School Van for transportation of mentally challenged children to School - South Central Zone - Siri Institute for Mentally Handicapped – Rajahmundry DO

"Siri Educational Society (Siri Institute for the Mentally Handicapped), Samalkot was formed in the year 1994 for providing teaching and training for mentally challenged below the poverty line children and to achieve the goal of rehabilitating them. It covers three Mandals with three branches i.e. Samalkot, Anuru (Peddapuram Mandal), Prathipadu (Prathipadu Mandal), covering 80 villages and providing services for both hostel (for 75 children) and day scholars (180 children). They are also providing vocational training programmes on Detergent Powder manufacturing, Tailoring, Embroidery, book binding, basket weaving, leaf plates making unit, relief, rehabilitation to mentally challenged persons particularly children from poor, rural and semi-urban families who are otherwise condemned. Trust had requested fund for School Bus which would be purely used for

bringing the children to their three centres. Presently they are using the services of auto to bring day scholar students to their three centres which is not safe for these children. Financial assistance of Rs 12,67,620/- has been provided for purchase of School Van for transportation of mentally challenged children to school.

#### • Construction of Vocation Training Centre -Heritage Culture Art and Education Development Society - Western Zone - Kolhapur Division

Heritage Culture Art and Education Development Society (HCAEDS) Trust was Registered in the year 1994 for promoting development related programs and activities focusing rural and tribal women, children, youth and farmers .Education is the core purpose of Heritageso they started school in 2004 to provide quality education & skilled education to the people and conduct different activities like Grafting, making Utne, making food items, showpiece,

light fitting training etc in school, which is useful for the employment of the students. They have also carried out two orientations training programme for SHG's and consumer group, Grampanchayat member and IWMP committee member. Among 11 villages, in 3 villages 5 orientation training were organized and around 303 people were benefited. Trust had requested assistance of Rs 27, 70,520/- for additional building on the same plot and this vocational training centre will be helpful for employment of the people.

Financial assistance of Rs 25, 00,000/- has been provided for Construction of Vocational Training Centre.

#### • Vehicle - Aarambh - Western Zone - Thane Division

Aarambh Trust was registered in the year 1997 and working in the slums of Turbhe (Navi Mumbai), it enrolls underprivileged children in schools and provides them free tuition. The school was started with three rooms and 30-40 students, now they have own building and approximately 2000 students are studying there. Trust runs pre schools in six slum communities of Navi Mumbai where mothers can leave their children. Over 400 children below five years attend the pre schools every day. Most of the mothers work as housemaids. They have 22 teachers and 8 other staff members .The school provides mid-day meal to the students and conducts various extra-curricular activities for the students like tree plantation, yoga, street plays, cleanliness drive etc. They wanted financial assistance for purchase of vehicle to pick up such children in four trips and drop them after School, a total of approx

100 children would be benefitted. Apart from this, the elder sibling can also attend school,

which would otherwise have to remain at home to take care of the younger ones. Financial assistance of Rs 14,80,844/- has been provided for purchase of vehicle.

• Construction of hostel, mess for deaf & dumb children from tribal area on school itself -Junnar Education Society's Mukbadhir Vidyalaya, Junnar -Western Zone - Pune DO I

Junnar Education Society was established in 1935 with the aim of Education to all category students for the purpose of generous personality. They have six branches of education i.e Shankarrao Butte Patil Vidyalaya & Junior College, R.P.Sabnis Primary School, Shankarrao Butte Pail English Medium School a Pre Primary & Primary Section, Govind Vasudev Joshi (Gujare) Balak Mandir, Late Bansilal Mohanlal Mukbadhir Vidyalaya.. "Junnar Education Society's Mukbadhir Vidyalaya" was formed in the year 1985 & started in the year 1987 with 40 blind students (both boys & girls). The area is deep rural and maximum students are from nearby area. It was very difficult for the students to travel every day, hence Mr

Anil Joglekar has given his building for hostel. Now 28 students are living in that Hostel. Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been sanctioned for construction of own Hostel, Library, Mess and workshop for deaf and dumb children from tribal areas.

• Tata CNG- Integrated Institute of Rehabilitation for the Disabled – Viklang Samekit Punarvas Sansthan- North Central Zone – Agra Division

Integrated Institute of Rehabilitation for the Disabled formally called Viklang Samekit Punarvas Sansthan was established in 2005 at Agra for taking care of the marginalized sections of people who are suffering from disability especially those in agony, and children suffering from cerebral Palsy, Autism, mentally retarded and visually handicapped, hearing problem etc. IIRD is running Special education centre for challenged children and provide special education, speech therapy, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, play therapy and activities of daily living etc. In May 2016, the organization has done a survey in Agra city, where they have screened more than 500 Divyang people, suffering from different types of disease like mentally retarded, cerebral palsy, autism, deaf and dump. Out of this there were

35 children who were in very bad condition, the organization is taking care of these children and provided residence to 20 children and day care facility to 15 students for rehabilitation. Financial assistance of Rs 5,97,365 has been provided for purchase of CNG TATA Magic Bus for transportation / caters the need of mentally and physically challenged children.

#### • Bus 10.75 H 3\*2 (40+1) - Matrubhumi Charitable Trust - South

#### **Central Zone - Warangal Division**

Mathrubhumi Charitable Trust, Narasampet, was established in the year 2006 to provide housing, food, and clothing, good education and life skills to orphaned and impoverished children to become a Good Citizen of India. The organization is recognized by the women and child welfare department. Trust is honored by District Collector Warangal for Best Children care Award on 14.11.2015. MBCT have own building in area of 3500 sq ft which is donated by Dr Bomineni Gopal. This building accommodates boys and girls hostel, study hall, library, canteen and office but they don't have facility of School College. Presently trust is having 53 Orphan children from 5 years to 18 years from LKG to intermediate classes going to different schools. The 17 children are going to Hanuman Deval, 7 small children from 5 years to 11 years going to Mandala Primary school (Telugu Medium), 6

students from class 6th to 10th going to Zilla Parishad. High School, 5 students from inter mediate are going to Junior college. These schools, colleges are about 1.5 to 2 km away

from the ashram. Financial assistance of Rs 17, 10,350/- for purchase of Bus 10.75 H 3x2 (40+1) has been providing for transportation facility to orphanage children.

# • Construction of School Building First Floor -Satavali Panchkroshi Shikshan

### Sanstha, Satavali, Ratnagiri, Maharashtra - Western Zone - Kolhapur Division

The Satawali Panchkroshi Shikshan Sanstha (SPSS) Trust was registered in the year 1969 and the school was started in 1969 at village Satawali in Lanjataluka of Ratnagiri District,

Maharashtra, which is a hilly and economically backward region. Children from Satawali

and other neighboring villages are benefitted by the school. The school provides education to poor students of the area and so far nearly 1100 students have passed out from the school, some of them are doctors and engineers. They are also running High School and Science Jr. College where presently 374 students are studying free of cost. The high school and junior college has 16 teaching staff and it is having all facilities like Physics, Chemistry, Biology labs and library, but not in one place. Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction a two storied building where the school and college can be managed in single shift and Physics, Chemistry, Biology labs as well as library, ladies room, toilet can be provided in the same building.

# School Bus – Eicher 10.75 HSKY Line (32+1) - Suryoday Kelvani & Sanskrutik Mandal - Western Zone - Bhavnagar Division

Suryoday Kelvani & Sanskrutik Mandal was established in 2000 and has been working since last 20 years in the service of spreading education, social and cultural activities in Savarkundla town & rural area. The main activity being "Save Girl Child" and create awareness for girls social and educational field. The institute is carrying the activities of school by self-finance by charging very nominal fees from the students. They are providing free uniform, tie, belt, shoes, shocks, school bag to the students free of cost. At higher secondary level all girls' students are exempted from paying fees. The school has 58 employees and they provide education to 1300 students out of which 100 are totally exempt from fees. Financial assistance of Rs 17,13,997/- has been provided for purchase of school bus to provide transportation facility to female students from their residence to school.

• Three Braille Machines, four Computers and UPS to be used for blind - Vocational Rehabilitation Training Centre (regd.) for Blind- North Zone - Ludhiana

Vocational Rehabilitation Training Centre is registered under Registration of Societies Act

1860 under Registration No.123/1974-75. The institute was founded by Late Dr .E.M. Johnson who himself was blind and worked as consultant on Rehabilitation and Head of the Eye Research project and Orthopedics Rehabilitation project of the Christian Medical College and Hospital, Ludhiana. In 1978 it was converted into a fully fledged vocational rehabilitation centre with the help of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India and other agencies. The institute provides free educational, vocational services along with free boarding and lodging facilities to 175 blind and disabled persons institutionally every year and about 200 in the rural areas in the remote villages of Ludhiana District. Total financial assistance of Rs 11,51,860/- has been provided for three things i.e Purchase of three Braille Machines(including software) of Rs.9,43,000/-, four computers is Rs.1,83,960/- and cost of UPS is Rs 24,900/- to be used for blind.

# Construction of Kitchen & a dining hall attached to an existing school, construction of kitchen Ramakrishna Mission Boys 'Home, Rahara, Kolkata - Eastern Zone – KSDO

Ramakrishna Mission Boys Home, Rahara, Kolkata, is registered in 1909 with a mission of imparting education to destitute and poorest of poor section of children including orphan children. It is a residential school, imparting education and preparing students for self sustenance. The object of the Boys' Home is to maintain and educate these boys in its care in a manner so that they may grow into healthy self-disciplined young men, full of zeal with a sound moral foundation and as much general education as possible and also be inspired by a genuine love and regard for the glorious heritage of the country. The Home maintains and educates about 100 Scheduled Tribe Boys, entirely

free of any charge. They hail from extremely poor peasant families and are admitted here under the Scheduled Tribes Welfare Scheme of the Govt.of India. Financial assistance of Rs11,51,860/- has been provided for the construction of a kitchen & a dining hall attached to an existing school.

#### Year 2016-17

• Construction of hostel with basic amenities - LalaJagatNarain Himotkarsh Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Kotla Khurd, Shimla – Shimla DO/NZ

Lala Jagat Narain Himotkarsh Kanya Mahavidyalaya Shiksha Samiti, Una (LJNHKMV) is a charitable education society registered in 1998. It was formed topromote girls' education

especially higher education, vocational and technical education. Education is being imparted free of cost to orphan girls and girls from economically weaker sections from rural area.

Presently 582 girl are studying in the college. The college provides free boarding, lodging and free-ship to 20 orphans and poor talented girls.Funding of Rs 17,24,878 has been

provided for construction of dormitory, toilet for girls belonging to poor families.

 Construction for the extension of existing building for Primary School (Six rooms at Ground and First Floor) - Bharat Sevashram Sangh, Gangpur, Taluka Vansda, Distt. Navsari, Surat – Surat DO/WZ

Bharat Sevashram Sangh started a tribal welfare center at Gangpur in Navsari District of Gujarat in October 1997. It is a Branch of Bharat Sevasharam Sangha, Calcutta. The school works especially for the welfare of tribal & backward people and runs on "no profit no loss" basis. The school is situated in rural and backward area of Gujarat and the Trust is providing quality education to poor students, free of cost. Presently 765 children are studying in the school which is the first primary school at Gangpur, Taluka Vansda, Dist Navsari. The school has 30 teachers / employees to take care of students. The project authority works for noble cause of providing free education in the tribal area where people do not have easy access to education.

Presently the school has 30 rooms in a two storied building with total construction area of 23338 Sq ft. Funding of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of six rooms

(three rooms at ground floor and three rooms at first floor) with proposed area of 1362.75 Sq ft on each floor to accommodate more students, especially poor students living in Gangpur or nearby places.

• School Bus (Tata Star Bus) - Mamta Vidyalaya- An initative of Matimand Vidhyarthi Shikshan Mandir, Nashik – Nashik DO/WZ

The Matimand Vidhyarthi Shikshan Mandir (MVSM) was established in the year 1981 and registered under Society Registration Act and Trust Act. Its objective was to start special school for mentally retarded children and accordingly Mamata Vidyalaya was started at Amalner, Jalgaon District of Maharashtra, which is the only special school for such children in Jalgaon District. Mamta Vidyalaya is for the mentally challenged students up to the age of 18 years.

The Trust started "Savali Project" which is an experiment to engage the mentally challenged and economically backward children in agricultural activities, thus making them productive members of their families. The school has purchased 6 acres land for agriculture and the income generated from the crop is to be given to the children.

Presently, 50 children from economically weaker sections are studying in the school and all facilities are provided free of cost. Apart from special training to the mentally challenged children, the Centre provides uniforms, food, library, audio visual teaching program, scholarship, free medical checkup, free health advice, speech therapy, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, functional academics with pre-vocational skills, facilities for imparting life skills and arts.

The mentally challenged children commute from home to school and back by auto rickshaws and private vans, which is not safe. Funding of Rs 14,45,870/- has been provided for purchase of a school bus for transportation of the children to the institute and to drop them back at their residences.

### • Swaraj Mazda van - Radha Institute for Mentally Retarded – Secunderabad DO/ SCZ

It is the first institute in the State of Andhra Pradesh to initiate pre-vocational and vocational training programme for the mentally challenged persons. They have 120 students in the institution from whom no fees are charged.

Funding of Rs 15,78,210/- has been providing for purchase of a 32 seater Swaraj Mazda van for transportation of mentally challenged children.

 Tata Star Bus Ultra School (56 seater bus) - Shree Pragna Chakshu Mahila Seva Kunj – Bhavnagar DO/WZ

Shree Pragna Chakshu Mahila Seva Kunj (PCMSK), Surendranagar, was established in 1995 and has been working since last 20 years in the service of blind students. PCMSK runs primary education from Standard 1 to 7, starting with basic programme of Braille reading and writing and High School where education is provided to blind girls. PCMSK is providing food, clothing, hostel, medical treatment and education facility free of cost to around 175 blind girls at present. The school has 15 teaching and 8 non-teaching staff. The institute is running Computer Training Course, Canning Diploma Course and Beautician Course (Hair & Skin Care) which is ITI recognized. It has won may National level awards including "Rashtrapati Award".

Funding of Rs 19,00,000/- has been providing for purchase of Tata Star Bus Ultra School (56 seater bus) for transportation of blind students.

# • Construction of School Building - Dr K. B. HedgewarShikshanPrasarak Mandal - Goa DO/WZ

Dr. K. B. Hedgewar Shikshan Prasarak Mandal established in Panaji City is imparting elementary education in mother tongue. The aim of the School is to develop the best that is in the children, so as to prepare them for challenges of the changing world, through encouragement of self-discipline, intellectual upgradation and physical fitness. The School has achievements in all the fields i.e. academic, sports, cultural, quiz, elocution, debate etc. The school is running competitive exam training centre, Indian classical music school, Vedic Mathematics training centre wherein students from other schools are also benefited. The school which began with 20 students has today grown up as a full-fledged institution imparting education from K.G. to Junior College with the strength of 1350 students. The school is having 39 teaching staff on regular basis, 16 lecturer on contract basis and 12 non- teaching staff along with 10 other staff members on contract basis. The school is receiving Salary and Maintenance grant from the Government for High School section and only maintenance grant for Primary Section. No grant is received for Pre-Primary Section. Funding of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of school building for students of pre-primary, primary, and secondary and higher classes.

# • Construction of 5 classrooms, 1 Head Master Room - Koyana KhoreVidyaVikas High School, Shirwali -Satara DO/WZ

Koyana Khore Vidya Vikas School situated at Shirwali Taluka, Mahableshwar is run by Mahabaleshwar Takuka (Koyana Khore) Vikas Mandal, Mumbai (MTKKVM) which is aTrust registered at Mumbai in 1986 by few residents of the villages who were working at Mumbai. The objective is to provide education to poor students of around 15 villages in the neighborhood who cannot afford to go and study far from this place. It is in deep rural area around 35 kms from Mahabaleshwar, where majority of the people are from poor financial background. The school was built on one acre donated land. It has done an excellent job of providing education particularly to girlswho are 40% of total students. The school is receiving

100% government grant since 1993-94. The school provides free education to 175 students from classes V to X. The school has 11 teachers/employees to take care of students.

Funding of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for the construction of class rooms of junior college for higher education to the students who pass out of class X from the school.

• Construction of school building - Nimar Abhyudaya Rural Management and Development Association - Indore DO/CZ

Nimar Abhyudaya Rural Management and Development Association (NARMADA) was set up in year 2010 to extend helping hand to the deprived villagers in the Nimar region of Madhya Pradesh with a focus of providing pre-school and primary education programs across the villages. Initially, non formal schools or education centers known as "Narmadalaya" were started in few villages only. From Academic year 2015, a formal school Ramkrishna Sarda Niketan has been started at LepaPunarvas. 125students are enrolled in the school and majority of them are from economically weaker sections and 65% of students are enrolled free of cost. Funding of Rs 25,00,000 has been provided for construction of school building on the land specially purchased for the purpose at village Lepa Punarvas.

#### • Construction of Sanskrit class room - Gaudiya Mission, Bagbazar - KMDO I /EZ

The object of the Mission is preaching of Sri Chaitanya's doctrine of Universal Peace & Brotherhood. The objective is that the younger generation should learn Sanskrit to follow the scripts of Indian Philosophy. The Sanskrit class room is affiliated to "Rashtriya Sanskrit Sanstha" and thesalary of teachers and staff is paid by the Gaudiya Mission. The cost of day to day management of a cyber library which is free for students is collected from donation and subscription of members.

Funding of Rs 12,25,257/- has been provided for construction of the Sanskrit class room.

### • School Bus – Netra Vidyalaya Degree College for Blind, Sriramnagar- Hyderabad DO/SCZ

Netra Vidyalaya provides education for the blind in India and is a part of the Jeeyar Educational Trust (JET) founded by HH Sri Tridandi Chinna Srimannarayana Ramanuja Jeeyar Swamiji. JET provides free education, boarding, lodging, food, study material etc to blind students irrespective of religion, caste, colour and gender. Students use computers equipped with Braille software in the Netra Vidayalaya and state-of-the-art Braille Printer is also provided to them. Vocational training is also provided to the students in higher classes (grades) so that they can use the skills to become financially independent. They have 6 teachers and 2 other staff members to take care of blind students. Apart from that, they have

12 visiting faculty members to provide education to the students. Presently there are 120 students in the Netra Vidyalaya from whom no fee is charged.

Funding of Rs 13,73,273/- has been provided for purchase of a bus for Netra Vidyalaya Degree College for transportation ofBlind students from hostel to class rooms and examination centers.

# • School Bus- Tempo Traveller Mini SCB 17 Seater - Aanchal, St Gregorios Charitable Society, New Delhi - Delhi III DO/NZ

The St Gregorious Charitable Society (SGCS) is a non-religious charitable society formed and registered in the year 2010 to manage the affairs of project known as Aanchal, which is a centre for mentally challenged children. The Project was inaugurated on 26.10.2014 and out of 53 students admitted, 45 are from economically weaker sections and all the services are provided free of cost.

Funding of Rs 12,57,906/- has been provided for purchase of mini school bus (17 seater Tempo Traveller Mini SCB) which would be used for transportation of mentally challenged children from their homes to the Aanchal centre and back.

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• Construction of School Building. - R.S.S. Jankalyan Samiti, Latur, Maharshtra – Sanvedana Cerebral Palsy Vikasan Kendra, Latur, Aurangabad - Aurangabad Division/WZ

RSS Jankalyan Samiti (Maharashtra Prant) (RSSJS), Latur was registered under Society Registration Act 1860 on 9.2.1973. 'Sanvedana' Cerebral Palsy Vikasan Kendra (SCPVK) is run by RSSJS since last 10 years. 'Sanvedana' imparts education, therapeutic services, vocational training and aims to help children with cerebral palsy to join the mainstream of the society. Presently 50 children are benefitted from this project. They have 21 staff members including special educators, speech therapists, physiotherapist, psychologist, doctors, care takers and other clerical staff. The institution has received Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Samaj Bhushan Award from Govt. of Maharashtra for the year 2014-15.

Funding of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of own new school building which would benefit 100 children with cerebral palsy.

School Bus (Tata Star bus 36 seater ) - Vivekananda Loksiksha Niketan - Kharagpur DO/EZ VLN is recognized by various government agencies for special adoption, juvenile justice,

welfare of persons with autism, cerebral palsy, mental retardation and multiple disabilities,

AIDs prevention and control, protection of women etc. They are running Swadhar shelter home for destitute women, Specialized adoption agency for surrendered or abandoned babies, Integrated Child Development Service project and crèches for children under 6 yrs of age, Children's Home under Juvenile Justice Act, Working women's hostel, Family counseling centre, Child line project for entire Purba Medinipur, Primary teacher training institute, Special DLED course of training to disabled students, Special B Ed study centre and Old age home for women above 60 yrs age. They are running Special School for visually handicapped and mentally retarded children and no fee is charged from them. These children have to be picked up and dropped at their door steps and also need to be cared by drivers and attendants which are not provided by private transporters. School bus has been provided for transportation of these mentally handicapped children.

• Construction of Handloom and Weaving Training Institution Building - Christian School, Molvom, Run by Kuki Christian Church (KCC) – Jorhat DO/EZ

The Christian School, Molvom started the vocational training institute for handloom and weaving in the year 2008. The aim of the establishment is to provide wider range of education through formal schooling and to promote skill development through vocational training institution of handloom and weaving for women. They provide vocational training opportunity for drop out girls as well as widows and house wives.

Since the establishment of the school, there has been an increase in the number of pass out students who are serving in various capacities and also trained weavers are earning their livelihood. Since the number of students have increased, therefore, construction of building for handloom and weaving training institute is required to accommodate more students and machinery. Funding has been provided for construction of building for handloom and weaving training institute.

• School bus (32 seater ) Ashok Leyland Stag Model : ALFBV 1/17 48+D - Badhit Bal Vikas Samiti, Badhir Vidyalaya – Ajmer/Ajmer DO/NZ

The basic objectives of BBVS are to provide quality education including vocational training to hearing impaired children without any discrimination of caste, creed etc. with the ultimate objective of making the students self-dependent and to enable them to earn their livelihood and live their life respectfully. BBVS is providing education including vocational training to 172 hearing impaired children free of cost.

The present bus being used for travelling of 40 deaf and dumb students was purchased in 2000-2001 with government aid and same needed to be replaced with new bus.

School bus has been provided for transportation of these handicapped children.

# • Construction of Ground + First floor of School building at Sullia - Rotary Charitable Trust – Udupi DO/SCZ

The Rotary Charitable Trust was formed exclusively for running school activities. The Trust also conducts Blood donation camps, medical checkup camps, distribution of books and uniforms to school children etc under its community service.

The school is unaided and runs on no profit and no loss basis. The school is situated in rural and backward area and the Trust is providing quality education to poor students.

Funds have been provided for Construction of Ground and First Floor of School building for poor students living in sulia and nearby places.

# • School Bus – Eicher 11.12K Starline - Shree Pragna Chakshu Mahila Seva Kunj – Bhavnagar DO/WZ

Shree Pragna Chakshu Mahila Seva Kunj (PCMSK), runs primary education from Standard

1 to 7 which starts with basic programme of Braille reading and writing. The institution runs

High School where education from standard 8 to 10 is provided to blind girls. Under its Integrated Education Programme, the institution has appointed 35 mobile teachers with the aid of the Central Government and about 1100 blind, deaf-dumb, mentally retarded children are being benefitted. The institute also rehabilitates the blind girls by arranging for their marriages to enable them to establish in the main stream of social life. PCMSK is providing food, clothing, shelter, medical treatment and education facility free of cost to around 175 blind girls at present. The institute has won may National level awards including "Rashtrapati Award".

School bus has been provided for transportation of its blind students at the time of Morning College, Medical emergency, appearing for examination with a writer etc.

# School Bus -National Association for the Blind – Gandhinagar DO/WZ

National Association for the blind, Gandhinagar is undertaking activities associated with the education, training and employment of the blind and disabled in the Sabarkantha District, Gujarat State. It is working towards the upliftment of the disabled and provides all services free of charge to the blind children.

The organization also works to prevent disabilities by surveying rural areas for pregnant

women suffering from malnutrition or those who are unable to afford medicines and medical checkups. The centre arranges for visits from professionals such as physiotherapists, psychiatrists, psychologists and ENT specialists. Since inception, it has helped more than 5000 disabled persons.

The institute has arranged for children pick up and drop through local transportation which is like open rickshaws is not safe for blind students. School bus has been provided to bring the children from their remote places and to drop them back.

# • School Bus - Annamma School for Hearing and Physically Handicapped and Baby Care Centre – Machilipatnam DO/SCZ

The main objective of Annamma Organization for Hearing and Physically Handicapped and Baby Care Centreis to strengthen and empower mentally challenged children for their social and mental health. They provide Special Education services which include preparation of specially designed curriculum to meet unique need of children with Multiple Disabilities. They work for HIV/AIDS infected and affected people. Awareness and screening is provided for early identification, early intervention and prevention. They are providing vocational training and forming Self Help Groups with suitable training and networking training for infected and affected family members to work as volunteers at grass root level and other suitable services for better living with stigma free environment.

School Bus has been provided to pick up these disabled children from their home to the school and drop them back to their home. It will also be useful in participating in medical camps organized by

Government and private hospitals, to provide medical care to the sick children and transport them to the hospital.

# • School Bus - Vicharta Samuday Samarthan Manch – Ahmedabad DO/WZ

Vicharta Samuday Samarthan Manch (VSSM)was initiated in the year 2006 with the

mission to give social identity, dignity and voice to the various communities of Nomadic and De-Notified Tribes. Its objectives are to ensure that all the children from NT-DNT communities enjoy their fundamental Rights to Education, avail their fundamental rights and entitlements, to facilitate creation of alternate employment opportunities in lieu of the

traditional occupation that have been rendered obsolete with time and to ensure that the NT- DNT families obtain a roof, a place to settle and get an address of their own.

The girls of Vadia Village, for whom this hostel facility is developed, are although

unwillingly, forced to go into prostitution under the pressure of moneylenders from whom

these families or their forefathers have taken loan. The families live in utmost poverty. VSSM has taken the challenge to make them free from the clutches of moneylenders as well

as poverty and provide them equal chance of growth both financially and socially. The said hostel will not only serve as the platform for the girls of Vadia to become literate but also

pave a way to much better and brighter life ahead.

VSSM runs 4 hostels at different location in Gujarat (1 Boy's hostel in Radhanpur, 1 Boy's

and 1 Girl's Hostel in Doliya, Surendranagar and Ahmedabad). However, the newly built hostel in Ahmedabad has begun in June 2015 especially for the girls of Vadia.

School bus has been provided to these girl children presently staying in their hostel so that they can be sent to school safely.

#### • School Bus - Friends of Handicapped – Meerut DO/NCZ

Friends Of Handicapped –India was established as a public charitable Trust in June and

established three institutions viz. Vaani School & Research Centre in November 1997, Satyanand Vaani Training College for Teachers of the Deaf students in August 2007 and L.I.C of India Vanni School Vocation Training Wing cum Hostel in July 2014. These institutions provide quality vocational training to Handicapped students in various vocations such as Computer Courses, Fashion Designing, Accounting, Beauticians Course, Jewellery designing, Sports Goods manufacturing etc. It is conducting Diploma Course in Special Education on No Profit No Loss basis and prepares Special Teachers who provide education to Hearing Handicapped Students.

School bus has been provided for transportation of these Hearing Impaired and Mentally Challenged students/trainees from their homes in rural/semi-rural areas to school / vocational training wing and back home.

### •Construction of Assembly cum Classroom Building – Gohaldiha Jati Upjati Blue Bird Women's Welfare Centre - Kharagpur DO /EZ

The main objective of the organization is to eradicate the extreme poverty and ignorance among the children, youth, women and especially Adhivasi, Santhal, Munda, Bhumij and Lodha community hailing from remote villages.

The organization had started a primary school at Kharikamathani, in a small house with a few children. Apart from book learning, they are giving emphasis on physical education, different vocational training, recitation, cultural education etc for overall development of a child. They are also providing income generation skills through handicrafts, raising crops, poultry and livestock, fish farming and beekeeping.

Funds have been provided for Construction of assembly cum open teaching hall and Classroom to accommodate increasing number of students.

 School bus. - Parents Association for the Mentally Handicapped persons Manochaitanya – NetraVidyalaya Degree College for Blind - KarimnagarDO /SCZ and and and a sequence of the sequence of the

Parents Association for the Mentally Handicapped persons, Manochaitanya is a charitable organization registered as NGO with the Telangana Govt. to run special school for mentally Handicapped children. They provide necessary facilities of education and training for mentally handicapped children. They are running early intervention and stimulation programme for 0-5 years of children and Special school under integrated education programme for children

between 5-15 years of age. They are running Manochaitanya vocational training center and sheltered workshop forMentally Challenged Persons of 15

years age and above. The School is servicing the deprived section of the Society and it is being run from charity provided by different organizations.

School bus has been provided for transportation of these mentally handicapped children.

#### Year 2015-2016

 Construction of Kitchen Block, Toilet Block and Hostel - Sri Ramkrishna Ashram Batanagar/KMDO II/EZ

Sri Ramkrishna Ashram is a spiritual organisation having more than 170 branches in India and abroad. Ashram is running hostel for orphan and poor boys. They are providing

training to outgoing students after class VIII, Higher Secondary and Senior Secondary. They are organizing other activities for the boys like acupressure, pranayam, Vivekanand

Pathachakra, library etc. They are also running a Matri Mangal Kendra, a sewing school for girls. The organization has one homoeopathy and ayurvedic centre. Construction of Kitchen

Block, Toilet Block and Hostel on the first floor for boy's home will help orphan and poor boys. School Bus (Tata Star bus 36 seater) for Meerut Children Welfare Trust

### Mawana/Meerut/NCZ

Meerut Children Welfare Trust, a charitable organization registered as NGO with the UP

Govt. is running special "Disha School" for mentally handicapped children. They provide necessary facilities of education and training for mentally handicapped children. They are also providing Occupational training, Physiotherapy, Speech Therapy, Clinical Psychologist music therapy etc to them. These children have to be picked up and dropped at their door steps and also need to be cared by drivers and attendants which are not provided by private transporters. School bus has been provided for transportation of these mentally handicapped children.

• Construction of Rooms for Students along with common path rooms, toilets and General Assembly Hall - Sri Ramakrishna Students' Home Old Boarders Trust - Sirsi / Dharwad / SCZ Sri Ramakrishna Students' Home Old Boarders Trust is a unit of Sri Ramakrishna Students'

Home, Bangalore which is providing free boarding and lodging to 50-60 students selected on the basis of economic condition and merit. Students follow a routine by which they are encouraged to inculcate discipline in their daily life, learn simple living, develop integrity, embrace the cordial tenets of love of God, service to humanity, patriotism etc. Their emphasis on character building helps the students to improve themselves physically, morally, intellectually and to come up as responsible citizens. Apart from students, general public is also taking part in these activities regularly. Presently all the students are housed in four rented buildings. Construction of Rooms for Students along with common bath rooms, toilets and General Assembly Hall at first floor has provided all facilities under one roof with free boarding and lodging to poor and deserving meritorious students.

#### School bus (EICHER 10.9 L Starline 40 seater) - Swami Vivekanand Youth Movement - Saragur/Mysore/SCZ

State Award from Karnataka Government and National Award from Government of India recepient Swami Vivekanand Youth Movement is a Non Government Organization working in the field of education, health, community development services throughout the Karnataka State. The organisation is focusing on educating children in tribal hamlets, rural areas and urban slums. The key focus areas are tribal and rural health, ayurveda, reproductive and child health, hygiene and sanitation, care and control of HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis and disability. Apart from providing education, they have established a Hospital in Saragur with 103 beds and Nursing Institute. They have established Computer Labs and Alternate Schooling

Concept etc. They are running HIV programmes in rural areas and have Mobile Health Van Units to visit patients in forests. The tribal rural students face a lot of difficulties to reach school due to poor transportation facility and they cannot afford cost of transportation by private vehicles. This is becoming a major hurdle for the students in attending school. School bus for tribal rural students will provide transportation facility and encourage more number of girls from tribal community to join the school.

• School Bus 40+1 seater (EICHER 10.9 Star line) - Nava Jeevan Bala Bhavan Society - Vijayawada/Machhilipatnam/SCZ

Nava Jeevan Bala Bhavan Society is performing task of rehabilitating orphan/rescued/street children and children affected by HIV/AIDS and also children from SC/ST and slum areas of 17 Mandals of Krishna district. They believe in Education as a tool to transform and break

the generational poverty. The children rescued from street life are brought immediately to round the clock shelter and provided basic needs. Apart from providing education including vocational education and providing health care for girls, the society is also providing support to the girls against child marriages and also against cases of domestic violence. School bus is used for commuting orphan, rescued street children, children affected by HIV/AIDS and working children from the marginalized sections from various homes to respective schools within the city and also for organising educational camps and medical purposes.

• School Van (TATA Winger) 13 seater - Society for Awareness and Holistic Activities by youth (SAHAY) - Ramnagar/Rajahmundry/SCZ

SAHAY is a nonprofit organization having objective to identify mental disabilities in children and provide boarding, lodging, medical aid, uniforms, special free education, skill

development, rehabilitation and recreational facilities to multiple disabled and mentally challenged people. Special school called "Hrudalayam" is being run by SAHAY where

physiotherapy, speech therapy, special school, hostal facilities, food are provided free of cost to children along with free vocational training and hostel accommodation to mentally

retarded people without age limitation. They are providing free shelter for missing persons received from district child welfare committee through child line services. School Van

provided for reaching the remote places particularly in the deep rural areas for the children of the school to move from home to hospital and other needy places.

# School Bus (Tata Star Bus 26 seater) - Samata Shikshan Prasarak Mandal - Satara Satara Division /WZ

Samata Shikshan Prasark Mandal works for children, youth and adults with various types of disabilities, primarily those with physical disability, mentally challenged, have delayed development, speech, hearing and other disabilities. The main objective of the school is to strengthen and empower mentally challenged children for their social and mental health. School has hundred percent results in the Xth standard State Board exam and all of them have passed with excellent grades. Vocational training and skill development provided along with teaching main subjects help students get employment opportunities at various small scale industries in M.I.D.C. (Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation). The distance between the hostel and the school is about 3-31/2 kms and 175 students studying in the School are residing in the hostel. As all the students are physically and mentally challenged, it will be easy for them to commute from the hostel to the school on regular basis by School Bus.

• Construction of Coaching cum Training Centre – Ramakrishna Math, Bagda, Asansol DO

The Math is catering to various mankind services in different fields of human need, looking after medical services, relief work and to uplift the downtrodden masses. The Math is providing free coaching classes and training classes to boys and girls coming from nearby villages. The Math is arranging seminars, symposiums, cultural programmes etc so that the boys and girls of future generation may imbibe the values of selflessness and fellow-feeling at an early stage of their life. Construction of Coaching cum Training Centre is for the boys and girls from class I to class IV of the downtrodden families from the adjacent villages.

# • Construction of Vocational Training Centre – Sarada Seva Sangha, Howrah DO

Sarada Seva Sangha is a humble charitable organisation, started by a group of dedicated women inspired by Swami Vivekananda's ideal of 'Service to Man is Service to God'. They got the necessary inspiration and guidance from the monks of the Ramakrishna Order. They run a free coaching centre for 150 poor children studying from class I to XII running six days a week. They are teaching English speaking, moral and cultural values. The students are provided nutritious snacks every day. They are given books, note-books, a set of dress,

toothpaste, brush, soap, Blankets etc. Construction of one floor of existing building for Vocational Training Centre will be utilized for educating socially and economically deprived women.

#### • Construction of School Building – Ranapara Gram Bikash Kendra, Howrah DO

Ranapara Gram Bikash Kendra was established in 1996 by a group of dedicated social activists of Amta 1 Block with a view to undertake developmental initiatives in the locality

especially for empowerment of women and children, aged and other underprivileged sections of socioeconomically backward communities. The society is located at village Ranapara on

the bank of the river Damodar. In rainy season due to heavy rain flood occurs and the poor villagers suffer due to miseries, food insecurity and acute poverty. The Kendra is providing

education, training and all types of rehabilitation services within age group of 1-18. They also provide community based, home based rehabilitation and training for adult boys, girls and

women free of cost and all the beneficiaries come from the poorest of poor families of rural areas. Construction of school building will bring all these scattered children in the proposed school building and provide educational facilities under one roof.

Construction of Assembly cum Classroom Building at Ground and First Floor - Gohaldiha Jati
 Upjati Blue Bird Women's Welfare Centre, Kharagpur Division

The organisation started at a tribal dominated backward block in the district of Paschim

Medinipur. The area is surrounded by the river Subarnarekha and the land types are undulated, hilly and full of forests. The main objective of the organization is to eradicate the extreme poverty and ignorance among the children, youth, women and especially among the tribal communities of the area. The organization had started a primary school at Kharikamathani, in a small house with a few children. As the student's strength is increasing day by day and has reached up to 817 in the year 2014, they will be able to accommodate them by constructing classrooms at the ground and first floor of the institution.

• Construction of boy's hostel building - Avvai Ashram (a unit of Gandhigram Trust), Tirunelveli Division

The Gandhidham Trust emerged with the blessings of Gandhiji in 1947 under the leadership of Dr. T.S. Soundram and Dr. G. Ramachandran, the disciples of Gandhiji. Gandhidham Trust is involved in various activities viz. health, education, social welfare and knowledge management. Avvai Ashram is a unit of Gandhidham Trust which is a surrogate for 57 children, mostly from very poor families, orphan or have single parent. Construction of boys hostel building will help them to accommodate more students.

# • Braille Press - Shri Krushna Kumarsinhiji School & Home for Blind Trust, Bhavnagar Division

The institute was established by the Maharaja of Bhavnagar State for providing education and vocational training to the blind persons. The Institute is providing formal education from KG to 12<sup>th</sup> standard to the blind children. The Braille lipi education is being given from nursery to 8th standard in primary school and also from 9th to 12th standard, education is being given as per the syllabus of higher secondary board of Gujarat State. Vocational training is also imparted to students in the form of nylon work, electric motor rewinding,

computer, music and home science for blind girls. Braille Press will cater to the needs of the blind students of the School so that every blind student can receive the study materials in all the subjects which will assist them and enhance their learning process.

# • School Bus – Jeevoday Education Society, Nagpur Division

The School is engaged in bringing these children into mainstream and making them

employable without discretion of caste, creed and religion. Jeevoday has undertaken training, education and rehabilitation of the intellectually challenged youngsters. They are providing them various therapeutic exercises, exposure and opportunities to bring them into mainstream of the society. Mentally challenged children are trained for different skills related to self- earning such as Tailoring, Carft work, Embroidary, Book binding, File making, Candle making, Chalk making,Card making etc. School bus will be utilized for mentally challenged children.

# • School Bus – Bhikku Sanghas United Buddist Mission, Amravati DO

Bhikkhu Sangha`s United Buddhist Mission is the active Regional Member of the World Fellowship of Buddhist. The main objective of the Apang Mukbadhir Seva Sansthan

Vidhyalaya School is to educate the disabled students and students suffering from hearing impairment. They have built up a huge monastery named as "Sarvodaya Maha Buddha Vihara"in Mumbai and are doing monasterial services for the people in General. They are also running a special Deaf & Dumb residential school for handicapped children and also

supporting them. They are running a boys hostel for students since last 20 years. Hundreds of students have benefitted from it. School bus will help in minimizing the hardships faced by the students due to non availability of transportation facilities.

# • Construction of School Building - Dr. K.B. Hedgewar Shikshan Prasarak Mandal, Goa Division

# Dr. K. B. Hedgewar Shikshan Prasarak Mandal established in Panaji City which is imparting

elementary education in mother tongue. The aim of the School is to prepare the children for challenges of the changing world, through encouragement of self-discipline, intellectual upgradation and physical fitness. The School has achievements in all the fields i.e. academic, sports, cultural, quizzes, elocution, debate etc. The School is running competitive exam training centre, Indian classical music school, Vedic Mathematics training centre wherein students from other schools are also benefited.

# • Bus - National Association for the blind, Mumbai DO II

National Association for the Blind has been formed with the mission of helping to raise

education and skills of visually challenged persons in India and make them independent.

Purchase of Bus will be utilized to transport visually impaired children to the Home Based Programme Centre, Rehabilitation centre, Teacher Training Centre, Work Centre, Exposure Visits, Get Together, Sports and Cultural Meets etc.

### • Construction of main gate, toilet, Information of Basic Technology Room, Library Room, Compound for entire school and compound wall - Bhandari Education Society, Kolhapur Division

Bhandari High School at Malvan was established in 1897. The school is developing skills in its students. It has 1100 students. Activities such as Home Science and agriculture with vermiculture compost fertilizer are conducted in the school. The students have also succeeded in starting their vermiculure compost plant with herbal plantation garden on their own. Construction of IBT Room will help students to get knowhow for modern technology of Engineering, Home Science, Agriculture and other rural employment avenues.

### Year 2014-2015

#### • School Bus - Ramakrishna Mission, Aalo, Jorhat Division

Ramakrishna Mission, Belur Math has started a School at Aalo for the Arunachali tribals in 1966. It was started in a thatched building with only 35 students. Gradually, with the passing of time, the School added on accessories such as a Dairy - to provide milk nutrition to the residential tribal children, a poultry - to provide meat nutrition for the residential tribal children, an agricultural field in the campus wasteland, utilizing the refuse of the dairy and poultry – to provide vegetables to the residential tribal children, a printing press - to provide writing material for the school children, a whole section of vocational training such as tailoring, carpentry, industrial workshop, computer, etc. School bus will help the parents/guardians of the students who are coming to drop their children to school from hilly tribal area.

# • School Bus 26+1 seater - Karunamayee Parents' Organization for the Mentally Handicapped, KSDO

The organization is imparting special education, therapy and medical attention among

challenged children mostly coming from BPL and unprivileged community. Organisation is involved in activities namely special education at individual and group level, Nutrition supplement, Medical Checkup, counseling, treatment, skill training, parents training programme, delivering lectures in local schools, community awareness programme etc. School Bus will help them to provide transportation facility to more number of children.

# Construction of School Building - Bhalopahar, Asansol Division

Bhalopahar is a Society for Culture, Ecology & Rural Development. It is located at Bandwan block of Purulia District, West Bengal in the border of Jharkand and Orissa. Their aim is to build a formal school for education with rural development, ecology, conservation of folk culture and tradition, primary health care and community hygeine, farming and cultivation. They have changed the dry and empty landscape into a lush green forest with small clearings for cultivation of rice and other food grains. There are total 200 students in the School from whom no fee is being charged. Construction of School Building to have an environmental school with hostel and regular playground and other facilities wherefrom all students will graduate in future.

# Construction of first and second floor of students home - Ramakrishna Mission Sevashrama, Silchar Divison

The Sevashrama conducts a Students' Home for the benefit of poor students, provides medical help to hundreds of poor patients, supplies nutritious food and medicines wherever

necessary. The Students' Home (hostel) is for poor and tribal students who study in classes between VI and X. This Students' Home was founded in 1963. With its limited financial

resources and grants-inaid from the Government, the Sevashrama has been providing food and accommodation to 63 tribal boys. These tribal boys belong to different tribal communities like Naga,

Kuki, Hamar Chorai, Barman, Khasi, Reang, Tripuri and Chakma. The Government bears all their expenses.LIC construction of floors of students home will provide them the better environment for stay.

### • School Bus – Cherry Blossom Society, Jorhat Division

The Society is running a School viz. Cherry Blossom School for both normal and differently abled children. Cherry Blossom School is one of its kind where importance is given to educate every child irrespective of caste/creed/race/disability. They give therapy to the Disabled children studying in school as well as out door disabled children get therapy in the therapy department. They also encourage parents to be counselled. The bus will be utilised

for the transportation of these children so that more number of children can attend the school.

# School Bus – Organization for Friends, Energies and Resources (anandghar), KMDO II Organization for Friends, Energies and Resources(OFFER) is a non-profit organization working towards uplifting the condition of underprivileged children in Kolkata and other district of West Bengal for last 28 years. OFFER and its various projects provide institutionalized and specialized healthcare, education, psycho-social support to children with HIV/AIDS, especially abled and mentally challenged children and also cater to the needs of

5,000 children. Children are also encouraged to participate in cultural programmes, extra- curricular activities, attend events, functions and meet important dignitaries from all walks of life.

## • Construction of School Building – Ushagram Trust, KSDO

Ushagram Trust is a non-political, non profit and rural voluntary organization which was formed in 1980 with six like minded people of the area. Ushagram Trust is a reputed organization is West Bengal. It has taken several charitable activities for holistic development of all classes of people through their various educational missions. They are

conducting workshop on teaching methodology and adult literacy programme in villages. The purpose of the project is to spread further literacy in the area and opening up of new opportunities to the drop outs. They will construct classes for primary school, Teacher's Training Room, space provision for up gradation of the school from primary level to upper- primary level and opening of adequate library for children.

### • TATA Winger – Sirisha Rehabilitation Centre, Machilipatnam

Sirisha Rehabilitation Center is a voluntary service organization with the main focus of

working for the training and rehabilitation of children with mental retardation and other

associated disabilities. The Centre is running a special school with residential and day care facilities. They are providing special education with supporting services of Therapeutics, Sports, Games, Recreational and Cultural trainings etc. They are taking care of 50 students in the Institution from whom no fee is charged.

# • School Bus 40 seater - School for the Blind run by 'Service Association for the Blind', Gandhinagar Division

Service Associaltion was founded to make 1% of the Indians who are blind, literate and independent to bring them in to the main stream of Society. It has surveyed more than 80

villages of Gandhinagar district and started blind school in 1995 at Kolwada Taluka, Gandhinagar. The Institution permits admission to children, irrespective of their religion,

state, caste, creed, culture or class. They provide facilities of hostel, mess, medical aid, uniform and all the necessary supplements to children without any charges. LIC 40 seater

School Bus for the Blind students for making mobility easy and participating in various educational and cultural activities, tours and to reach various avenues in order to impart musical programs.

### • School Bus 40 seater - Aakansha Shiksha Kalyan Samiti, MDO II Division

They are providing education to students belonging from Nursery class to 10th class. They are also providing computer knowledge to adivasi children form Panvel and Palghar area.

They organize different educational trips to various places where children can learn several things. They are also helping the street children who do not go to schools. The school bus will be used for pick up and drop facility to the poor students who stay far away from the school and also for taking children to picnics and field trips.

# • Bus (36 seater) - Ashirwad Trust for Disabled Sayla, Bhavnagar Division

The trust was founded in 2002 with the help of noted NGOs of Gujarat to offer a superior service to people with disabilities. The main activities performed by the trust are centre-based activities which are conducted in the name of two stations: the Ashirwad Day Care Centre (Sayla) and Kshamata Kendra (Limbdi). The day care resource centers provide guidance and training to 60 children with multiple disabilities. The 36 seater bus is used for children who come from the poorest section of society.

• Construction of 3 classrooms, 1 laboratory and Veranda - Koyna Education Society (Apati High School), Satara Division

Taldeo is the village situated on the top of mountain in Koyana river valley. In 1957 the construction of the lifeline of Maharashtra i.e. 'KOYANA DAM' was started by Government of India. In the Koyana river valley many small villages are situated and villagers are very poor. Many villages were affected due to the dam construction. Rehabitation of many villages was taken place by the Government. But people from these villages didn't move anywhere.

They placed themselves on the bank of back water of Koyana dam. Due to the need of these people,Koyana Education Society was established in 1964 and the society started New English School, at Taldeo in 1967. LIC construction of proper building will be for poor and needy students.

•Construction of Respite Care Centre – Sobti Parents Association, Thane Division

Sobati Parents Association was formed in 2004 when parents of children with blindness or mental disabilities got together primarily at the behest of National Association of Blind (NAB) professionals, to create a separate organization to take better care of vocational and other training needs of these children. Sobati runs with association of NAB. Students are guided and encouraged to take up primary, secondary and higher secondary exams conducted by Thane Municipal Corporation. The Association runs two centers one at Thane and one at Andheri where 18 blind students with multiple disabilities are being trained under special teachers. Once the construction of Respite Care Centre will be completed, the Association has proposed to cater to 50 students.

# Year 2013-2014

 Construction of a staff room, one class room, two class rooms for vocational training, one audio visual multipurpose hall and amenities on the first floor of building Jyoti Special School, Bhopal Division

Jyoti Special School, Bhopal is run by Christu Jyoti Society, Ujjain. The School provides education and training to the mentally disabled children to ensure their integrated development and to integrate them with the main stream of the society. Jyoti Special School is special school for the mentally challenged children in Bhopal. Many of the children are those whose parents were victims of the gas tragedy in Union Carbide Company twenty years ago. Construction of a staff room, one class room, two class rooms for vocational training,

one audio visual multipurpose hall and amenities on the first floor of building on the land owned by Christu Jyoti Society, Ujjain will help them to provide education and physiotherapy to children from weaker sections of society.

• LIC Special School Bus - Institute for the Handicapped and Backward People, KMDO II Division

The Institute is a socially responsible non profitable NGO running a composite Special Sector School for the disabled children free of cost. The Institute is working in 29 blocks under

South 24 Paraganas and Kolkata district. The key target groups are Backward Classes, SC/ST, Muslim Children and among them girls and children with disability. Special School Bus will help in ferrying the differently abled students to the School.

• Construction of Ground Floor of hostel building - Shyamchak Pratibandhi Kalvan Samity, Paschim Medinipur, Kharagpur Division

The Shyamchak Pratibandhi Kalyan Samiti was started with the spirit of sharing, love and deep concern for the rural poor and handicapped children. The activities of Samiti consist of arranging eye operation camps for aged persons, Blood donation camps, providing toilets and supply of clean water to the villages. The Samiti has 321 students out of which 208 are residential and 113 are day scholar. They have 135 Mentally Retarded students along with 99 Hearing impaired students and most of the students are orphans. Construction of Ground floor of hostel building for orphan students will help them to provide sufficient place to accommodate all the students.

• Construction of three training halls, a library and a toilet on ground floor of building - Prerona Pratibandhi Sishu Bikash Kendra, Jorhat Division

It is a prime institution in the North East with a mission to empower for proper rehabilitation, early intervention, education, therapy, vocational training, leisure skills and full participation

to ensure equal right to live for the differently abled children. This Institute is situated at Cinnamara, 3 kilometers away from the main township in a lush green campus. The main academic and administrative building has facilities for different activities like physical therapy, vocational training etc. The Training units will be used to develop trained manpower so that they are better equipped to take care of the persons with disability.

# • LIC TATA Star Bus - Odisha Patita Udhar Samiti, Bhubaneshwar Division

Odisha Patita Udhara Samiti was formed in 1999. The organization provides community based services in far flung areas and aims to change the behavior of the prisoners for social mainstreaming by providing education and psycho-social support to their children. The main Activity of the Samiti is to identify the children of the prisoners of different jails of Odisha by establishing proper rapport with the jail superintendent and the prisoners. Thereafter the children of the prisoners are brought to the hostel namely Madhur Mayee Adarsha Sikshya Niketan for providing them proper accommodation and healthy environment. This bus will be used for transportation of the children residing in the hostel to reach different schools of Bhubaneswar in time.

# Construction of Chemistry Laboratory and Physics Laboratory - Shoshit Seva Sangh, Patna Division II

The institution was established with an aim to provide state of art facilities, comforts and

education to the poorest, landless and deprived children of one particular community – "Musahars" Soshit Seva Sangh started a fully free English medium residential school for the children of Musahar Community. As there is lack of literacy and education in this community, all the new admissions are in the pre-school class (UKG). Total 314 students are provided with facilities viz. free boarding lodging, food, textbooks, healthcare, computers, library and uniforms, bedding and stationery free of charge. Construction of laboratories will be useful for children.

# • LIC TATA Magic Bus - Kalyani Charitable Society, Kanpur Division

Kalyani Charitable Society is constituted for training and education of physically, mentally and socially handicapped children. The school is providing special education, physiotherapy, speech therapy, behavior modification, vocational training, conveyance, parental counseling, home based programmes for children who cannot attend regular school and interactive sessions for teachers. TATA magic Vehicle for transportation of mentally challenged children will help them to accommodate more number of children.

#### • Swaraj Mazda Sartaj Model School Bus 24+1 seater - Saksham Trust, Meerut Division

The Trust is running a School for the physically/mentally challenged children with the help of some individual/institutional donors. The School is providing all the facilities of a day-

boarding school to its children including breakfast and lunch. The School is having 68 children who come from different areas of National Capital Region. Since 90% of children

are from extremely poor families, all these services are provided free of cost. 24+1 seater school bus will be useful for low income visually impaired multi handicapped children.

# • Construction of Training Centre with housing facilities at Block A – Swayamkrushi, Secunderabad Division

Swayamkrushi, a voluntary organisation located in Trimulgherry Secunderabad, is dedicated to the rehabilitation and integration of adults with developmental disabilities. Established in

1991, it was the only institution of its kind in India and has spearheaded the movement to increase awareness and inclusion of adults with developmental challenges in the community. They place the challenged individuals in 'Group Homes' and provide them supervision and training. The project will improve the living and economic conditions of the disabled persons.

# • Construction of disabled friendly school building – Greenlife Charitable Trust, Kottayam Division

Green Life Charitable Trust was formed to help the physically and mentally challenged

persons and also rehabilitate patients with cerebral Palsy and other disabilities. Presently Green life charitable Trust runs two schools one at Kottayam and the other at Palai and have a total strength of 60 children. Jyothis is a project started by the Trust and is a special school for children and is providing services like early intervention, special nutrition, infant stimulation, developmental therapy, special education, disability advisory clinic and supply of special rehabilitation equipments. The school building will have a training centre with

special features to serve the disabled children population of Kottayam and adjoining districts.

# Construction of free dormitory at Kasturba Gandhi Kanya Gurukulam &

# Construction of free dormitory facility on first floor of Sri Thayumanavar Vidyalam, Vedaraniam - Kasturba Gandhi Kanya Gurukulam, Thanjavur Division

The Kasthurba Gandhi Kanya Gurukulam Trust was established in the year 1946 by Sardar

A.Vedaratnam, an active freedom fighter, in Vedaraniam, a coastal village in Nagapattinam

district of Tamil Nadu. The Trust is engaged in rural development activities in the surrounding villages and has established training school and conducts training programmes. The Trust runs various Institutions as follows. Nearly a hundred children attend the school from the neighboring villages. In addition Kasthurba Gandhi Kanya Gurukulam Teacher Training Institute for Women was started in the year 2004 wherein 550 students have completed the two year course for primary teachers. The new hostel/dormitory will give opportunity to the poor students as well as those who are living in the surrounding areas to reside and learn.

# Construction of Ground Floor of School Building - Shri Manik Prabhu Shikshan Samiti, Raichur Division

Shri Manik Prabhu Shikshan Samiti is a non-profit, secular and non sectarian registered voluntary organization carrying out its activaties in the most neglected and backward area of northern Karnataka. The Samiti has set up a Special School for visually handicapped children, an orphanage and a hostel for students from backward community at Maniknagar in the Bidar District of Karnataka. There was no such institution in the district. Presently 79 blind children are pursuing their studies in this school free of cost. This building is of immense help to the visually impaired children of the region.

# • LIC 54 seater Bus – Fellowship of the Physically Handicapped, MDO I Division

The Institute was founded in 1956 by Smt. Fatima Ismail as a small workshop for a few adults with disability with the aim of providing training and mutual support to each other. The Institute runs on a no profit basis and provides vocational training in various trades to

physically and mentally challenged individuals. They provide the trainees with free breakfast and lunch and also provide subsidized transport facilities. The Institute serves those adults who have orthopedic disabilities and are in the age group of 18 to 40 years. LIC Bus will

help them to transport the trainees residing in the eastern suburbs of Mumbai to and fro from their residences.

# • Construction of 5 class rooms, 2 toilets and corridor area – Jeevan Vikas Trust, Surat DO

Jeevan Vikas Trust is a Public Charitable Trust established in 1972 to help mentally retarded children by giving education and training to enable them to become economically self- sustained and developed to lead a healthy and normal life. The Trust runs a School cum Institute which operates a day care school and training Institute for mentally challenged children. They provide these students basic skills and fundamental concepts which helps

them function as independently as possible in their daily lives. Construction of 5 class rooms,

2 toilets and corridor area will provide better amenities to the children of the Trust.

# Construction of three Classrooms in School Building. - Samaj Prabodhan Vyaspeeth, Kolhapur Division

The Samaj Prabodhan Vyaspith has been registered under Mumbai Public Trust and the jurisdiction is Sangmeshwar Tahsil Dist, Ratnagiri region. Their objective is to propagate

advance systems in education in the backward region among the masses by establishing educational complex including secondary school. The Institution spreads education among

the masses through Educational Institutes i.e. Functioning Secondary School, Junior & Senior College, Technical School College. Additional class rooms will enable them to provide better services to the candidates.

# • Construction of one Conference Hall, two Rooms, two Toilets, Verandah - YMCA Gandhidham, Rajkot Division

The YMCA Gandhidham is a locally registered society and is also affiliated to the National Council of YMCAs of India. The main aim of the Institute is to provide job oriented courses to the people at the lower strata of community for their capacity building and develop their skill within a short period in order to enable them to secure a gainful employment. Construction of 1 Conference Hall, 2 rooms and 2 toilets and verandah which will enable them to impart education and skills to prepare the youth for entrance tests and examinations like Indian Police Force, Army/Navy/Air Force etc.

# • LIC 32+1seater School Bus - All India Disabled Rehabilitation Educational Institute, Nashik Division

All India Disabled Rehabilitation Educational Institute for the mentally retarded children was started in 1984 and is serving the mentally retarded and the hearing impaired children

residing in the vicinity of Nashik. The aim of the Institute is to make educational facilities available to the disabled, to impart training and try to provide necessary training for mental

development so that they become useful citizens. They provide vocational training such as production of chalks, candles etc. according to their mental and physical ability. There are

250 students presently in the school and no fee is charged. LIC 35 seater school bus will provide to and fro conveyance facility to disabled and mentally retarded children from their houses to school.

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# • Purchase of School Bus - Kshitij Trust's Kshitij School for mentally retarded Children, Mumbai III Division

Kshitij is a Trust started by three women Mrs. Anita Dalvi, Mrs. Lakshmi Ranganathan and Mrs. Gouri Govekar, who decided to start a project in order to do something for the mentally challenged children. Kshitij School organizes medical checkup camps for mentally challenged children, Occupational therapy Camps, Parental guidance Seminars, Exhibition and sale of craft articles made by the school children, awareness program for Dental check up, health and hygiene etc. LIC school bus has facilitated the children a safe commuting to school and back home safely. **Year 2012-2013** 

# • LIC School Bus - Arushi Society, Bhopal Division

The Society is highly reputed and is providing physiotherapy, speech therapy, computer training and vocational training to the disabled persons. The Organization has undertaken several initiatives for the betterment of the differently abled persons such as development of instructional material for visually impaired in alternative formats, placement of persons with disabilities, computer training centre, Panaah, a home for the mentally challenged, a pre school for children aged 0-6 years and several community based Rehabilitation programmes. LIC School bus will be used to carry these children to school and back to hostel.

- Construction of Building Paschim Banga Rajya Pratibandhi Sammelan, Howrah DO The organization is providing permanent shelter and training to develop Mentally & Physically Challenged Persons. Also they are taking steps to increase their self maintenance capacity and to enable them to take part in productive activities for their economic rehabilitation. The new Building will enable them to accommodate more number of mentally & physically challenged Persons.
- Construction of Library cum study centre and residential ladies hostel Chandanpiri Sri Ramakrishna Ashrama, KMDO II Division

The organization has been relentlessly working for the socio-economic empowerment of the rural community especially for the vulnerable community by implementing various development projects with the help of dedicated volunteer force and experienced employees. The number of students in Class V to Class VIII is 165 of which 86 are girls. For the children belonging to the economically distressed families, a free coaching center has been

functioning for last several years. The new ladies hostel will enable them to accommodate 30 poor girl students studying in the classes Class V to Class VIII.

# • Construction of Classroom cum Activity Hall – Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya, Jorhat Division

Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya is a service mission helping in nation building and

development of poor country people. The functioning of the Vivekananda Kerndra Sivasagar

started on 3rd May 2010 and is presently located at Amolapatty of Sivavsagar district which is a rural area about 13 km away from Sivasagar Distt Hq. The Vidayalaya takes up various activities for the welfare of the people of nearby villages, like entrepreneurship training, personality development camp, youth leadership programme, women awareness programme, health camps etc. New Class room cum Activity hall will enable them to run activities after school hours and during the holidays for activities for upliftment of the neighborhood.

Construction of a Hostel Building for boys – Don Bosco Development Society, Kolkata for RUA
Youth Centre Oodlabari, Jalpaiguri Division

Don Bosco Society Kolkata centre was established in the year 1997 and runs an English medium school for boys and girls. Rua Youth Centre, Oodlabari is a part of Don Bosco School Kolkata. It was formed to cater to the tribals, Nepalis and local underprivileged

children through the initiative of Salesians of Don Bosco in the year 2002. The school is located about 50 kms from Jalpaiguri. It is basically in a forest area inhabited by the people of local tea gardens. There are total 754 students upto class VI and the school is being upgraded every year and will be seeking affiliation to ICSE Board. A good number of children will be able to complete their studies by staying in the hostel.

# • Construction of first floor of Hostel Building – Dr. Issac Santra Balniketan Phulijharan, Sambalpur Division

The institution was established in 1979 and provides educational development to orphans and

destitute children who are living in remote socially and economically backward areas which are having a high level of illiteracy. The institute is taking care of 55 inmates in the hostel building. The new hostel building will enable them to accommodate the girls separately.

### • LIC TATA Winger School Bus – Nai Dharti, Patna II Division

Nai Dharti is an NGO, registered u/s 21 of Societies Registration Act 1860, providing food, shelter and education to the deprived girls. The organization provides education, shelter, rehabilitation and economic empowerment through various programmes. They have an all women Executive Committee consisting of teachers, bankers and social workers. There are

50 students out of which 20 are residing in Hostel and 30 is day scholar. The LIC Bus will enable them to provide better services to students.

### • LIC vocational centre - Badhir Kalyan Samiti, Jodhpur Division

The institution is a registered NGO working since 1984 looking after (1) Gandhi Badhir Sr.

Secondary School, (2) Gandhi Mook Badhir Boy's Hostel & (3) Gandhi Mook Badhir Girls Hostel at Jodhpur where free education is being imparted to at present 196 students who are deaf and dumb. It is an institution providing education free of cost and hostel facilities to hearing and speech impaired students. Construction of Vocational Centre will be benefit to the children of the School.

### Construction of Rooms and Toilet blocks in girls hostel – Vanyasi Kanya Chhatrayas Samiti, Haldwani Division

The Samiti is working for the welfare and rehabilitation of children of families who suffered

in Naxalite and terrorist hit North Eastern parts of the country and are dedicated to working for the welfare and development of girls from such areas. They are providing free education to the 75 girls from class III to Graduation level and encourage cultural development and inculcate Indian Patriotism. The construction of rooms and toilet will be used as residential purposes of ST girl students in the organization's campus at Jagatpura.

# Construction of four additional classrooms - Isha Education, Vellore Division

Isha Foundation is a nonprofit NGO with headquarters at Coimbatore. "IshaVidya" is the rural school initiative of Isha foundation carried out under a separate trust viz."Isha Education". Their aim is to provide high quality school education to underprivileged rural children who cannot otherwise afford it. Seven such schools are running in the villages in the districts of Coimbatore, Erode, Nagercoil,, Tuticorin, Villupuram, Salem and Cuddalore which are serving 3450 children.Construction of additional classroom can accommodate 40 children and the laboratories will help in providing better education and improve the infrastructure of the school.

# Construction of Golden Jubilee Hall - VidyabhivridhiSangha, Shimoga Division

The society is running the school since 1962 spreading literacy activities in the area. Their aim is to provide quality education through Audio-visual teaching aids like computers, LCD Projectors, CD Library etc. which help the students to comprehend the concepts easily. It has a Kannada medium high school section, Arts & Commerce pre-university college section, Computer school section and Music school sections are unaided. Construction of a

permanent building to house the Laboratory, LCD projector hall and improve the existing library by procuring more books, CDs etc to cultivate a reading habit amongst the children.

### Construction of College Building – Anathasevashrama Trust, Shimoga Division

The Trust is catering to the needs of the rural poor people by providing education,

particularly financially and socially backward people. The Trust provides education to the economically backward from all over Karnataka irrespective of caste and religion and students who cannot afford the fees to be paid to get admission in advanced, high-tech P.U. colleges in bigger cities. The Trust is running 14 different educational institutions for

Primary, High School and ITI in Maladihalli and 6 Institutions in the State. A total number of

3094 children are studying in the Institution. The new college building for Sri Raghavendra

Independent P.U. Science College will facilitate poor students of rural area.

# • Construction of School Building – Taruna Bharathi Trust, Shimoga Division

The Trust came into existence as a brain child of committed activists, volunteers and youths to work for the protection of the national pride, national sentiment and national fervor. Since then several programmes have been held, literary and cultural shows have been staged to showcase the character and values of our country. The Trust runs a High School, a Higher Primary School, Two Kindergartens and "Matru Bharathi" for women and "Bala Gokula" for kids. The School caters to the education needs of about 540 students. The new school

building will motivate children intellectually, physically, psychologically, emotionally and spiritually ensuring the overall development of a child.

# Construction of Golden Jubilee Science Laboratory and Library – Ikkeri Education Society, Shimoga Division

Ikkeri Education Society is a registered society and is undertaking various activities in the field of Education, Culture, Music, Growing of plants etc. The Society started in 1966 for the

purpose of promoting education in the surrounding areas for Higher Secondary as there was no High School. The inhabitants are mostly from families which belong to socially

backward, socially oppressed class and agriculture laborers. The Society is running a High School – VIII, IX and X standard classes and 100% result is registered in 2011-12. More than

3000 students have completed their secondary education in the School so far. The establishment of Library and Science Laboratory would enable the children to understand the subject in a better manner either by observing or by personally performing the experiments.

# • LIC School Bus – Shri Vidya's Centre for Special Children, Secunderabad Division

The institution is imparting training/education to a group of around 150 children from different places in the city. The centre has a day school as well as residential facility, which caters to 50 students. The school also conducts extracurricular activities like music and dance, excursions, games and cooking. LIC Bus will enable them to transport children for daily sessions of physiotherapy and school daily to improve their quality of life.

# • LIC 26 seater School Bus – Dr. Narendra Bhivapurkar Andh Mahavidyala, **Amravati Division**

This is a residential school which provides education upto 7th standard. They have a batch of 16 students for higher education for 8th, 9th and 10th standard and they attend a zonal parishad school which is 4 kms away. The School also has a branch at Paratwada which is 6 kms away from Amravati and provides education to blind children till 4th and 5th standard.

These children are transported home after their vacation. There are 175 students in the School. LIC school bus will be used to transport children of 8th, 9th and 10th standard to school and also to develop the students personality in areas such as sports, music etc. by taking them to participate in various activities related to these areas.

# • Construction of First Floor & Renovation of Ground Floor - Dhaulwalli Gramvikas Mandal, Kolhapur Division

The School is situated in a rural area of Rajapur Taluka and is working for the education of children in backward area. They are having 350 students on rolls studying in 5th to 10th standard out of which fee is waived for 269 students. Construction of First Floor & Renovation of Ground Floor will enable them to provide education to more number of children.

# • Construction of ground floor of school building - Deevalaya Trust, Dharmapur DO

The Deevalaya Schools (both primary and secondary with higher secondary unit) are situated on Dhamni road, Fulwadi Village, which is a remote underdeveloped tribal area in South Gujarat and is 11 kms from Dharampur town and caters to children coming from Dharmapur and Kaperpada talukas. Deevalaya Trust is working for the poorest of poor people in tribal area. Ground floor of school building will consist of two class rooms and library of the school building which will be benefit to the children of the School.

# Year 2011-2012

# • LIC School Bus - National Association for Blind under Raipur Division

This organization is managing a hostel with training centre for Blind, deaf, disabled girls with 14 employees. This organization is caring for shelter, education and vocational training to these people. LIC school bus for blind children with the capacity of carrying 95 students will help the organization to carry students to the school.

# • LIC Hostel – Nimtouri Tamluk Unnayan Samity, Kharagpur\

The samiti is working for education, health, cultural development and rehabilitation of backward and disadvantaged group of society for last 10 years. Their aim is to help the differently abled children and young adults to become self sufficient and self reliant adults helping them to develop their potential to the maximum of ability. LIC hostel building will be used for girl's hostel to provide them facilities of education and vocational training.

# • LIC AC Bus – AHEAD, Rehabilitation and Research Institute

The Institute is running a school for the mentally challenged and autistic children to provide them professional education and therapy for overcoming the various disabilities from which they suffer and also to provide guidance to parents/ guardians for forming self help groups. LIC bus will help in transportation of these children who are coming from distant areas.

# • LIC School Building – Voice of World, KMDO II

This is a multi unit multifunctional social welfare organization for the handicapped, the visually challenged children, orphans, destitute women, elderly persons detached form the families, mentally retarded children, etc coming from very economically backward families of rural Bengal. LIC school building will help them to run a junior high school with capacity of 120 handicapped students.

# • LIC Class rooms - Satgachi UP School, Kolkata

It is a primary school run by the committee constituted of eminent people of the locality. The School has taken the task of providing primary education which is considered to be the basic need for the children of maid servants. LIC Class rooms will help them to provide basic education to these otherwise deprived children.

# • LIC Three Class Rooms - Tibrinath Sangaved Sanskrit Mahavidyalaya under Bareilly Division

The college aims to promote and conserve Indian Culture and Sanskrit language and is a residential college based on Gurukul system. In addition to teaching Sanskrit language as per the University curriculum children are also taught Vedas/ Indian rituals/ music etc to help

them earn their livelihood. LICs three classrooms and hostel building will provide better services to 165 residential and 25 students on day scholar basis.

# • LIC School Building - SIRI Institute for Mentally Handicapped

This is an institute for training and rehabilitation of mentally handicapped children of rural areas who are illiterate and coming from poor background. They provide sheltered employment in their vocational units where profit of the product is given to the Adult Handicapped working in the units for their livelihood. LIC school building will enable them to provide better services to the mentally handicapped children.

# • LIC Class rooms – Vidya Prasarak Mandal, Dahisar

The aim of the institution is to cater an educational and cultural centre of excellence in the suburban of Mumbai providing quality educational facilities right from Jr. K.G. to the Management Degree under one roof at affordable cost to all sections of the society. LIC class rooms will help them to provide these services to more such students.

# Year 2010-2011

# • LIC four braille printers & school bus – Atma Jyoti Awasiya Drishiheen Kanya Mahavidyalaya Trust

The institution is providing free lodging and education to visually challenged students in and around Gwalior and the Project will help the Blind girls students for upliftment of their lives. LIC School bus will help for transportation of these students who are pursuing education at various schools and colleges in the city. LIC Braille printers will enable them to prepare books and notes for their blind inmates which will help in their students.

# • LIC School Building - Gopad Viklang Kshiksha Samiti, Katai under Shahdol DO This is a non-Government Organisation working for the all round development of the handicapped children of the tribal belt. The aim of the ashram is to open a vocational training cum ashram school for handicapped children. LIC School building will enable students to avail residential and non residential facilities of the school building. There are 60 residential and 15 non residential students at Katai.

# • LIC Roofing of open playground – Miriam Society for the Mentally Handicapped, Bhopal

The School is dedicated to the education and training of the Mentally Challenged. They are working for a noble cause which will lead to better health of mentally retarded people. LIC

roofing of open playground will enable these children to utilize it when weather conditions are adverse.

# •LIC Hostel - Bilaspur Sewa Bharti, Bilaspur

The Institution with utmost social objectives is committed to a noble cause of taking care of parentless, homeless children. They are working for the last 16 years on various projects viz. orphanage for small children 'Matruchahaya' hostels for remote (rural) Vanvasi children, child labour school, computer training centre and tailoring centre for girls. LIC hostel will provide rehabilitation of 380 destitute children.

# LIC hostel building – Bidhan Chandra Pratibandhi Karmakendra, Asansol

The institution is mainly catering to the needs of the poor, needy children of Burdwan and adjoining district of Bankura & Birbhum. Their aim is to ameliorate the condition of the disabled persons of their locality & bringing them back in the mainstream of society. LIC hostel building will help these children to make out a living for themselves.

# • LIC School Building – Sri Ramakrishna Sangha, Howrah

The Institution maintains a free residential students home for 60 poor and destitute boys. They are trained in different vocational courses. The institute is providing free medical facility and free training for repairing of Computer, TV radio, Motor Cycle, Scooters as well as Tailoring, Carpentry

etc to help the poor people earn and stand on their own feet. LIC School building will enable them to provide vocational training and make the students self reliant.

• LIC School Bus - Jalpaiguri Welfare Organization under Jalpaigiri Division It is a voluntary organization started in the year 1987 for the successful and meaningful rehabilitation of the differently abled children to the main-stream of the society through quality education and special care. LIC School Bus will be for 179 Disabled Students for their commutation to School who are scattered in and around Jalpaiguri.

### • LIC School building – Workshop for the Blind, Kolkata This organization is striving hard for the development of the poor visually impaired/ blind persons through special education with the help of Braille and Vocational Training for their rehabilitation. LIC school building will enable these blind persons to earn their livelihood.

# • LIC Vocational Training Centre – Kharagpur Utkal Vidyapith, Kharagpur The School is situated in a very prominent place of the town and their students mostly belong to economically backward sections of society. The school has 600 students mostly belonging to lower economic strata of the society. LIC Vocational Training Centre enable them to provide training for electrical and motor winding repairs etc to these students.

# • LIC Bus – The Institute for the Disabled, Bhubaneswar

The institute is especially aligned to social objectives of LIC by alleviating the suffering of the multiple handicapped children by providing various skills training. Their aim is to evolve strategies to offer diagnostic and therapeutic facilities in the field of Mental Health. LIC school bus will enable them to provide better services to these children.

# • LIC Wing - Saraswati Shisu Mandira, Balasore under Cuttack Division

The School is one of the best in Jaleswar area of Balasore District having ideology of Sikshya and Sanskar. LIC Wing will be available for imparting Computer education, library Facilities and Science Laboratory.

# • LIC School bus – Rajasthan Mahila Kalyan Mandal, Ajmer

The organization is working in the field of Mental Retardation since last 20 years. Their aim is empowerment of the deprived segments of the society through capacity building measures, including awareness and skill building; proper interventions enhanced by applied and improve the overall standard of life of underprivileged through mobilization of all possible resources. LIC will provide commutation of these children who are coming from far of area.

# • LIC Two Class Rooms - Disha Samiti, Bareilly

This is a well known school which provides free education and vocational training to physically challenged deaf and dumb children belonging to families which are below poverty line. They have been honored with Governor Prize and also "Bareilly Ratna" Puruskar. LICs two Class Rooms for Vocational Training Centre will enable approximately 160 mentally challenged students to avail the benefit of training.

# • LIC School Building - Gautam Buddha Academy, Khorabar under Gorakhpur DO

This organization is operating for overall rural development and general welfare of the poor since year 2004. They provide quality education at affordable rate to nurture all round development of young generation for making them responsible citizens. LIC GJF supported ground floor of the School Building in Academy will provide education to the children from weaker section.

# • LIC Class Rooms - Spastics Centre, Kanpur

This NGO strives to give persons with disabilities an opportunity to recognize and enhance their abilities to attain their maximum potential, and enable them to integrate in their community thereby improving their overall ability of life. LICs three class rooms will be used for special

education, vocational courses and physiotherapy for spastics children who can be an asset for the country, instead of becoming a liability.

# • LIC Wing - Assissi Vidyalaya, CHASS, Kottayam under Kottayam Division This Society is engaged in rehabilitation of mentally and physically handicapped children belonging to low income families to whom they provide Job Oriented Vocational Training. LIC Wing will provide for a skill oriented vocational centre.

# • LIC Second floor of school building – Sevalaya, Kasua Village, Chennai

This is a charitable trust which is engaged in a range of social projects which includes providing quality education at free of cost, orphanages, medical centre, library, vocational centres, old age homes as well as animal husbandry. LIC wing will help poor children to study in school and become self reliant.

• LIC School Bus - Abhayam School for Mentally Challenged, Thuvakode under Kozhikode Division

It is a charitable institution functioning since 1999 at Chemanchery near Koyilandy for the welfare of the mentally challenged people. At present there are 81 inmates getting training in routine activities, craft works and academic subjects and all the facilities are provided free of cost. LIC School Bus will enable them to ferry their students to school who are residing within a large radius.

# • LIC Class rooms – Bethashan Special School, Madurai

This school has been functioning for the welfare of Mentally Handicapped since 1996 providing them special education, rehabilitation therapies, vocational to achieve personal independence. LIC class rooms will enable the school to cater the needs of these children.

# • LIC ground floor of school building – St. Mary's HSS Pattom, Thiruvanathapuram

St. Mary's School is a learning centre and provides quality education without discrimination. LIC ground floor of school building will help them to start a student supporting service mission for the schools of Trivandrum districts, irrespective of any category.

• LIC School Building - Guild of Service – Home for the Blind, under Vellore Division Guild of Service is a voluntary service organization. Its aim is to improve the standard of education for blind children through Braille method. The school has been specially formed for the noble cause of imparting education to blind children from rual and economically weaker sections. LIC GJF has supporting in extension to School Building on ground floor and first floor for classrooms, computer room and library.

### •LIC Ground floor of school building – SMSM Higher Secondary School, Suchindram The School was started ninety years back during the reign of Travancore Kings and is located on the Kanyakumar Road. They caters to the educational needs of children whose families live below poverty line and they are mainly from the economically weaker sections of the society. LIC wing in the school will help them to provide better services.

• LIC School Building & Computers – Mithram Rural Information and Development Centre, Thiruvananthapuram

Mithram works for the welfare of the physically and mentally challenged people of Pallichal Gram Panchayat. It is providing employment training and conducting medical camps for the physically challenged. MRIDC has formed 745 self help groups who have been imparting capacity building and skill development training for physically handicapped persons. LIC School building will be helpful to the locality by way of catering to the educational needs of the differently abled children.

### • LIC first floor of school – St. Peter's Charitable Society, Thiruvananthapuram

This school is working for mentally challenged children since 1993. This school implements a special package of education, training and medical care to the mentally challenged children to make

them either normal or less dependent on others in their daily life. LIC wing will be used for library, physiotherapy, vocational, speech therapy, counseling and one classroom.

# • LIC Community Programme Centre – YMCA Rural Centres and Institute of Rural Development Marthandam

This institution has a long history of involving in various activities that empower the local people in sustainable livelihood generation. At present they are imparting vocational and skill

training in Bee Keeping & Honey processing to 40 SHG women & tailoring & embroidery to girls and unemployed youth. LIC community programme centre will enable them to provide better services in vocational & skill training.

# • LIC Wing - Sharadamba Education and Rural Development Society, Bahairumbe under Dharwad Division

The institution is providing free education from Play School to SSLC to the rural children with very high quality standard and discipline and it is situated in the backward regions of Karnataka At present there are 232 students studying in various classes. LIC Wing will be available for library and laboratory.

# • LIC School Bus - Zion Educational Society, Koppa under Rajahmundry Division

This is a Voluntary organization, working for the welfare of S.C., S.T., B.C. and Visually handicapped children those who are orphans, for the destitute and disabled. # • LIC residential Vocational Training Centre – Grameen Shramik Pratishthan, Aurangabad

Grameen Shramik Pratishthan is a voluntary organization working in the Latur District of Maharashtra since 1981 for the rehabilitation of visually challenged and orthopedic disabled persons under three different programmes, aimed at supporting the disabled to become self reliant and economically independent. LIC residential vocational training centre will help them to support their rehabilitation programme.

# •LIC seminar room and two lecture halls - Sree Narayana Mandira Samiti, Chembur

This is a registered charitable society under Bombay Public Trusts Act 1950. Their aim is to establish, conduct and maintain educational institutions such as schools, colleges and technical institutions. LIC seminar room and lecture halls will enable them to provide educational services to 5000 students.

# • LIC School Bus - V.D. Indian Society for Mentally Retarded, Malad

The Institute was established to help in detection, prevention & rehabilitation of mentally handicapped. It imparts training and education to pupils upto the age of 18 years through well qualified teaching staff. LIC school bus will help these children to be transported to the institute.

# • LIC Computer Centre – The Blind Relief Association, Bhopal under Bhopal DO

This is a leading institution for various welfare activities for blind in Bhopal for last 39 years where they provide food, clothing, medical facilities, education up tp 12th vocational & recreation facilities to the blind inmates free of cost. LIC Computer Centre will provide computer education to the blind students through a special software where they can learn by hearing the voice.

# • LIC Hostel - Sri Ramakrishna Vivekananda Sevashram, Annupur under Shahdol DO

The organization is working in the field of tribal girls education and health care since 1995 in Pushparajgrah block of Annuppur District. Their aim is to create awareness among the poor tribals of the area in general and women in particular through best possible education and health care, awareness towards positive social economic empowerment facilitating the development process for all round progress of down trodden. LIC Hostel Building will help these tribal girls to take free education.

# • LIC School- Sishupathsala H S School, Dhubri under Bongaigaon Division

It is one of the oldest and prominent School in the State of Assam and around 60 % of students of the School hail from the poor and down trodden section of the society. At present there are 625 students, LIC School will enable them give better infrastructure and increase the existing capacity.

# • LIC Equipments - Bhagat Puran Singh School of Deaf under Amritsar Division

The society runs five educational institutions for normal, special and deaf children. These schools provide free education to all students. Deaf children are provided free hostel accommodation, education as well as stationery. LIC equipments will be utilized for two additional classes in the school.

• LIC Wing – Mariampur High School, Kanpur under Kanpur Division

# • LIC Computer Centre – Bengali Tola Inter College, Varanasi under Varanasi DO This is one of the oldest Inter college of the City engaged in providing best education with the help of qualified and experienced teachers to the children who are economically backward on nominal fees. LIC Computer Centre will help them to provide job oriented / technical knowledge free of cost to around 1800 students.

# • LIC Wing – Isha Education, Coimbatore under Coimbatore Division

This organization was founded as a means to transform the lives of rural children by providing affordable, high-quality education where it is otherwise unavailable. At present there are 363 students from LKG through 4th standard. LIC Wing will enable them to increase the student body to 450 in the academic year starting June 2009, with roughly 60% of the student supported by full scholarships.

# • LIC bus, computer & office furniture - Mar Gregorios Rehabilitation Centre for the Blind, Kodunganoor under Thiruvananthapuram Division

This Organisation engaged in the rehabilitation of physically and mentally challenged destitute residing in six village panchayats around Trivandrum city and cater to their various needs i.e. Medical, Economic, social and educational needs for last twenty five years. LIC bus, computer & office furniture will enable them to provide better services.

# • LIC Class Rooms - Ramakrishna Mission, Kadapa

The institution is well known worldwide for its services and is fast growing with numerous activities in town. It is serving the needs of people from backward region of 'Rayalaseema'. The mission runs a free students home, conducts value education programmes in schools and colleges, runs a spoken English institute, conducts training for the rural youth in Horticulture and other areas and a free library and dispensary. LIC Class Rooms in School will enable more students to take education and participate in other various programmes in school.

# • LIC Library - Our Lady of Rosary High School, Dona Puala under Goa Division

The School caters to all round development of girl child. They give special attention to students having learning disability by having special resource room teachers to assist these children to be on par with the other children. LIC Library will enable to cater the increasing number of students and their multiple educational need.

# • LIC Bus - Sanskriti Samavardhan Mandal, Nanded under Nanded Division

The Organization is established with a view to educate and empower the deprived rural people of village Sagroli located on the borders of Maharashtra, Andhra and Karnataka. LIC Bus will provide transportation of students from surrounding ten villages radius of 10 kms.

# • LIC Vehicle for transportation of disabled children- Bhagwan Mahavir Viklang Sahayaya Samiti, Jodhpur DO

The Samiti is a registered body under Societies Act working since 1975 for the welfare of handicapped. It is providing calipers for physically handicapped and hearing aids to deaf &

mute. It is also engaged for rehabilitation of women by providing them self employment through its women cell. LIC vehicle will provide benefit in bringing handicapped persons,

deaf and dumb from villages to their centres for providing them Jaipur foot, calipers, wheel chairs and hearing aids.

#### • LIC Wing - Asansol Braille Academy, Burdwan under Asansol Division

The residential school for blind where free food, lodging, education as well as study material is provided to the inmates who belong to the poorest stratum of W.B. and also Jharkhand State. Already 45 students up to Class II and 15 administrative staffs man the organization, LIC Wing will enable them to provide education up to Class IV

#### • LIC Bus - Tapovan Manovikas Vidyalaya, Sriganganagar under Bikaner Division

This is a residential co-educational institute for mentally retarded children and is providing rehabilitative services since 1991. No fees is charged from the students. At present, there are 129 children in Day Care Centre and 60 in Hostel to whom they provide special education, speech therapy, physiotherapy and vocational training, etc. LIC bus will be utilized for transportation of their inmates who are coming to Day Care Centre from nearby villages and belong to poor sections of the society.

# • LIC Bus - Netraheen Vikas Sansthan, Jodhpur under Jodhpur Division

The Institution provides free Boarding, Lodging, medical facilities and studies to all their inmates since 1977. At present there are 363 students out of which 107 students are physically and mentally impaired. LIC Bus will be utilized for transportation of students.

# • LIC Auditorium - Pramilabai Chavan School for the Deaf managed by All India

# Deaf and Dumb Society, Delhi under Delhi Division II

This School provides education to deaf students and help them for their future progress and development. They have an arrangement with National Institute of Open Schooling whereby students appear for secondary examination. As on date about 280 deaf and mute students are on roll from nursery to 8th class. LIC Auditorium will be utilized for multipurpose educational use of children.

#### LIC Bus – Spandana Society, Warangal under Warangal Division

The Institute operates a Day Care and Residential Centre for both boys and girls with mental retardation and hearing impairment where they provide the education as well as vocational training and job placements to their inmates. LIC Bus will provide transportation to these inmates from their residence.

### • LIC Wing – The Victoria Memorial School for the Blind, Tardeo under Mumbai DO IV

This is one of the oldest institution in the service of the blind, since 1902 and it is dedicated to the education and rehabilitation of the visually challenged, making the institution with

futuristic perspectives. LIC Wing will enable them to provide better facilities to their inmates.

• LIC Wing - National Association for Welfare of Physically Handicapped (NAWPH), Chikhaldara under Amravati Division

This Residential School for the Blind, Chikhaldara was established in the year 1991 and has been working to educate visually impaired children from Melghat Tribal Region of Vidarbha. LIC Wing will enable them to upgrade the school up to Std 10th and to increase its strength up to 250.

• LIC Vocational Training Centre-cum-Hostel - Swami Satyanand Saraswati Vaani School & Research Centre, Meerut under Meerut Division

The Institution provides high quality academic education to 102 Hearing Handicapped and 28 Mentally Challenged students free of charges to enable them to become useful, productive and self supporting members of the Society. LIC Vocational Training Centre-cum-Hostel will provide the disabled not only variety of vocational courses but also courses which are challenging in their form and content.

• LIC Hostel - Shri Shah K.L. Institute of Deaf, Vidyanagar under Bhavnagar Division This institute is working for the hearing impaired children right from their birth for detection, imparting education, training and rehabilitation. At present there are 282 deaf students in the institution to whom they give all facilities free of cost. LIC Hostel will accommodate approximately 70 girls.

• LIC School Building - Sri Tulsi Pragya under Satna Division

The society was established for deaf children belonging to deprived and poor sections of the society. They are providing free accommodation, food, medical aid, clothing and other daily needs and in addition to vocational courses for these deaf students. LIC residential block of school building will provide residence to 125 blind and 100 deaf children.

# Year 2008-2009

- LIC Computer Laboratory Don Bosco School, Guwahati under Guwahati Division LIC Computer Laboratory will cater to 2000 students of Snehalaya, including Evening Batch students, who are coming from economically weaker section. It will also cater to the children studying in various schools managed by Don Bosco NGO's and other related educational institutes
- LIC Common Room for Multicultural activity- Dasghara High School, Hooghly Under Howrah Division

The school caters to a large section of underprivileged students i.e. around 1500 students will be benefited for using LIC Common Room for Multicultural activity.

• LIC School – Mohitnagar Colony Taraprasad Balika Vidyalaya, Mohitnagar under Jalpaiguri Division

This is the only girls high school in the area and around 55% of students come from lower strata of the society mostly below poverty line. LIC School Building for 750 such girls will help in spreading the education.

• LIC Library - Kharagpur Priyanath Roy Vidyaniketan, Malancha under Kharagpur Division

LIC Library will provide reading facility to about 1000 students and teachers of the above school as well as the people from surrounding locality.

• LIC Class Rooms – Barrackpore Girls High School, 24 Paraganas (North) under Kolkata Suburban Division

At present there are around 2500 students in the school from which 1900 get education at free of cost. Extension of School Building will enable the school to accommodate more students who are coming basically from rural area.

# • LIC Computer Lab – Patulia Girls High School, 24 Paraganas under Kolkata Suburban Division

The girls school is situated in deep rural area and LIC Computer Lab will impart free computer education to around 700 students every year.

# • LIC School - Gram Vikas Samiti, Samastipur under Muzaffarpur Division

LIC Gram Vikas School is committed to eradicate child labour and aimed at providing education to around 150 children from socio-economically weaker section who are working in fields, factories, and homes.

# • LIC Library - Navjyot India Foundation under Delhi DO-III

One innovative project that facilitates higher learning, the Foundation has set up a library under the aegis of Navjyoti India Foundation, which is being run under the tutelage of Dr.

Kiran Bedi, winner of the Ramon Magsasay Award and a very eminent personality in the realm of social welfare. The objective of LIC Library is creating an atmosphere for education and learning for the rural children which will provide them with books to help them in inculcating a habit of learning and also enhance creativity, expressions, confidence and responsibility amongst them. Around 100 students from government schools will be benefited each year.

# • LIC Residential Resource and Vocational Training Centre - National Association for the Blind (NAB) under Haldwani Division

LIC Residential Resource and Vocational Training Centre is for providing improved and regular training to 47 (5 yrs to 14 years visually impaired student) and 112 registered adult blind. This is the first and only institute in Kumaon Region working for the welfare of the blind.

• LIC Bus - Handicapped Development Council (Institute for Mentally Handicapped), under Agra division

The LIC BUS will facilitate to save the recurring expenses of the Institute incurred towards transportation of 131 mentally challenged students who are scattered through out the Agra City.

# • LIC Vocational Rehabilitation Centre - CSI Balar Gnana Illam under Salem DO

The infrastructure development provided at LIC Vocational Rehabilitation Centre will enable the school to contribute not only for learning of the group of mentally challenged children in a conducive environment but also help the children in their journey to become independent through development of mental faculties. It will accommodate around 136 students.

# • LIC Learning Centre - Malenadu Education and Rural Development Society, Sirsi under Dharwad Division

LIC Learning Centre will provide education to around 98 under privileged children and to promote all round development of the children of rural areas.

# • LIC Hostel – Vanvasi Kalyana, Chipageri under Dharwad Division

Vanavasi Kalyan is striving to inculcate value based development of boys of tribals and forest Dwellers in the fields of education, preserving and developing cultural activities, Health, Finance and protection of their interests to make them self reliant with self respect. At present there are around 50 students. LIC Hostel will increase their capacity and enable the poor tribal's residing in forest area, near Chippageri to attend school, which will help towards enhancement of literacy and economic condition.

• LIC School Building - Shri Chhatrapati Shivaji Sarvajanik Shikshan Mandal's Lok Vidyalaya, Tulsani under Kolhapur Division

This school is 42 years old which is on the way to Devrukh, Ratnagiri and 14 km away form Taluka Place. They want to provide modern facilities in the school i.e. school building, water facility, well equipped laboratory, computer room, library and Gymnastic hall etc. LIC school Building will give the education for 270 rural children in this area.

• LIC School Bus - Little Angels School, Bandra under Mumbai Division I

It is a school for multiple disabled children. LIC School bus will help in transporting such children from different parts of the city.

• LIC Hall - National Association for the welfare of the Physically Handicapped under Nagpur

LIC Hall is provided for around 50 blind handicapped, deaf & dumb children/ students of poor families. Imparting vocational training and education with hostel facilities are provided by the organization.

•LIC Residential & Vocational Centre for training the girls and women - Society of the Daughters of the Cross, Ankleshwar under Vadodara Division

LIC Residential & Vocational Centre will provide focus on integral development and empowerment of around 185 girls and women in the tribal area.

• LIC Vocational Training Hostel - Rural Health & Welfare Programme, Sakwar under Thane Division

LIC Vocational Training Hostel is situated in a very rural & tribal area 20 Km away from Virar.Hundred students will be benefited by this scheme every year by way of free vocational training and boarding, so that they can earn their livelihood.

# Year 2007-2008

• LIC Library - Anand Kendra, under Gwalior Division The Kendra has free schooling and hostel facility for Tribal children. LIC Library will Facilitate the children further.

- LIC Educational Wing Tinisuti Bima School, under Guwahati Division Tinisuti is a remote village in the backward tribal area under Guwahati Division. This is the only High School in the area. LIC Educational Wing will benefit about 300 students in the school.
- LIC Educational Wing Marudyan Primary & Junior High School, Dhanpota, Kolkata under KMDO-II

This school is situated in an under-developed block of Magrahat of South 24 Paraganas in West Bengal. LIC Educational Wing will provide benefit to about 600 students in the school.

- LIC Community Hall Sr. Secondary School Surani, under Shimla Division This school is located in a remote village Surani in Kangra distt.of Himachal Pradesh. Construction of community hall will fulfill multipurpose needs of the school. LIC Community Hall will benefit about 575 students in the school.
- LIC Educational Block Sai Vivekanand Vidyalaya, under Chennai Division-2 The school caters to the needs of the lower income group families. LIC Educational Block will benefit about 500 students in the school.
- LIC- School Library Govt. Upper Primary School, Bheemanad under Ernakulam Division

This school is situated in a very backward area in the district of Palakkad in Kerala. LIC-School Library will provide books and reading material to students who are unable to pursue their studies due to lack of infrastructure
