• Ganjam District Orthopedically Handicapped Welfare Association, Chatrapur- Eastern Central Zone, Berhampur DO,

The Ganjam District Orthopedically Handicapped Welfare Association has been working for the all- round development of people with disabilities since 1986. They have taken several steps for their education, vocational training, health, employment, self-employment and rehabilitation. They have a two-fold educational programme- community based and institutional based. In the former, they encourage children with special needs for their schooling in general schools and arranging for their specific needs like aids and appliances, scholarship, teaching and learning materials, school bags, uniform etc. Institutional based education is for students who are unable to go to general schools, for whom they are running two residential Schools- Samarth School for Mentally Retarded and Samarth School for Cerebral Palsy- with student strength of 60 and 54 respectively. The Association has requested contribution to construct the second floor at an estimated cost of Rs. 58 lakhs, out of which they have been able to procure Rs. 8 lakhs.

Financial assistance of Rs 5000000/- has been provided for Construction of 2nd floor of shelter home for the mentally retarded & cerebral palsy children.

• The Akshaya Patra Foundation, Rajajinagar - South Central Zone, Machilipatnam DO. The Project is procurement of distribution vehicles which would be utilized for distribution of hot nutritious mid-day meals to children of Government Schools in Gudiwada. This project is aimed at making a difference to the lives of beneficiaries by providing healthy nutritious meals which would drastically bring down malnutrition & other health hazards and enable the children to excel in their educational career

Financial assistance of Rs 2500000/- has been provided for purchase of two food distribution vehicle for distributing meals to school children.

Assam Centre for Rural Development, Rehabari –Eastern Zone, Guwahati DO Assam Centre for Rural Development has been working on various development issues such as health, education, women/ girls trafficking, women empowerment, disability, livelihood etc in various districts of Assam during the last 25 years. Since 2016, they are running two CHILDLINE subcentres covering Rani and Boko Block in Kamrup Distt with support from the nodal agency Childline India Foundation (CIF) Mumbai under the Integrated Child Protection Scheme of the Ministry of Women and Child Development, Govt. Of India.Through Childline sub-enters , they have received 15 to 20 cases every month from different areas but mainly from the remote villages and Char Chapori areas of Nagarbera, Kalahkash, Berabhanga, Tupamari, Goroimari, Jairpur, Loharghat in Rani and Boko area of Kamrup District. Most of these cases are related to child marriage, child sexual abuse, child labour, missing children etc.

Financial assistance of Rs 9,42,759 /- has been provided for purchase of Bolero- B4 BS6 vehicle for transportation of children rescued from women/girl trafficking and their rehabilitation.

• World Renewal Spiritual Trust, Eastern Central Zone, Bhubaneswar DO.

The World Renewal Spiritual Trust was established to promote and carry out research in the ancient Indian Culture Yoga & Philosophies in close liaison with Prajapita Brahmakumaris Ishwariya VIshwavidyalaya. In order to pursue the aim and to propagate the use of alternate energy through Yoga and Meditation among the people of Odisha one Spiritual Learning Centre has been opened at Haridamada Near Menedhasal, Bhubaneswar since 2016. The Odisha branch constitutes of a classroom with audio visual facility for sharing spiritual knowledge with 100 learners at a time along with an open auditorium to accommodate nearly 4000 participants

for imparting spiritual view towards life promoting mental peace which is key to healthy mind. The organization, besides conducting the usual sessions for spiritual students, also conducts special counseling sessions for older adults who may have difficulty with transitions of aging to manage their emotions, find new sources of enjoyment. They take efforts to help the elderly people to deal with frustrations and grief in life with equanimity as friends and family members pass on.

Financial assistance of Rs 22,02,200/- purchase of Eicher Starline Bus (24 +D) seater)for transportation of spiritual students from their homes to classroom and back. Roman Catholic Diocesan Social Service Society, North Zone, Ajmer DO.

Roman Catholic Diocesan Social Service Society (RCDSSS) is established in 1993 with an aim to improve the living conditions and general welfare of the poor people. At present, they are working with 27,563 Households in 1111 villages of 45 developing blocks in Ajmer, Barmer, Bhilwara, Sawai Madhopur, Sirohi, Jalore, Dungarpur, Kota and Chittorgarh districts of Rajasthan. Presently the said NGO has a program "Disha Aahar". Under this program the NGO is providing food to malnourished children and members of the vulnerable community on daily basis. For this purpose, NGO has requested funds for purchase of a Food Van so that they may able to approach needy persons at specific locations like brick- klin, mines, roadside dwellers & garbage collectors of urban areas and provide them food to survive. They provide food to 300 children and other vulnerable community members on daily basis for which they do not charge any amount from any of the beneficiaries.

Financial assistance of Rs 8,18,970/- has been provided for purchase of Arctic white magic 9+DBS VI (Mini Truck).

• Society for Service to Voluntary Agencies North Punjab, North Zone, Chandigarh DO Society for Service to Voluntary Agencies (SOSVA) started its activities in the year 1984 and is working as an NGO for enabling and empowering women/men through skill development in deep rural areas and coaching/guiding poor students. Being a mother NGO, they have conducted various projects through sub NGOs like Training of poor women in Skin & Hair Beauty Care at Amritsar, Cutting & Tailoring, Awareness against Drug Addition, Caring of elderly & chronically sick persons, Tailoring, Computer Operations. The Women & Child Development Department provides grant-in-aid for implementing various programmes for skill development of women from poorer sections. Training is imparted for six months in Computer Applications, Cutting & Tailoring and Hair & Skin. Funds are also provided for child nutrition and awareness against drug addiction. 82 Projects for imparting training to poor women in various skills were implemented for one batch by 58 NGOs and 1997 women were trained.

Financial assistance of Rs 8,51,276/- has been provided for Purchase of Ertiga Vehicle for transportation of members/employees working with SOSVA to training centres in far flung areas for supervision & imparting training/skill development.

• Asha Jyothi Handicapped Welfare Society – South Central Zone - Machilipatnam DO Asha Jyothi Home for Mentally disabled children is providing diverse services for development, education and rehabilitation of the children with physical and mental disabilities., Presently there are 61 staying there, among them 42 are orphans and remaining 19 are semi orphans have some relatives / guardians. Some children are bed ridden or wheel chair ridden. They have requested for purchase of vehicle which will be helpful for transporting the inmates to nearby hospitals whenever health problems occur.

Financial assistance of Rs 16,73,317/- has been provided for purchase of Tata Winger Vehicle for transportation of specially abled inmates to nearby hospitals.

• Sanskriti Samvardhan Mandal, Nanded – Western Zone - Nanded DO.

Sanskriti Samavardhan Mandal has established Utkarsha skill development centre in 2009 with aim to equip the unemployed rural youth with technical skill for their livelihood. They are constructing skill development centre. In the skill development centre, they provide variety of training programs. They have partnered with few corporates for various training programs besides farm related training programs provided by KVK. They support towards customized course syllabus, training aids etc. The fees for food and accommodation are paid by the trainees. The duration of the course is one month to three months.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of three rooms and passage at first floor for Utkarsha skill development centre to equip unemployed youths with technical skills for their livelihood.

• Sulabh International Social Service Organization, Deoria –North Central Zone – Gorakhpur

Sulabh has converted /constructed 1.5 million of individual household toilets in various states and union territories and also constructed and is maintaining more than 9000 public toilet complexes at important places all over the country which are being used by 20 million people every day. Sulabh has constructed more than 200 human excreta based Biogas plants which are linked with public toilets. It has also constructed 20,000 toilet blocks in the schools and colleges all over the country. They have requested funds for construction of 5 seated Sulabh Toilet Complex at Parmarthi Pokhara Deoria Shahar

Financial assistance of Rs 24,24,817/- has been provided for Construction of 5 seated Sulabh Toilet Complex at Parmarthi Pokhara Deoria Shahar for providing sanitation facility.

• Sri Sri Rural Development Programme (SSRDP) Bengaluru - North Zone – Karnal DO Sri Sri Rural Development Programme (SSRDP) under the aegis of Art of Living was founded in 2001with the single minded focus of empowering Rural India. The Ved Vignan Maha Vidhya Peeth in collaboration with SSRDP is conducting Skill Development & Entrepreneurship Programme and the goal of the project is to provide for skill development trainings. Sri Sri Rural Development Programme has requested for funds for Setting up Centre of Excellence for Skill Development in Kaithal and purchase of furniture and fixtures.

Financial assistance of Rs17,01,226.68 only towards supply and installation of Solar Lab, Toolkit AC Repair

• The Pelican Centre - South Zone- Ernakulam DO

The Pelican Centre, Kulayetikkara, Ernakulam is an NGO is registered with Niti Aayog Government of India and is involved in the rehabilitation of mentally deranged persons. The Centre was able to rescue more than 100 homeless individuals. At present, there are more than 165 inmates undergoing treatment. A new building has been constructed as the old building is fully occupied. They have requested for funds for construction of new kitchen and dining hall as the present kitchen and dining area are located around 250 meters away from the new Building, thereby making it difficult for the inmates to move three times a day in view of their infirmity and physical challenges.

Financial assistance of Rs 63,00,000/-has been provided for construction of Kitchen & dining hall.

• International Society for Krishna Consciousness - North Zone – Delhi DO II ISKCON East of Kailash, New Delhi is offering many social service activities such as the Food for Life program, i.e. distribution of nutritious and hygienic vegetarian to needy and poor people daily, in almost 10 areas of Delhi including AIIMS HOSPITAL, several slum areas, leper's colony, orphanage homes etc. ISKCON, Delhi had requested for funds for purchase of food truck for distribution of fresh food to needy people

Financial assistance of Rs 11,45,027/-has been provided for purchase of Food Truck. Jattu Trust - South Central Zone – Visakhapatnam DO

• Jattu Trust - South Central Zone – Visakhapatnam DO Jattu Ashramam has taken efforts and began to work in the area of environmental protection and its first USP is Solid waste management involving technology and passion to keep their place clean and tidy in coming years and also stand as an example of society driven effort. Their waste management centre collects, segregates different types of dry waste to process them thereby reducing the need of fossil fuel resources, forest resources, mineral resources etc. They need one electric three wheeler to take the children to schools, colleges and hospital and another electric cargo vehicle for extension programmes such as Swatcha Parvathipuram.

Financial assistance of Rs.6,83,167- has been provided for purchase of One Three Wheeler and One Cargo Vehicle.

• Project from Utpal Bipanna Sahayata Samiti (UBSS) – ECZ -- Cuttack DO

Utpal Bipanna Sahayata Samiti started its Journey in 1982 during the Cuttack Floods by serving the marooned people. It made its first valued contribution in the aid of the victims affected by the supper cyclone during the year 1999. The volunteers of the Samiti had cremated thousands of dead bodies and carcasses. Mayurbhanj is one of the most natural Cyclone prone districts in Odisha. In the last year very severe cyclonic storm "AMPHAN" and "YAAS- 2021" had affected the district which resulted in heavy loss of lives and property, Every year, natural calamities upset people's living in some parts of the district. The economic condition of the people of this locality is very poor. Most of the population is of tribals having only temporary houses with mud- wall and sloped roof with thatching or tiles which are highly prone to cyclonic disasters. During cyclonic disasters most of the villages don't have a safe space of shelter and as such the construction of cyclone shelter is very much essential so as to save their lives. In this context Utkal Bipanna Sahayata Samiti requested to LIC GJF for financial support to construct a (S+G+1) floor, cyclone shelter building in the name and style of "Ashray Bhawan" over the existing own plot.

Financial assistance of Rs 50 lakhs, has been provided for construction of stilt/ground floor.

• Women's Interlink Foundation - Eastern Zone – Bardhaman DO

Women's Interlink Foundation (WIF) is currently implementing Integrated Women, Child and Community Development Projects in 11 Districts of West Bengal. WIF is providing education through Integrated Projects in Red- light areas with 1300 children of women in prostitution. They provide an integrated package of support services such as 30 ICDS Centres, night shelter, awareness on HIV/AID, remedial education and vocational skills training such as computer, driving, tailoring & paper bag making. They have requested for funds for construction of community development centre which would be helpful for development of women living in rural areas of West Bengal.

Financial assistance of Rs 32,55,400/- has been provided for construction of Two storied (Ground and First Floor)

• Saksham - North Zone – Shimla DO

Saksham Trust is working for individuals with visual impairment and multiple disabilities. The Trust has requested funds for construction of Saksham Education, Training, Rehabilitation and Resources Centre for children with visual impairment and multiple disabilities. For this particular project, Saksham has identified 20 visually impaired beneficiaries / children between the age group of 4-18 years of age which consists of 10 boys and 10 girls from 12 districts of Himachal Pradesh. Providing funds for this centre is useful to accommodate these students. This

proposed centre would cater to education, computer literacy programs along with trainings to those children who are visually impaired and are unable to pursue education or go to schools like other peers with normal eyesight.

Financial assistance of Rs 50,00,000/- has been provided for Construction of Building for Education, training, Rehabilitation and Resource Centre

• Udavum Ullangal Public Charitable Trust - South Zone – Tirunelveli

Udavum Ullangal Public Charitable Trust is running Education, Health, Skill Development and Disaster Recovery Projects in rural areas of Tirunelveli. The Trust has started a Cancer Prevention Center known as Nellai Cancer Care Centre at Tirunelveli in the year 2011 in association with Cancer Institute (WIA), Adyar. The Nellai Cancer Care Centre conducts medical camps in rural areas for screening the cancer patients. They are specially screening women and providing them with proper health care. Presently the Centre also gives Palliative care service to 100 patients as per Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital list. They have requested funds for purchase of Ambulance to increase this service to more people.

Financial assistance of Rs. 20,25,779/- has been provided for purchase of Ambulance.

• Shree Ganesha Seva Trust for Exceptional Persons - South Central Zone – Udupi The Ganesha Seva Trust for Exceptional Persons (R), Mangalore was formed to serve the mentally challenged persons aged 5 to 53 years. They are running Saanidya Residential School and Mentally Challenged Centre. There are a total of 163 disabled students who are getting inhouse training in the Institution. They have requested funds for installation of lift which would be will be helpful for movement of disabled students from ground to 1st and 2nd floor.

Financial assistance of Rs. 14,58,000/- has been provided for installation of the lift.

Karma Falya Trust - Western Zone- Gandhinagar DO

Karma Falya Trust is providing yeoman service to old age persons; especially to those neglected by the family. The trust provides them with residence, food, medical and other required facilities so that they can avail and enjoy peaceful and dignified life. Moreover, they also arrange for last funeral rites. The Trust has requested for funding for purchase of 7 Seater vehicle for smooth movement of the old aged persons to Hospital, Religious places and their residents as and when needed.

Financial assistance of Rs.6,64,825/- has been provided for purchase of 7 Seater vehicle.

• The Leprosy Mission Vocational Training Centre Nashik - Western Zone- Nashik DO

The Leprosy Mission (TLM) is a leading international Christian organization with over 140 years of experience. TLM is present in almost 50 countries around the world. The Leprosy Mission Vocational Training Centre Nashik was established in 1979. There was a realization that leprosy cured young boys and girls do not have the skills to earn a sustainable living which impelled them to provide job oriented technical skills. The vocational training centre provides residential training on job oriented technical skills to boys and girls from leprosy, disability and general background. The Trust has requested funds for purchase of Vehicle which is required for transportation of Leprosy affected students to Industrial visits or for In Company Training. **Financial assistance of Rs 16,77,588/- has been provided for purchase of vehicle.**

• Ramakrishna Math, Barisha - Eastern Zone - KMDO II

Ramakrishna Math is supporting old aged people mentally and physically in a spiritual environment by way of providing them food, shelter, medical support etc. on a very nominal charge. Most of the inmates here suffer from knee pain, bone pain, Arthritis Spondylosis etc. and it becomes very difficult for them to move from one floor to another, particularly for going to dining hall, shrine etc. situated on the ground floor. RKM has a lift installed earlier but it is very old and very often becomes inoperative due to mechanical failures, creating a lot of problems for the inmates The project sought financial assistance for installation of a new lift in the Old age Home for the benefit of these old inmates.

Financial assistance of `25,00,000/- has been provided for Installation of new Lift at the old age home.

Integrated Development Society - Construction of Annex Building to be used as skill development training centre for tribal youth based in Dasamantapur Block of Koraput District - Berhampur DO, Eastern Central Zone

Integrated Development Society (IDS), registered in 1990, has been working for Scheduled Tribes and other marginalized people for the last 26 years in Koraput District of Odisha. They cater to the basic needs of disadvantaged and vulnerable children who have been denied their basic rights like food, health and education due to socio-cultural and economic problems. Adarsh Girijan Pragati Vidyalya of IDS is a residential school where children belonging to Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Castes and children from economically weaker sections and destitute children are given education up to 10th Std. Presently there are 47 children staying with lodging and boarding facilities in the school.

The Project Authority has submitted a report regarding our earlier sanctioned amount that "The Bolero vehicle supported by LIC GJF is being used for the service of Orphan, abandoned and surrendered children mainly covering the undivided Koraput district and to the State Head guarter –Bhubaneswar as per the needs and requirements of the children.IDS has requested assistance for construction of about 2500 sqft. Annexure building which will serve the purpose of skill development training centre for Tribal youth.

Financial assistance of 25,00,000/- has been provided for Construction of Annex Building to be used as skill development training centre for tribal youth based in Dasamantapur Block of Koraput District.

Pacific Creative Society –North Central Zone, Dehradun DO.

The Pacific Creative Society is engaged in many social, educational, health & sanitization activities especially among the poor & marginalized people of the society. It concentrates its activities on providing clean drinking water solutions, promoting handicrafts, children's education, community health, women empowerment, vocational & technical training for youth etc. The Society is working with the Uttrakhand Char Dham, Devasthanam Management Board and has resolved many problems like shortage of hot& clean drinking water for pilgrims. LIC GJF had given financial assistance of

`25,00,000/- in 2019-20 and the NGO has installed EPIOS which will provide free hot &clean drinking water to the pilgrims and local public of the area. Pacific Creative Society had requested for funds to install 10 E-Toilets in Badrinath Dham, which would help thousands of pilgrims visiting Badrinath Dham, as this is the major area of concern at the pilgrimage centre.

Financial assistance of 24,54,400/- has been provided for installing 4 e-toilets at Badrinath Dham.

Prerana Social Welfare centre (unit of Carmel Jyothi Trust) – South Central Zone -Shimoga DO

Prerana Social Welfare centre is a unit of Carmel Jyothi Trust. They are rendering free service to the needy people of Jagalur taluka. Jagalur is a very backward and deep rural

area. Education and health facilities are not much available in this area. Prerana is providing free education, health care, self employment training and conducted legal awareness camps in rural villages. During 01.06.2017 to 15.08.2020 they have conducted many programmes like eye operation, eye check up, dental check up, POCSO, Yoga, Scouts and Guides, Asha workers work shop, general health camps, Aids & cancer awareness, Tailoring training, health camps etc and about 10,940 people were benefited. Prerana is rendering free service to the needy people of Jagalur taluka. They have requested for one four wheeler vehicle, as they are not having any vehicle to conduct all social activities.

Financial assistance of `15,05,266/- has been provided for purchase of Force Trax Cruiser vehicle.

Bodhi Peeth – Eastern Zone, Kolkata Suburban DO.

Bodhi Peeth is a voluntary Non- Governmental residential social welfare organization working exclusively for training, welfare and rehabilitation of orphan and abandoned persons with intellectual disabilities, irrespective of age, gender, religion and caste. Bodhi Peeth is conducting many classes for mentally retarded children. Bodhi Peeth has requested funds for purchase of Ambulance which would help to deliver fast and speedy medical services to residents. As most of the residents are mentally retarded, they frequently injure themselves and also have some health issue which needs immediate care. An in-house ambulance would be able to serve them better.

Financial assistance of `6,67,030/- purchase of EECO ambulance.

SangamamTrust - South Zone, Coimbatore DO.

Sangamam Trust, initiated and helmed by Padmashri Mayilanandan, popularly known as SKM, envisions a tranquil journey for the departed souls from 'Sojourn' to 'Ultimate Home'. The farsighted foresight of constructing an immense and extensive Modern Gas Crematorium at a breezy village, Pasur on a wide expanse of 1.71 acres at a cost of about 7 crores has come to fruition with the liberal benefaction of the benevolent people of Kongu region. Sangamam Trust is restricted only to the Crematorium Project for the General Public irrespective of their religion, caste etc, and for the general welfare of the society. Sangamam Trust has requested for LPG fired Crematorium furnace and other accessories to be used at crematoriums in Erode district which will help in conservation of trees/forests being used for cremating bodies as well as saving the environment from pollution as apart from firewood, tyres and other inflammable materials are also used for burning the dead bodies.

Financial assistance of `25,00,000/- has been provided for Supply & Installation of LPG fired Crematorium furnace, and accessories including trolley for loading body, Ash collecting door, Venturie wet scrubber, inter connecting duct, ID Fan, 110 feet Chimney, control penal, automatic and manual burners etc.

• Contribution towards Clean Ganga Fund (CGF) established by Government of India.

The Proposal from the Union Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation to contribute towards "Namami Gange Program". NMCG has taken up various activities to support the national effort to rejuvenate river Ganga like promoting ecological protection through a forestation, in-situ bioremediation of drains, sewage treatment, river surface cleaning, industrial affluent monitoring, massive public outreach and creating river front development including construction, renovation and modernization of Ghats and crematoria

• Contribution to Armed Force Flag Day Fund (AFFDF) – Welfare of Ex-Servicemen of the Indian Defence Force

A request from the Kendriya Sanik Board, Ministry of Defence, Government of India, New Delhi was received for contributing towards "Armed Force Flag Day Fund (AFFDF)". KSB Is the apex body (under the Honable Raksha Mantri, Ministry of Defence, Govt. Of India, (GOI), spread pan India, upto the District level. The task of extending various welfare schemes to about 37 lakh ex- servicemen fraternity, Veer Naris and their dependents is accomplished through 32 Rajva Sanik Boards at State/UT level and 403 District Sainik Boards. These welfare schemes for ex- servicemen, war widows, battle casualties, orphaned/ dependent children is funded by AFFDF. To keep the defence forces profile young due to operational reasons, defense personnel, particularly in the lower ranks retire at a relatively younger age between ages 35 to 42 years (approx 60,000 retirees added every year). With meager pension, pending domestic responsibilities, escalation in cost of living, these personnel who come from modest backgrounds face a lot of hardships. Escalation in counter insurgency has also resulted in a lot of casualties. To value and recognize the services of such war veterans, the nation needs to contribute towards the welfare and rehabilitation of the ex-servicemen community and Next of Kin of those killed/disabled in operations. Hence, KSB has requested to contribute to AFFDF which will help for education of children of Ex- servicemen, Martyrs and their widows.

Financial assistance of `5 crore has been provided for the same.

 Mahila Abhivruddi Mattu Samrakshana Samsthe (MASS) – South Central Zone -Belagavi DO.

Mahila Abhivruddi Mattu Samrakshana Samsthe (MASS) based in Belagavi District in Karnataka State endeavors towards upliftment of Dalit women and supporting economically and socially weaker sections of the Society. MASS also provides loans to start business, provides uniforms, bags and books to school children. They requested funds for construction of a building housing the office of the NGO and also to be used to give shelter to Devadasis.

Financial assistance of 25,00,000/- towards construction of Building on plot owned by MASS for housing the office of NGO as well as providing shelter to Devadasis.

• Yamunai Shaikshanikand Sanskritik Mahila Mandal Dhule –Sanskar Matimand Mulinche Ballgrauha - Western Zone, Nashik DO.

Shri Sanskar Matimand Mulinche BallgrauhaYamunai is established in 2009 and run by Yamunai Shaikshanik and Sanskritik Mahila Mandal. The Mandal is running a residential hostel and school for orphaned mentally retarded girls and providing them training and proper medical care. The Society had requested funds for purchase of vehicle to provide training and timely medical services to these girls.

Financial assistance of `13,44,970/- has been provided for purchase vehicle .

• Sevabharathi - South Central Zone – Udupi DO

Sevabharathi has established Sevadhama project in collaboration with Association of people with disability (APD) in 2018. This centre is working for rehabilitation of persons with spinal injuries that is prevalent in large number in the costal districts of South Kanara and Udupi but do not have any such facility of rehabilitation after spinal injury. Sevadhama has

rehabilitated over 50 beneficiaries last year and identified over 180 spinal cord injured people in South Kanara and Udupi districts. The project sought financial assistance for purchase of Solar Power System, as centre is located in a rural surrounding that is often faced with frequent power shut down affecting treatment of inmates and use of machinery installed for physiotherapy treatment.

Financial assistance of `8, 33,000/- has been provided for purchase of Solar Power system.

Sangli Mission Society -Western Zone – Kolhapur DO

Sangli Mission Society (SMS) was established in 1990. Society is carrying out various programs and projects for the improvements and development of the disadvantaged and marginalized sections of society in Maharashtra, mainly in four districts i.e Sangli, Kolhapur, Sindhudurg and Ratnagiri. Society is running 10 English medium schools and three nursery schools, where they are providing education to 11,000 children. Society is running Asara care for aged and abandoned people. Society is also providing shelter to the homeless. They have constructed 16 houses and 47 toilets for poor. The Society has started construction (G+2) of a Training and Animation Centre at Herle, Kolhapur with a view to having a common place to co-ordinate social, charitable activities and to provide various training to their staff and to conduct various training activities. The project sought financial assistance for the construction of the first floor

Financial assistance of `25,00,000/- has been provided for construction.

Samarpan run by Gayatri Pariwar Trust - North Central Zone – Lucknow DO

Samarpan Varishtha Jan Parisar, old Age Home, constructed by Lucknow Nagar Nigam, at Adil Nagar, Ring Road, Lucknow is being managed by the volunteers of Samarpan. This Old Age Home is equipped with a yoga-Meditation Center, Library, dispensary, dining hall and round the clock ambulance and 24 hours security. It boasts of furnished 19 double-bedrooms and 3 dormitories. Presently there are 40 inmates and they are charging nominal monthly amount i.e. Rs 3500/- per dormitory per head and Rs 10,500/- for double bedroom for two persons inclusive of food, lodging, electricity and water etc. They are also providing training to ladies and youth for self employment in Gayatri Shakti peeth, Kursi Road, Lucknow and Gayatri Shakti Peeth, Rampur Deorai, Lucknow. The project sought financial assistance for purchase of vehicle to enhance their social development work and transportation of senior citizen of old age home.

Financial assistance of `17, 64,650/- has been provided for purchase of school bus.

• Sukrutham Charitable Trust -South Zone –Kottayam DO

Sukrutham Sevanilayam is a home for 12 mentally challenged persons from economically disadvantaged families facing different types of mental retardations. The inmates are provided with holistic as well as remedial treatments to minimize the difficulties arising out of the illness and are provided with healthy and nutritious food to improve both mental and physical health as well as immunity power. Presently Sevanilayam is functioning in rented building and Trust envisions to build Sukrutham Sevanilayam centre for rehabilitation of 50 differently abled persons along with interventions in areas like special school and skill development for the all round developments of the inmates. The proposed construction is a 3 storey building. The project sought financial assistance for construction of first floor.

Financial assistance of 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of the first floor.

 Ramakrishna Mission Ashram, Bajepratappur – Eastern Zone – Bardhaman DO Ramakrishna Mission Ashram, Bajepratappur, Bardhaman is running a charitable allopathic-cum- homeopathic dispensary and 9000 patients were treated in the last year.

Ashram is also doing welfare work by way of distributing blankets, clothes, educational aids, etc to the poor and needy. During the last year 4948 people were benefited. They have 50 staff members and 25 inmates. All the services like education, medical, relief and other charitable works are provided free of cost to all. The existing set up at the campus is very congested and uncomfortable and the project authority is planning to shift their clinic to a spacious area. The project sought financial assistance for construction of charitable dispensary, meditation and skill development Hall.

Financial assistance of 25,00,000/- has been provided for Construction of Charitable Dispensary, meditation and skill development Hall.

• Digambarpur Angikar - Eastern Zone – KMDO II

Diagmbarpur Angikar is a community based social welfare organization established in the year 1988 at Sundarban region with a team of dedicated youth. Diagmbarpur Angikar also runs two govt supported shelter homes for the destitute girl children in need of care & protection and another home for girls like trafficking victims. There are nearly 150 vulnerable children. Though the Government is providing all recurring expenses like food, cloth, vocational training etc. there is absence of Government funds for construction of building. Diagmbarpur Angikar has already constructed a building for all 150 inmates as per Government requirement with financial support from different corporate and individual donors. Now on an average on a daily basis 200 to 250 such category of victims are residing, much beyond the capacity, and accessing various services through these residential shelter homes. The project sought financial assistance for construction of addition building to expand their shelter for additional 50-75 traffic victims

Financial assistance of Rs 24,86,000 /- has been provided for construction of additional one storied building.

• Vatsalya Foundation – Western Zone – Surat DO

Vatsalya Founation is a NGO in Vadodara, Gujarat working since 2000 and their flagship project is Menstrual Hygiene management for women. The theme of this work starts from awareness, access and affordability of hygiene projects. Lack of awareness, knowledge of hygiene and economic inability leads to young girls skipping school and other activities and rural working women to miss work and also alarming increase in Cervical cancer. Their aim is to make this program popular in the entire country and engage rural unemployed youths in production and marketing and also to fulfill the school requirements to maximum years. The Project from Vatsalya Foundation for women's health and hygiene is for providing support for purchase of 7 sanitary napkin manufacturing machines with raw materials at each of the seven locations (covering 4 states) - Bhayali, Daman, Silvassa, Vadodara, West Bengal, Jharkhand and Odisha and manufacturing of 40,000/ units at each of these 7 locations.

Financial assistance of Rs 2498734/- has been provided for purchase of 7 napkin manufacturing machines with raw materials for manufacturing of 40000 units each at the seven location at Bhayali, Daman, Silvassa, West Bengal, Jharkhand and Orissa.

• Shelter Associates- Western Zone – Kolhapur

Shelter Associates is a civil society organization established by Architects and urban planners headquartered in Pune and have been working to improve the living conditions of urban poor. Since last five years, the NGO has been rolling out, 'One Home One Toilet (OHOT) program which is well aligned with the Government's Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. They have facilitated 20,000 household toilets impacting over 1 lakh people in 7 cities of Maharashtra – Pune, Pimpri & Chinchwad, Thane, Navi Mumbai , Panvel & Kolhapur. The beneficiaries under OHOT are slum dwellers who do not own the land but are residing there for generations. It is the mandate of the Swachh Bharat Mission to provide household sanitation to all the urban poor families irrespective of their religion, tenure and financial status. The project sought financial assistance for cost of construction of approximately 12 square feet toilet is around Rs.20000/, of which Rs.6000/ being the construction cost shall be borne by the beneficiary.

Financial assistance of Rs .25,00,000/ has been provided for facilitating construction of 125 home toilets under their 'One Home One Toilet Scheme'' model in slums of Kolhapur City.

<u>2019-20</u>

 Pacific Creative Society - Purchase of 15 Water EPIOs - North Central Zone – Dehradun

Pacific Creative Society is engaged in social, educational, health and sanitation activities especially among the poor and marginalized people of society. It concentrates its activities on clean drinking water solutions, promoting handicrafts, children's education, community health, women empowerment, vocational & technical training for youth etc.

Trust has requested funds of Rs93,75,000/- plus GST to install 15 water vending ATMs or E-pios to provide clean drinking water to the general public on Char Dham Route- Badrinath, Kedarnath, Rishikesh, Haridwar. There are two major problems, first is of clean drinking water and second is pollution by plastic bottles. By installing Water E-pios machines, they will provide clean drinking water and also reduce the use of packed drinking water and damage to the environment.

Financial assistance of Rs25, 00,000/- has been provided for 4 water vending machines.

Cyclone Fani Relief - East Central - Bhubaneswar

Cyclone "Fani" has wreaked havoc in the coastal areas of the State of Odisha and to a slightly lesser extent in the States of West Bengal and Andhra Pradesh. There has been loss of lives and extensive damage and/or loss of property. Tens of thousands of people have been displaced.

Financial assistance of Rs 600000/- has been provided for cyclone Fani Relief..

The Academy of Magical Sciences- Construction of Auditorium - South Zone – Thiruvanthapuram DO

The Academy of magical Sciences was established in 1996 for the promotion of art of magic and uplift the under privileged and weaker section of our society. Magic Academy with the support of Kerala State, social security mission organized "Anuyatra" campaign to empower the differently-abled children and bring them to the mainstream of the society. The Institute of Magic science is a platform to explore and nurture the diverse talents of differently-abled children. Presently 23 disabled children are staying, getting trained and rehabilitated at the centre and the academy aims to increase the number to 100. They sought funds for construction of training centre.

Financial assistance of Rs25, 00,000/- has been provided for construction of training centre for mentally and physically challenged child artists.

• Aai Day Care Sanstha - Construction of 3rd floor of Hostel - Western Zone – Thane DO Aai Day Care Sanstha was established in 2010 to cater to the needs of mentally challenged children in and around Pen area of Raigad District. Aai Day Care runs a Vocational training Centre, where they give vocation training to 50 specially abled students ranging from age group 3 to 25 plus. There are six classes in vocation training, i.e Pre-primary class, Primary class, National open School class, Pre-vocational class, vocation class, swayam project. The institute provides special education, early intervention, vocational training & rehabilitation, physiotherapy, free medical check-up and medicine, free transportation etc. They sought financial assistance for construction of 3rd floor of the hostel for orphans and financially weak children.

Financial assistance of Rs25,00,000/- has been provided for the construction of 3rd floor consisting of a kitchen, dining hall, library, washing area, wash area, store room, a stair case, ramp and lift area.

• Bhavnagar Vruddashram Trust - Installation of solar power plant of 34.125 KW capacity - Western Zone – Bhavnagar DO -

Bhavnagar Vruddhashram trust was established in 1969 by a social worker Shri Mnabhai Bhatt for the welfare of senior citizens. It was started with 10 members, now they have 260 senior citizens. Out of 260 members, 160 are staying in Old Senior citizen home where they charge Rs 250 per month for single room and Rs 500/- per month of double room and another 110 members are staying in Jivan Sandhya Sushrasha Dham where charges are 2800/-per month. Trust has requested funds for installing solar power plant of 34.125 KW capacities, which will help them to save on electricity bills.

Financial assistance of Rs18,95,850/- has been provided for installation of solar power plant.

 The society for the welfare of the differently abled (physically handicapped) person education and research centre - Installation of additional solar power plant of 25 KW -Western Zone – Pune DO II

The society for the welfare of the differently abled (physically handicapped) person education and research centre (SWPH & RC) has been working for the noble cause of complete socio-economic empowerment of persons with orthopedic challenges since last 63 years. The centre houses now 240 candidates and provides all the services related to health, education , sports, skill training, post care lodging and boarding at free of cost to their inmates. The project sought financial assistance to install additional 25 KW solar rooftop pv power system costing Rs 16,33,500/- (In addition to their existing 15 KWa solar power generating system) which will help them to save on electricity cost.

Financial assistance of Rs16,33,500/- has been provided for installation of solar power plant.

• Gharkul Parivar Sanstha, Satpur, Nashik for construction of Ground floor of hostel with kitchen, reception, waiting room and cabin - Western Zone – Nashik DO Gharkul Parivar Sanstha is running a school cum hostel for mentally challenged girls/women at Satpur, Nasik for more than a decade. All these girls are mentally challenged and are not capable of carrying out their daily activities independently. In the existing hostel, 47 mentally challenged girls are accommodated of which 25 girls are supported free of charge. This institution is taking care of 50 mentally challenged girls right up to their death. This institution has sought funds for construction of Kitchen, waiting room and office area Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of Ground floor of hostel with kitchen, reception, waiting room and cabin to provide residential and other facilities to mentally challenged girls/women.

• Arogya Sandhan Charitable Trust – Eastern Zone – KMDO II

Arogya Sandhan Memorial Charitable Trust (ASCT) was established in 2005 and registered in 2007 to provide medical services to mentally challenged children and their parents. As parents of these children are suffering from loneliness in handling their children and deep anxiety of the future threat of life of their challenged children in their absence. Arogya Sandhan Memorial Charitable Trust is providing comprehensive package of training, therapies and residential care for differently abled persons so that their hidden talent can be optimized an in many case they can be self – dependent to a great extent which can lead to mitigation/lessening the problems of differently able persons and their parents as well as society. The project sought financial assistance for construction of LIC Block of Skill Optimization residential care home for differently abled persons on second floor.

Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for purchase for construction of LIC Block of Skill Optimization residential care home for differently able persons.

• Public Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt of Maharashtra for COVID 19 Relief

• Solar power system, solar water Heater and provision of lift. - Jwala Home for mentally challenged, Pondicherry - South Zone -Vellore DO

Jwala Home for mentally challenged girls /women was established in the year 1996 for mentally challenged girls/women below socioeconomic status. At present there are 29 mentally challenged girls & 13 women. Jwala Home provides clean and healthy atmosphere, food and clothes to the inmates. Psychiatrists and physicians visit the ashram as and when required and proper medical treatment and medicines are given to the inmates. The ashram has 16 staff members to take care of the inmates. All services are offered free of cost. They have built a 3 storied building at Angalamman Nagar, Murungapakkam, Puducherry with the help of MP-LAD fund and local fund mobilization. Physically challenged inmates are finding it difficult to move up and down. Financial assistance of Rs 14,28,000/- has been provided for purchase of Solar power system, solar water Heater and provision of lift.

• Renovation of two water bodies names Panacha and Hara - Vivekananda Kendra-South Zone -Madhurai DO

Swami Vivekananda Centenary Celebration and Vivekananda Rock Memorial Committee have been in registered in 1963 and this has been renamed as Vivekananda Kendra and registered in 1979. Vivekananda Kendra has more than 200 branch centers all over the country and provides numerous services through various projects like character building education, cultural and spiritual activities, rural development program, yoga, social welfare activities etc. The Trust has initiated several Natural Resources Development projects called VK- Nardep in many rural areas and in the poverty stricken areas. For water management, Trust is working for renovation of tanks, deepening Oorains (traditional water storage tanks i.e dugout ponds in natural depressions.), providing a sand filter trench and a draw well, artificial recharging of tube wells and roof water harvesting. Vivekanand Kendra has already renovated 22 water bodies and balance 20 is in the pipeline. Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for revival and renovation of TWO teerthams namely Panacha and Hara for water management.

- Grid Tied Solar Plant & CCTV Sri Sarada Math Western Zone Pune DO II Sri Sarada Math Pune is a branch of Ramakrishna Sarada Math Belur, was established in 1975. The aim and object of this center is to carry on educational, cultural and religious activities among women and children. Presently, they have a study room for girls, yoga classes for women, Mandir, big garden, guest room, Sri Sarada Math Women's wing etc.They have a Vivekananda Vidya Mandir where approx 230 students are studying from pre and primary to 4th std. Also they have a Spiritual Centre, General Library and a Guest Room where 6 persons can stay. Financial assistance of Rs 12,29,147/- has been provided CCTV camera for security purpose and installation of 10 KWP solar grid plant that will cover all the campus power requirements and will reduce the present electricity bill.
- Computers, Audio visual equipments and furniture for training center for hearing impaired persons - The Delhi Association of the Deaf, Delhi. - North Zone Delhi DO-I The Delhi Association of the Deaf was established in 1950 and renamed as the Delhi Association of the Deaf in 1978, with its registered office in Kamla Market, New Delhi, highly accessible by public. The Association works as a focal point for a large number of hearing impaired persons who visit to seek solution/advise/assistance for their problems, disability certificate, railway and bus passes/ concessions, education and vocational training for themselves or their children, issues with civic agencies or simply to get forms filled. The Association with its extensive network also acts as an informal employment exchange for hearing impaired persons. They are running a Research and Rehabilitation Centre for the deaf, train hearing impaired person in computer design and animation, photography, visual arts, pottery, sign language, hospitality management advocacy and dance therapy free of cost. They also organise sports activities for the deaf. The association in collaboration with NASSCOM has put together a PROJECT that would train hearing – impaired persons in the area of Graphic Design and Animation Skills. While NASSCOM will provide technical support, Oracle and Accenture have committed to provide on the job training to the students. At the same time, making use of the infrastructure they would make a large number of hearing impaired digitally literate. Financial assistance of Rs 20,74,575/- has been provided for 16 works stations and class room furniture, 55" Screen with audio visual equipment, Seven Air Conditioners, 16 computers, furnishing of pantry etc.
- Construction of Dining Hall /Recreation Room- Ved Vignan Maha Vidya Peeth Udaan - Eastern Zone – KMDO II

VVMVP which has been actively involved in betterment of the lives of children of sex workers of Sonagachi was constituted on November 1981 under the aegis of The Art of Living. They are running an evening school for the children of sex workers and providing free meals, education and vocational training to them. They also conduct medical camps and distribute medicines free of cost. Udaan Project is supported by International Association for Human Values (IAHV). Proposed project is for construction of School and Hostel Building, which will be accommodating 50 school girls. In addition to school camps they will construct community centre, skill training centre, meditation hall, play ground, metal roads, security rooms etc. Financial assistance of Rs 15,74,122/- has been provided for construction of Dining Hall/Recreation room.

 Construction of old age home for destitute Senior Citizens – Sevalaya – South Zone – Thanjavur DO

Sevalaya runs a MahakaviBharathiyar Higher Secondary School in Thiruninravur, 40 kms west of Chennai, providing free high quality education from Balwadi (Pre-KG) up to 12th Standard for poor children from the neighboring villages. Strength of the school is 2058. They provide value-based education which enables the children to become self-reliant and live ethical lives. **LIC GJF had given grant of Rs. 1813000/- in the year 2010-11 for construction of**^{2nd} **floor of their school building.** Sevalaya runs the Swami Vivekananda Boys' Home and Mother Teresa Girls Home for orphans, poor and destitute children. Sevalaya also runs eight Community Colleges, offering 10 trades; these provide a ray of hope for rural youth (mostly aged 18-25) who otherwise would not have had access to higher education. Sevalayacould lift unemployed and unskilled young people out of poverty's reach. It also runs an old age home, which has 70 destitute senior citizens as inmates and takes care of their needs up to their final rites with no contribution from the inmates. Financial assistance of Rs 24,99,417/-has been provided for construction of old age home to accommodate 20 Senior Citizens .

• Flood Victims in the State of Kerala –South Zone

It is reportedly the worst flood of the century and there has been enormous loss of lives and property. Thousands of people have lost their homes and belongings. The rains have not abated and all the dams in the State have had to open their shutters, worsening the already precarious situation. As situation is grave, Funds of Rs 20,66,454/- has been provided for relief of poverty or distress in the aftermath of unprecedented rains in the State of Kerala

• Construction of two community toilet(7 seated) with water tank in LIC's adopted village of Govindpur - Sulabh International Social Service Organisation –North Central Zone –Varanasi DO

In the 21st Board Meeting of LIC GJF held on 12/03/2017 it was decided that a poor village from the 'Forest Villages" of Sonbhadra District, Uttar Pradesh be adopted by LIC GJF. Accordingly, Govindpur Village of Sonbhadra District, Myorpur Block was adopted by LIC GJF for providing assistance through Banwasi Seva Ashram. The NGO Banwasi Seva Ashram, Govindpur, a voluntary organization, is a Trust registered in the year 1956, established in Gandhian principles of life, which selflessly and untiringly works towards the upliftment of the villagers of Gram Panchayat Gambirpur covering the villages Govindpur and Gambirpur and surrounding predominantly tribal areas. Govindpur Village has 101 households and Gambirpur village has 132 households and the total population of Gambirpur Panchayat is 1242 (ST-226, SC-801, OBC-175, Gen-40). We have provided an ambulance for medical relief and funds for literacy campaign to eradicate illiteracy. Further, during the visit of GJF Officials in June 2018 and discussions with the Sarpanch and Villagers, the need for sanitation facilities was perceived. Sulabh International Social Service Organization was consulted and looking at the terrain and scarcity of water, they suggested setting up two community toilets, with maintenance for 3 years. Funds of Rs .68,00,000/- has been provided for construction of two community toilets near Ashram Govindpur and near Upper Primary School, Govindpur with provision for boundary wall, PVC water storage tank, septic tank, soak pit, submersible pumps, solar lights, water cooler, R.O plant and sign boards and maintenance of two toilets for initial period of one year for Rs. 8,22,984/.

• Sharon Society of Pondicherry – Construction of home for elderly widows and destitute women at Korkadu revenue village- South Zone -Vellore DO SHARON Society of Puducherry (Service Home for Aged Rehabilitation Orphanage and Novice of the Life) was registered on 19.12.2002 to improve the social, educational and economic conditions of the underprivileged, disadvantaged and vulnerable people irrespective of caste, creed, religion, sex and sexual orientation. They are working for the development of children, women, adolescent girls, youth, aged, differently abled persons, disabled and PLWHA (people living with HIV/AIDS) individuals. They have Senior Citizens' Home, rehabilitation centre for the aged with physiotherapy treatment, special school for special children and day care centre for slum children. SHARON Society of

Puducherry has plans to construct own building for 'Pushpagandhi Home for Aged' which is presently running in rented building and 20 elderly widows and destitute women are getting residential care and support.Financial assistance of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of own building (Pushpagandhi Old Age Home) which will extend the care to at least 50 elderly and destitute women.

Year 2017-18

Construction of Hall - Akhil Bhartiya Viklang Chetna Parishad - Bilaspur DO /CZ Akhil BhartiyaViklang Chetna Parishad Bilaspurwas established in the year 2000 and registered under Society Registration Act .Its Object to serve and spread awareness in the society about physically or mentally challenged people. It has branches and membership in different state of India. The society's work includes surgeries, outreach camps, arranging opportunities for the youth to meet and select their life partners, cultural activities, sports events, training programmes, self employment, examination and certificate distribution, awareness workshops, individual help, distribution of appliances and likewise. All the works are totally free for the disabled.

Society also provide other facilities to disabled people i.e Distribution of free disability certificates, early diagnosis of disability in outreach camps, providing help to get Railway concessions, free distribution of Artificial Limbs, examination of the mentally challenged and free training to their parents, Appeal to writers and critics to recreate and emphasize the life of disabled in literature etc

Funding of Rs 25, 00,000/- for construction of Hospital Building has been provided for boarding, food & medico surgical services to physical disabled.

 Construction for extension of existing hostel building – Bhaniba Lakdhirji Solanki KanyaChhatralaya, Under Late Shri Deepak RajaramMakwanaSmriti Trust -Bhavnagar DO /WZ

BhanibaLakdhirji Solanki KanyaChhatralaya, (BLSKC) is being managed by Late Shri Deepak Rajaram Makwana Smriti Trust for last more than 30 years. It is providing hostel accommodation free of cost to girls from rural areas belonging to poor families. They are getting grant from Backward Class Kalyan Department of Gujarat Govt. The BLSKC is getting grant for 98 girls from the Gujarat Govt. However they have admitted 136 girl students for whom all fees are waived and the cost is borne by the Trust with support of donors. They are also providing facilities like physical training/exercise, yoga, computer training, sewing classes etc for development of the girls.

Funding of Rs 11,77,650/- has been provided for extension of its existing hostel building by construction of 3 more rooms, hence the facility of lodging and boarding to more girls will be increase.

Tata LPT 1109/42 HEX 2 - AkshayPatra Foundation, Lucknow DO /NCZ

The Akshaya Patra Foundation Lucknow (APF) was formed in June 2000 with the vision that no child in India shall be deprived of education because of hunger and with a mission to feed 5 million children by 2020. APF is only NGO to enter the Hall of Fame in ICAI Awards for Excellence in Financial Reporting and is a recipient of Nikkei Asia Award 2016 for supporting Sustainable Development in Asia. ISO 22000:2005 certification has been awarded to 13 out of its 23 kitchens. They serves mid-day meals to more than 1.5 million children in the age group of 3-14 years across more than 13000 Government schools across 24 locations covering 10 states of India. APF maintains quality of the meal by taking feedback from schools on a daily basis and are adopting and implementing Kaizen, CI Projects and Six Sigma methodologies to ensure quality on all terms. The meals are supplied

to the schools in customized delivery vehicles. APF, centralized kitchen in Lucknow provides food to more than 100000 children across Lucknow.

Financial assistance of Rs **13**, **52**,**048**/- has been provided for purchase of a Truck for routine transport of raw material from wholesale market to its godown and kitchen facilities.

• Repair of Truss and roofing work of the old age home –Anandashram Seva Trust -South Central Zone – Udupi Division

The Anandashram Seva trust was established in 1995 in the area of Dakshina Kannada District Karnataka for old and elderly needy persons. Anandashram has provided so many facilities like Boarding and Lodging, Nutritious and easily digestible food, Regular Bhajan & Dhyan sessions, Compulsory light exercises and Pranayama, Indoor games like Carrom, Chennemane and Chess, A good library with good spiritual books in Kannada, English & Hindi, Beautiful up-coming garden and landscaping. They have conducted regular Medical checkups, Benefits of periodic Satsang and Cultural programmes, A Full-fledged Physiotherapy unit with an experienced Physiotherapist. Financial assistant of **Rs 2,58,750/-** has been provided for repair of Truss and roofing work of the old age home (Jeevan Sandhya), as the years passed fiber roof sheet of destitute cottage "Jeevan Sanhya" are damaged and almost weakened due to exposure to immense heat of sun and rain. By replacing with a new technology for all season Galvanized Aluminum Sheets and other required truss material will be helpful for old age home.

 Construction of Store room – cum show room-Mithram Society of Parents of the Mentally Handicapped – South Zone -Ernakulam Divsion

Mithram is a Registered Charitable Trust formed in the year 1993 by the parents of the mentally challenged persons. They are providing total care and protection, behavioral training, education, vocational training, employment in employability centre and other services needed to persons with mental retardation, autism, cerebral palsy and multiple disabilities and also to provide lifelong residential homely care to such persons. They are running different projects for training the students in vocational activities and providing employment to them. Manufacture of note book, candle, soap powder and allied items, envelopes, rice powdering, farming, poultry farm etc. The Note book manufacturing is done jointly with M/S Bridege social Innovations, Kakkoor, Piravom, and NGO formed by educated young persons. They provide technical and marketing assistance of the project. As a result 10 students and 3 parents got employment there. Students are engaged in different productions like paper products (note book, notepads, envelopes files, carry bags), Food Products (rice powder), Detergents (Toilets Soap, washing powder, phenyl. dish wash), Candle (Variety of Candles), poultry& chicken farm(eggs & chicks) etc but they don't have platform to sell it or generate revenue. Financial assistance of Rs 5, 60,000/- has been provided for construction of new building, so they can use this building as a store room for stocking and show room for sale of different items.

• Installation of 30KV Solar Energy Plant –Anandam- South Zone - Chennai DO-II Anandam is a Registered Charitable Trust formed in the year 1995. They established Anandam Old Age Home in 2003 to cater the need of Senior Citizens who do not have any living children and no source of income. They provide healthcare to the patients along with the Old Age Home facility and nursing care to the old people who need round the clock attention. In the old age home they have 12 Dormitory Halls. Each dormitory Hall is of 600 sq .ft in area to accommodate 8 elders, they provide steel cots, mattress, fan, solar heated water in the bath room and 2 attached western toilets, cupboard to keep belongings and non skid tiles and grab rails and bath rooms are

provided with magnetic door closers with no bolt / latch inside. The organization is charitable Trust and they want to give optimal benefit of charity to their inmates. Financial assistance of Rs 19,50,000/- has been provided for 30 KW solar power panel. At present they have solar panels for about 15KW and electric consumption bill comes to Rs 72,000/- for every two months. By providing additional 30KW solar panel, this expense can be saved.

- Vehicle for Transporting Professional IT teachers from Chandigarh to project site at Bassi Pathana - Mehar Baba Charitable Trust - North Zone - Chandigarh DO. Mehar Baba Charitable Trust was established in 1998 at Chandigarh for uplifting rural communities. In 2005 they have started a Mata Harnam Kaur Community Development Centre a for benefit of rural population in a radius of 25 kilometer around Bassipathana Township of Fatehsingh Sahib District, which includes 187 villages. They are running a computer centre, language lab, vocational training centre, women empowerment SHG and a convention centre. Till date the Trust has trained 2206 rural youth in computer course, trained 3156 women for Garment making course, attended 500 chronic Diabetics and Heart Patients at their camps and done 2395 cataract surgeries at free of cost. Financial assistance of Rs 5,35,231/-has been provided for vehicle which will be useful for carrying the teachers from Chandigarh to project site of Bassi Pathana for computer training for poor children.
 - Ten Blood collection Monitors -Bhavnagar Blood Bank Western Zone -**Bhavnagar Division.**

Bhavnagar Blood Bank Trust was registered in the year 1989 to provide blood to needy patients from Bhavnagar city and neighboring districts. They are providing blood transfusion to thalassemic patients free of cost though R V Shah Thalassemia Care and Counseling Center. Bhavnagar Blood Bank (BBB) is supplying average 3200 units of blood per year to Thalassemic patients and approximately 200 children are being benefited from the project. BBB was running a 'Rakta Kranti Rath' which traveled 8383 kms during 2015-16 and organized 197 blood donation camps and 4 motivation camps. They have another small vehicle which traveled 5836 kms during 2015-16 and organized 37 blood donation camps. They have provided 9151 unit or blood and 4496 units to thalassemia affected children and provided blood free of cost to 168 poor patients. Financial assistance of Rs13,44,000/- has been provided for purchase of ten Blood collection monitors to collect the blood properly without coagulation.

• Bus for distribution of food SML ISUZU-Prestige 12.25 Cabin Chassis GVW-6440 KGS Payload-3.5Ton - Akshay Patra Foundation - South Central Zone -**Bangalore Division.**

The Akshaya Patra Foundation (APF) was formed in June 2000 with the vision that no child in India shall be deprived of education because of hunger and with a mission to feed 5 million children by 2020. The mid-day meal programme of APF was started by serving 1500 children across 5 Government schools in Bangalore. APF now serves midday meals to more than 1.5 million children in the age group of 3-14 years across more than 10,845 schools across 27 locations covering 10 states of India. The children come from weaker economic background with parents engaged in low income professions such as domestic help, street vendors, and construction labour. For many children this is the only full meal that they have during the day. Current fleet of 180 vehicles is to be augmented with 15 more which will be helpful for increase the coverage of meal distribution by about total 28000 meals across 220 schools every day for 232 days every year in South India. Financial assistance of Rs 17,99,789 has been provided for



purchase of Vehicle SML ISUZU prestige 12.25 cabin chassis for providing food to school children for its mid-day meal programme.

• Construction of 189 Bathroom cum Toilets - Rural Development Trust – South Central Zone - Kadapa Division

Rural Development Trust established in 1969. Since its inception, the organization has endeavoured to improve the quality of life of the rural poor, especially among marginalized and underprivileged communities of Dalits (SC), tribes (ST), Backward Castes (BC) and person with disabilities (PWDs). It has progressively implemented comprehensive development programmes involving all areas of development. RDT works in Education sector and took different initiatives to promote school attendance and to bridge the educational gap between children from disadvantaged communities and their peers. RDT also running hospital at three locations i.e Kalyandurg, Bathalapali & Kanekal in Ananathapur districts of Andhra Pradesh with a team of 120 doctors, 828 employees and total employees of all sectors are 2221 full time members, 3037 volunteers. They provide consultation, medicine, surgeries to SC, ST.OBC families in over 3000 villages of Ananthpur and adjoining districts of A.P free of cost or at subsidized rate.RDT is also work for public utility and planning to construct 189 bathrooms cum toilets for the poor people living in P. Yalleru village, D Honnur village, Gulipalyam village of Ananthapuram district, Andra Pradesh under Swacch Bharat campaign. Financial assistance of Rs 25, 00,000/- has been sanction for construction of 189 toilets cum bathrooms.

Grid Tied Roof Top Solar PV Plant - Shri Shankar Sewadham Sansthan - North Zone - Jaipur Do-2

Shri Shanker Sewadham Sansthan (SSSS) is an organization registered in the year 2009 through initiative of Shri Prahlad Gupta. The Sewadham ashram with capacity to accommodate 200 people was built entirely from savings of Shri Prahlad Gupta and was inaugurated in the year 2010. The ashram provides accommodation to old aged, mentally challenged, terminally ill persons and those who are without family to take care of them. SSSS started MahilaAwas in 2015 exclusively for female members and is having capacity to accommodate 150 women. Presently SSSS accommodates 310 inmates (206 male and 104 female) of which 240 are mentally retarded. The inmates are brought by police or referred by Govt, hospitals when there is no family member to take care. Helpless and abandoned persons from roadside, bus/rail stations are reported by general public, who are then picked up in an ambulance and brought to the ashram. The ashram provides clean and healthy atmosphere, food and clothes to the inmates. Psychiatrists and physicians visit the ashram as and when required and proper medical treatment and medicines are given to the inmates. The ashram has 17 staff members to take care of the inmates. All services are offered free of cost. Till date 1150 persons have been admitted in the ashram and 668 have got well and returned to their families. Financial assistant of Rs 13,00,000/- for installation of Grid Tied Roof Top Solar PV Plant having 20KW generation capacity which will save its operational cost and will be used for the daily needs of its inmates.

• Lathe Machine - The NAB Workshop for the Blind - Western Zone – MDO -2 NAB Workshop for the blind was laid by the Dr (Mrs) Helen Keller on 26.02.1955 and later on, inaugurated by Her Excellency Mrs. Vijay Laxmi Pandit, then Governor of Maharashtra, on 25th January 1963. NAB has conducted vocational training course which equips visually handicapped person with necessary skills, confidence and competence for placement in related industries. So far 2264 persons were trained out of which 998 were rehabilitated. NAB started stenography course (English) in 1991 and



Marathi in 1997 for education of blind persons. In English course 277 trainers were admitted out of which 210 have completed and 114 trainees have got employment and in Marathi Stenography, total 242 trainees were admitted out of which 175 have completed the course and 59 have got job. The organization is working towards the upliftment of the disabled and provides all services free of cost to the blind. Financial assistance of Rs 12,25,800/- has been provided for purchase of two lathe machines for their Turner operation Industrial Course, where visually challenged students learn to make and assemble Aluminum folding white Canes (Walking stick for the blind) and various Household and Industrial products that are manufactured on the Lathe Machine. NAB then supplies these white canes to various organizations across India

• Ambulance Van (Maruti Suzuki EECO 5 STR AC CNG) - Maa Madhuri Brij Varis Sewa Sadan, Apna Ghar Ashram, Puthkhurd, Delhi –Delhi I DO/NZ

The Maa Madhuri Brij Varis Sewa Sadan (MMBVSS) is a Society registered in the year 2000 with the objective to provide safe, secure and homely environment to the homeless, destitute, physically and mentally sick people and has a vision that no one should ever perish due to lack of help or medical support. There are two Apna Ghar Ashrams in Delhi located at Puthkhurd and Alipur, having residential capacity of 250 beds each. The Ashram at Puthkhurd was started in the year 2012 for males whereas the Alipur Ashram is for females. People from the streets, railway stations, bus stands of Delhi are brought to the Ashram and all necessities such as accommodation, medicine, food, clothing are provided to them free of cost. MMBVSS has 10 Ambulances for providing immediate medical services and support to the inmates of the Ashrams. The Ashram makes efforts to search the homes and families of the inmates and send them back after they recover from their sickness. Inmates whose families do not accept them are involved in the services of the organization. Every month, on an average, 40 homeless are brought to the Ashram and 14 persons are rehabilitated. On an average, Ashram treats 427 persons daily free of cost.

Funding of Rs 4,58,894/- has been provided for purchase of an Ambulance Van required to pick up the helpless, homeless and severely ill people from the streets and to take them to the Ashram or to different hospitals for treatment.

 Construction of Building for Senior Citizen or Old age bedridden persons - Navjeevan Trust, Kottayam – Kottayam DO/SZ

Navjeevan Trust was established by the Mr Thomas in the area of Panampalm, Kottayam in 1992 to cater to the needs of old age patients who are in the terminal stages of life and who have no one to support them in their homes. The main activity of the Trust continues to be rehabilitation of wandering psychiatric patients. These patients are brought to Navjeevan Bhavan by trust volunteers. The very next day they are taken to the hospital for treatment. Many patients recover and are sent back to their homes but those who are not welcomed back to their home, continue in the Bhavan as volunteers. Around 3700 such patients have been taken care, cured and rehabilitated so far. At present 210 mental patients and 25 permanently disabled patients are having nobody to support them and are being taken care by the Trust. They are running a Hospice where they take care of totally bedridden, elderly sick patients. These patients have no relatives to take care of them at home. Most of the patients are in the last stage of their life. They are providing food, residence, medical treatment and nursing facility free of cost. They are providing meals to about 5000 poor patients in three Government hospitals in Kottayam. They are providing approximately 1500 kg free rice to 100 families weekly in Villoonni and nearby area.

Funding of Rs 25,00,000/- has been provided for construction of day care home for elders in the Navjeevan Bhavan. It will be helpful for accommodation and rehabilitation of old age persons who are abandoned. The senior citizens will be brought to the day care centre and dropped back in the evening by using free ambulance facility of the Trust.

• 51 Seater Bus - Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai - MDO II/ WZ

Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai is a premier cancer care facility in India which has been at the forefront in the fight against cancer for the last 75 years. Tata Memorial Hospital is a Grant in Aid Institution under the Department of Atomic Energy, Government of India and it treats 60% of the cancer patients free of charge. Approximately, 200 new cases are registered here daily from all over the country. Advanced Centre of Treatment Research & Education in Cancer (ACTREC) is located at Kharghar, Navi Mumbai comprising of two arms, one for basic research and another for clinical research. The Centre is equipped with state of the art diagnostics and therapeutic facilities.

Funds of Rs 36,97,960 has been provided to Tata Memorial Hospital for purchase of 51 Seater Bus for transportation of cancer patients from Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai to Advanced centre for Treatment Research and Education in Cancer located at Navi Mumbai and back.

Three sets of water coolers with water purifiers - Ramakrishna Mission Ashram, Bhopal (Branch of Ramakrishna Mission, Belur Math, Howrah) :

Sri Ramakrishna Ashram is a spiritual organization having more than 170 branches in India and abroad. The Ashram does philanthropic activities in the field of education, medical, relief operations, preaching, spreading ethical and moral values and publication of Ramakrishna-Vivekananda literature. It runs a non-residential Higher Secondary School for 1100 students belonging to below poverty line and lower middle income group. The Ashram runs a physiotherapy unit for people belonging to economically backward class on no profit no loss basis.

Three sets of water coolers and water purifiers have been provided whichwill provide drinking water to economically weaker and tribal students coming from rural area of Bhopal.

• Construction of Building for Senior Citizen or Old age bedridden persons -Santhitheeram Charitable Trust – Thrissur DO/SZ

Santhitheeram Charitable Trust was established in the area of Kuttur, Trissur, Kerala to cater to the needs of old age patients who are in the terminal stages of life and who have no one to support them in their homes. They provide healthcare to the geriatric and terminally ill patients along with the Old Age Home facility and medical nursing care to the bedridden patients who need round the clock attention. They are also providing peaceful and comfortable environment along with spiritual, psychological and emotional support to the ailing ones so that they feel homely environment. They are having a 23 bedded charitable hospital and hospice for elderly people. Trust provides a unique facility for senior citizens, especially for those who are very old and have difficulty in attending regular hospital OPD, where the Doctors visit patients at their residences at a mutually agreed time.

They are running a Shanthitheeram Hospice where they take care of totally bedridden, elderly sick patients who have no relatives to look after and take care of them at home. Most of the patients are unmarried men and women, widows and widowers, suffering from stroke paralysis, Parkinsonism, dementia, nutritional deficiencies and other degenerative disease. They are providing food, residence, medical treatment and nursing facility at a concessional rate.Funds have been provided for construction of a small building with two floors for rehabilitation of Senior Citizens and old age destitute. In each floor, men and old women can live separately and common kitchen and prayer hall cum dining hall will be arranged for old age people.

• Artificial Limb for Life – Yuvak Pratishthan - MDO II/WZ

A NGO established in 1980 is working for various social casuses like medical, Sports, Education and Natural Calamities. They have developed a special sensitive patient centre management system where they serve poor, neglected and under privileged people. They provide Artificial Electronic Limbs to victims who have lost their limbs in terrorist attack or in railway/road accident or are physically handicapped by birth. Any disabled could visit for artificial limb and register his/her name without any appointment. For fitment of a limb or caliper, they have expert medical professionals. They have registered 39 patients for limbs, i.e Left/Right below and above knee and Right/left below and above elbow. Funds have been provided for purchase of Artificial Electronic Limbs which will be useful for physically handicapped people to live life like a normal person.

• Food distribution Vehicle - The Akshaya Patra Foundation – Jodhpur DO/ NZ : Akshaya Patra Foundation is a recognized NGO since 2000 and ranked 23rd among the top 100 NGOs in the world. This institution is dedicated to providing mid-day meal to children in Government Schools. The kitchens of the Foundation are ISO certified and ensures highquality food. The Foundation also helped to remove gender inequality by providing livelihood to thousands of women in many remote areas of the Country. Their decentralized kitchen model has provided a means of daily income to these women thereby empowering them. The food distribution vehicle will help them to provide balance diet to the under privileged children and reduce the dropout rate to an enormous extent because of hunger.

Funds have been provided for purchase of Food Distribution Vehicle to distribute mid-day meal to school children.

<u>Year 2013-14</u>

 Construction of Orphanage - Japatpara Sri Sri Nigamananda Saraswat Sevashram Society

Burdwan, Bardhman

Japatpara Sri Sri Nigamananda Saraswat Sevashram Society has been working for orphan children since 1988. The main activity of the Society is to provide shelter to the orphan children and also food, education, medicine, vocational training so that they can be independent. Construction of Orphanage will enable them to give accommodation to the orphans who are staying in a temporary cottage.

• Construction of Dining Hall and kitchen ,grill &compound wall for security - Kasturba Gandhi National Memorial Trust, Shimla DO

Kasturba Gandhi National Memorial Trust is a national Trust headquartered at Indore. It has 22 branches with more than 500 centers spread throughout the country. The Trust mainly works for the benefit of women and children who are from the disadvantaged sections of society. The Head quarter at Indore also has a Training Centre for sister workers who are engaged in their activities at village and state levels. The Institution is serving in Himachal Pradesh at two places – an orphanage for boys at Mall Shimla and one for girls at Durgapur Shimla. The construction of the dining hall and provision of furniture will enable them to enhance the standard of living of the girl children and also give them a decent place to eat.

• LIC Maruti EECO TSS VAN(7 seater) - Jai Ambey Sewa Samiti, Ajmer The organization was started in the year 1992 to ease the plight of those suffering from illnesses and unable to afford medicines. Subsequently in the year 2011 the Samiti could

construct their building with financial aid from a reputed social worker of the area Shri Jodharjji Laddha. In the last twenty years, the Samiti has provided medicines to poor patients ,conducted various eye camps, cancer detection camps ,blood donation camps etc The vehicle will also be used for conducting various camps such as eye camps, distributing food, school uniforms etc. in the surrounding areas.

• LIC vehicle for carrying mid-day meal - The Akshaya Patra Foundation, Jaipur Division

Akshaya Patra Foundation is a Pan India based Non-profit organization. The aim of the organization is to provide mid day meal to more than 1.4 million under privileged children every day in India with a vision of "No child in the country should be hungry and hunger should not be an obstacle for education". The Foundation provides mid day meal in 8500 schools across 9 states in India. The Akshaya Patra Foundation reaches out to 1.3 million children in 19 locations across 9 states of India to provide daily mid day meals. LIC vehicle is used for distribution of mid day meal to the students.

• Tirunelveli Social Service Society, Tirunelveli Division, Southern Zone– Construction of a Resource cum Training Centre for Women

Tirunelveli Social Service Society is one of the Non Profit Development Organisation established and maintained by Catholic Diocese of Palayamkottai to provide sustainable economic enhancement of the target people. The Organization has organized a large number of Women and marginal farmers into SHGs at Village, Panchayath, Block and District levels to play pro-active roles to ensure application of human rights, child rights, supplement family income etc. They have around 1200 women SHGs with 20000 women members. The training centre is to be utilized to enhance the level of knowledge, soft skills, attitude and vocational skills.

 Sevabharthi Balikasadanam, Kozhikode Division, Southern Zone - Construction of a building for housing destitute and orphan children

Seva Bharathi Balikasadanam is a voluntary service organization established in the year 1998 with an aim to provide assistance to and extend a helping hand to the needy sections of the society. The Society has been associated with providing shelter to the destitute, conduct of medical camps, blood donation and Ambulance service in Calicut Medical College as well as providing free food to the needy in the medical college. Presently the society is having 30 inmates and no fee is charged for taking care of them.

• Karunalayam Charitable Trust, Trivandrum Division, Southern Zone - Construction of a Kitchen and Store Room in home for mentally challenged and aged persons Karunalayam Charitable Trust is a non-government organization providing care for elderly orphaned and mentally unstable women. Started in 2003 they have been supporting the destitute and mentally disabled women by providing them shelter and medical treatment. The Trust picks the mentally challenged destitute women and girls from streets and railway stations and gives them proper treatment. Adequate education is provided to girls and medical treatment given to inmates wherever necessary through Dr. Jayaram of Trivandrum Medical Hospital. If necessary the inmates are sent to the nearby private Hospitals for treatment cost of which is borne by the Trust. The construction of a new building for kitchen will be a blessing for orphan inmates.

• Sree Moolam Shashtipurthy Smaraka Hindu Mahila Mandiram, Thiruvanathapuram Division, Southern Zone - Home for destitute children SMSS Hindu Mahila Mandiram, is a premier voluntary organization in Kerala which has entered its 93rd year of service to orphans/destitute girl children and women of South India.

The unit is designed to make the grownup children self reliant and creative and the elderly lead a secure and meaningful life, thereby enhancing the lives they lead. Mandiram – A

Home for orphan and destitute girls is the first unit started by the founder Smt. Chinnamma a renowned educationist of her time. The organization takes care of 100 girls between 5 to 20 years. The construction of children's cottage will enable them to provide better facilities and accommodate more number of girls.

• Saranaalayam Trust, Vellore Division, Southern Zone - Construction of Home for the orphaned and aged persons

The Institution was started in the year 2000 by Sri Subash Chandran by adopting two children who lost their parents due to AIDS. Timely help from a lorry driver to pursue his education at Good Samaritan Medical Institute of Science of Technology, Vellore motivated him to start the orphanage. The Institute is running an orphanage for poor orphans and aged persons. They provide free food, education, medical care, clothes and other help to the inmates. Their aim is to bring holistic development in the life of orphan children and provide care to the abandoned children. All the children are sent to school and many of them are pursuing higher education. Construction of the building will provide a proper Home for these people with minimum basic amenities

Year 2012-2013

• Construction of home for the aged - The Poreyahat Holy Family Society Home for the Aged, Tilkamanjhi

The society is actively engaged in social work in Bhagalpur city during the last 35 years. Their qualified social workers have come across many elderly people who are neglected by their own families and thus have become homeless and they are working to provide shelter and basic necessities to such persons. They have established schools in vernacular languages to impart knowledge to the poor in villages. Construction of home for the aged will provide residential facilities for 50 senior citizens.

<u>Year 2011-2012</u>

• LIC Ambulance - Paramshantidham Vridhasram Trust, Thane DO

The Ashram is running its activities for the last 22 years and is situated in Tolaja ,MIDC. Intially there were only 4 persons in the ashram which has now risen to 72 and ashram is providing services of lodging and boarding to all of them. LIC Ambulance will help in taking old and disabled persons for regular health check up or treatment in any emergency.

Year 2010-2011

• LIC Food Distribution Vehicle - Akshaya Patra foundation, Bhillai under Raipur Division

Akshaya Patra Foundation has taken up implementation of Midday Meal Programme of Chattisgarh Region and is providing midday meal to the under privileged students studying in 133 schools of Bhilai. The objective is that no child in India shall be deprived of education because of hunger. LIC Food Distribution Vehicle for Mid-Day Meal Programme will reach out to 30000 Students in Government schools.

• LIC Construction of kitchen, dining room in residential hostel building -Snehatheeram, Kollam, Thiruvananthpuram Snehatheeram was set up in September 2002 and aims at providing shelter for the mentally challenged destitute women. They have initiated various activities like prayer, yoga, library, newspaper reading sessions, soap making, tailoring, horticulture and gardening, etc for the mental and physical health of their inmates. The project is aimed at relief of poverty and distress and offering psychiatric rehabilitation to the mentally depressed. LIC construction of kitchen, dining room in residential hostel building will be used for these women.

• LIC Construction of medical unit - Little sisters of the poor- Home of for the aged, Bangalore

This is a charitable institution devoted to taking care of the aged and destitute. The Little Sisters of the Poor run Homes for the Aged cater to the needs of the aged poor, 60 years and above irrespective of caste and creed. They have at present 120 such elderly people who have been abandoned and have no means of livelihood. In India they have thirteen such homes and the Bangalore Centre is serving as Mother House for the other Branches. LIC construction of medical unit will enable them to provide better services.

• LIC Construction of Observation Home for HIV infected Children - District Probation & After Care Association, Satara DO

This institute has been working since 1941 for rehabilitation of orphan children and the children in conflict with law where they provide food, shelter, clothes educational facility and medical facility. In addition to above they are providing for rehabilitation of HIV positive children, and their numbers are increasing since last two years. LIC construction of first floor will enable them to accommodate 35 more HIV Positive Children.

Year 2009-2010

• LIC Library cum Computer Centre – Muanna In (Boy's Home), Mizoram under Silchar Division

This is a Orphanage for Boys where education as well as food is provided free of cost i.e.100 % fees is waived for all inmates. LIC Library cum Computer Centre will provide better study facilities to approximately 300 students.

LIC School - Alayaran Anath Ashram School, Kokrajhar under Bongaigaon Division This NGO started with a noble mission to bring up the children whose parents lost their lives during the violence erupted over a long period for Bodoland movement. At present altogether 217 Students are prosecuting their studies in various classes up to IV Standard and they stay in Hostels within the campus. LIC School will enable them to increase the capacity as well as to impart higher level of education.

• LIC Hostel - RAWA Academy, Mancheswar under Bhubaneshwar Division

This institution is doing pioneering work in the field of rehabilitation of the parentless, deserted and destitute children. Besides, it has started a Healthcare Centre to provide treatment to the poor and terminally sick patients through alternative systems of treatment such as Microvita, Acupuncture, Naturopathy, etc. LIC Hostel will facilitate rehabilitation of around 400 students.

• LIC Kitchen - Akshaya Patra Foundation, Puri under Bhubaneswar Division

The Akshaya Patra Foundation came into being to address two of the most immediate challenges of India ? hunger and education by providing unlimited, wholesome food to attract children to schools, retain them and then focus on children?s holistic development. The ultimate goal is to ensure that no child in India is hungry and every child gets access to good health, wholesome food and schooling and LIC Kitchen will facilitate to accomplish the above goal.

• LIC Bus - India Vision Foundation, New Delhi under Delhi Division III

This organization is started in Tihar prison fifteen years back and at present they are reaching out to more than 2000 beneficiaries everyday through their various intervention programs in

the areas of education, vocational training and life skill training. LIC bus will be utilized for the children of prisoners to take them to exposure trips for enhancing their knowledge and providing them an opportunity to see the outside world.

• LIC Roof top Solor Photovoltic System - Bharat Vikas Parishad Charitable Trust, Ludhiana under Ludhiana Division This is a Charitable Trust who work for the benefit of physically handicapped persons through their various educational, vocational and health projects. LIC Roof top Solor Photovoltic System will meet their electricity requirements for the various projects run by them e.g. Workshop for manufacture of artificial limbs for physically handicapped persons, Polio Corrective Surgery Hospital, Policlinic being run for economically weaker sections of society, etc.

• LIC Bus - Corrections India, Pampady under Kottayam Division

This is a non-profit organization which aims at the prevention, control and correction through moral teaching and rehabilitation. It is a special home for prisoner's children where they provide best education and care. LIC Bus will provide for transportation of 65 children to the school.

• LIC Vocational Training and Academic Centre - Sree Ram Krishna Prema Bihar, Khorip under Howrah Division

LIC Vocational Training and Academic Centre will provide in upbringing of around 212 orphan children, helping the poor, destitute and distressed people from rural area.

- LIC Building for Old Destitute People International Brotherhood Mission, Dibrugarh (Assam) under Jorhat Division LIC Building will provide home for old destitute people who are carefully brought up under loving care of the management of the mission.
- LIC Orphanage Paramanand Mission, Burdwan under Asansol Division This is a philanthropic organization which renders various social welfare services to the economically backward section of the society. LIC Orphanage will provide home to 252 orphan and destitute children.
- LIC HIV/AIDs Rehabilitation Centre Snehadeep Holy Cross Community Care Centre, Hazaribag under Hazaribag Division LIC HIV/AIDs Rehabilitation Centre is established for the care support of HIV/AIDs patient. Until today, over 1000 cases are registered and daily average of 15 patients are treated in this centre.

• LIC Home - Akshaya's Helping in H.E.L.P. Trust under Madurai Division

LIC is providing home to the Trust which is safe/centralized place for the uncared, left on the roads, an environment for rehabilitation and peaceful place for the abandoned elderly people in their last days. It is a new initiative to provide free infrastructure in a remote village to neglected people in distress, aggravated by mental illness and old age.

 LIC Clinic and Ambulance – Bethamy Home, Kallayam under Thiruvananthapuram Division

Under the Visakhapatnam Division, Akshaya Patra Foundation, Visakhapatnam under Visakhapatnam Division LIC Food Distribution Vehicle will provide Mid Day Meal to students in government schools which is organized by Akshaya Patra Foundation in partnership with Central and respective State Government of India, situated in around 60-80 kms area of Visakhapatnam. It is the largest Mid Day Meal Program in the World.

• LIC Learning Centre - SOS Children's Villages of India, Bhuj under Rajkot Division

The Learning Centre comprises of a Library, a Music room and a computer Lab within the village area. This would provide the children easy accessibility to new learning aids and computer literacy which is essential in steering the children towards fulfilling their goals and becoming self-reliant individuals. LIC Learning Centre will not only facilitate development of their inherent talent but also give opportunity to remain competitive. About 150 children will be benefited with this support.

• LIC Learning Centre - SOS Children's Village, Latur under Aurangabad Division The Learning Centre comprises of a Library, a Music room and a computer Lab within the village area. This would provide the children easy accessibility to new learning aids and computer literacy which is essential in steering the children towards fulfilling their goals and becoming self-reliant individuals. LIC Learning Centre will not only facilitate development of their inherent talent but also give opportunity to remain competitive. About 122 children will be benefited with this support.

• LIC Vocational Training Centre - Navjeevan Centre, Kalyan under Thane Division This Project is for upliftment and rehabilitation primarily of children of commercial sex workers who are undergoing residential training at the Navjeevan Village, Murbad. LIC Vocational Training Centre shall help in equipping these children with skills and knowledge so that proper rehabilitation and integration in the main stream is possible.
