GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

Re: Tender for ARC of Civil, Carpentry, Painting and Sanitary work at Divisional office Kanpur Including Branches & it's Properties under D.O Kanpur

1. This annual rate contract is meant for undertaking (i) Repairing works (ii) Renovation works (iii) Addition & Alteration works etc. in Divisional Office building & its Branches including properties under D.O., Kanpur and each job will be executed under specific work order for any item/ items of work (mentioned in the attached schedule) irrespective of its/ their quantity.
2. **In Envelop no.(1) ----Keep the payment of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five (DD/MR)**
In Envelop No.(2) -----Keep The Technical BID Document

In Envelop No. (3)----keep The Financial BID Document
All above three envelop in a single main envelop
3. The contractors are to quote on percentage rate basis i.e. Percentage Below/ At Par/ Percentage Above in the attached schedule of rates in figures and in words, otherwise tender will not be entertained. **No any other condition in other envelop or in the tender will be accepted**
4. All quantities unless otherwise specified will be measured net finish and are to include for all cutting / wastage.
5. The materials and specifications of all kinds of works must be such as to comply with the LIC Standard Specifications unless otherwise mentioned as per latest IS specifications and to the entire satisfaction of the Engineer or his representative.
6. Cement will have to be arranged by the contractor as per approved brand in Annexure - "U".
7. LIC reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever and will not be bound to accept either the lowest tender or any of the tenders. LIC also reserves the right to delete any item/ items of the tender thereof.
8. Rate to include charges for materials, labour, scaffolding, shuttering, curing and all the taxes as applicable . **GST will be payable on gross value of work**

Other Taxes at source shall be deducted as per rule stipulated by government/ financial act etc. Making good the damages to match with existing finish, removal of all debris from site, shifting/ removing of furniture if necessary within the office/ Qtrs. and keeping/ placing the same in earlier position covering of furniture etc. All rates should hold good irrespective of floors and heights. Works and measurements will be followed as per IS codes.

9. The contractor shall take all necessary safety precautions such as use of safety belts and other relevant equipment's for the safety of his work force during execution of the work so as to avoid any mishap. Further, the contractor shall be responsible for any damages caused / done due to accident during progress of the work. In every case in which by virtue of the provisions of Section 52, Sub - section (I) of the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1925, LIC is obliged to pay compensation to a workman employed by the contractor in execution of the works, LIC will recover from the contractor, the amount of the compensation so paid, and without prejudice to the rights of LIC under Section 12, Sub - Section (2) of the said Act, LIC shall be at liberty to recover such amount or any part thereof by deducting it from the Security Deposit or from any sum due by the LIC to the contractor whether under this contract or otherwise.
10. **Notwithstanding the above, the contractor shall have to arrange for necessary Insurance cover that are imperative for the respective jobs and premium thereof will have to be borne by the contractor, i.e. Workmen's Compensation & Contractor All risk policy including Third-Party Insurance.** Both the insurance policies of requisite amounts shall remain in force till the contract period or upto the period of extension, if any. LIC shall not be bound to contest any claim made against it under section 12, Sub- section (I) of the said Act, except on the written request of the contractor and upon his/ their giving to LIC full security for which LIC might become liable in consequence of contesting such claims.
11. Work shall comply with latest local Municipal Regulations and carried - out to our entire satisfaction. If due to violation of local Regulations by the contractor, LIC has to incur any expenses (e.g. to meet any claims etc.), the same will be deducted from the contractor's bill.
12. Contractors should visit the site before quoting the rates for the works.
13. Actual quantities shall be measured for payment on the basis of rates quoted. The quantities are to be read in conjunction with the specification and conditions of contract and the rates quoted shall be for doing all works as per specification complete, whether the same are reiterated or not. Unless otherwise incorporated with the tender as supplementary item/items, the rates quoted shall be inclusive of all costs and charges including arrangement for water supply to be incurred by the successful tenderer and all temporary works in connection thereto shall be deemed to have been provided unless otherwise definitely called up with the tender. In case the job necessitates barricading on the footpath for the reason of security, the contractor shall have to arrange the same at his cost and risk.

14. For wall painting on existing or new sand cement plastered surfaces, the mode of measurement will be net and no co-efficient factor will be considered.
15. While doing the painting jobs, the Contractor shall ensure that after completion of the job, floor walls and doors are cleaned properly without asking any extra payment
16. Any extra item/ items that may be found necessary during the execution of work and not originally provided for in the schedule may be paid based on the rate analysis for Extra/deviated items of work, co-efficient of labour and material wherever applicable shall be as given with latest edition of C.P.W.D rate analysis. Where such co-efficient are not available in C.P.W.D., rate analysis is to actual labour / materials involved and recorded Suptdg. Engineer/ Executive Engineer in executing the item shall be considered with an addition thereto to 15% to cover profit and other overhead charges. Incase of extra item/ items, contractor will deliver to the competent authority for verification of rates within seven days of taking up such work in hand alongwith actual vouchers.
17. The works must be completed in all respects within the specified time from the date of receiving the work order.
18. **LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:-** If the contractor fails to complete the work within the stipulated time period or within properly extended period of time and Executive Engineer certifies in writing that in his opinion the same ought reasonably so to have been completed the contractor shall pay or allow the employer to recover an amount equal to 1% per week of the tendered amount for the period during which the said works shall so remain incomplete subject to maximum of 10% of the contract sum. In case liquidated damages in accordance with the above provision accrue to maximum limit of 10% of the tendered amount. LIFE INSURANCE CORPORATION OF INDIA shall be at liberty to rescind the contract and to get it completed entirely at the risk and cost of the contractor through any agency if decides to appoint. All extra expenditure incurred shall be recoverable from the money due to contractor or lying to his credit with

19. LIFE INSURANCE CORPORATION OF INDIA against the present or any other contract. For urgent nature of jobs, L.D. rate will be decided mutually.
20. **The rates quoted by the tenderer must hold good throughout the currency of the contract and during the extended period if any. It may please be noted that in case of urgency/ priority, if the lowest approved contractor is not available for any reasons, then the work will be offered to other tenderers i.e. L2, L3, L4.....etc at the same rates. LIC reserves the right to entrust the work to any other enlisted contractors available at the lowest approved rate for the particular group.**
21. **The contractors should make it a point& ensure that his representative should be made available to the O.S Department of Divisional Office everyday during office hours for receiving work orders/ instructions maintenance job and also , in case of his tender is accepted.**
22. If the contractor his authorized representative fails to attend the office for consecutive 03 (Three) days to receive verbal instructions / work order or if the contractor, upon receiving written or verbal work order, does not undertake the work within the next 48 hours or immediately as instructed in case of emergency, the Sr.Divisional Manager/Manager (OS) shall have liberty to cancel the work order and employ other agency to get the works done and the difference in total cost thereof shall be deducted from the contractors bills or any other works such lying with LIC without making any reference to the contractor.
23. The Contractor should quote rate keeping in view that the salvage material would be taken away by the Contractor after proper checking by the department concerned and obtaining necessary gate-pass etc. However salvage value for replaced old materials of wooden, MS, aluminum items will be deducted at the rate of 10% (Ten percent) of the value of work done of respective items . Unserviceable materials, all sorts of debris etc will have to removed from the work site to Contractors own dump at the Contractors cost and risk immediately after completion of the work or even during the progress of the work in case of huge accumulation as per instruction of the Engineer-in-charges, failing which LIC reserves the right to remove the Debris through any agency and deduct the cost thereof from the Contractor's bill without any reference to him.(**For any other item having salvage value and not covered above, the salvage value will be decided as per market rates at the sole discretion of Engineering in-charge**)

If any defect is noticed within six months after completion of the work, the contractor has to rectify the same at his cost and risk, failing which LIC reserves the right to get the defects rectified through any agency and deduct the cost thereof from the contractor's bill.

24. The Competent Authority may due to adequate reason as he thinks fit from time to time, terminate the particular work awarded to the contractor and get it completed through another agency at his risk and cost and take any other penal action as deemed fit. The contractor should then leave the buildings in a decent and workable condition, failing which LIC reserves the right to take any action as deemed fit against the contractor.

25. Unserviceable materials, all sorts of debris etc. will have to be removed from the work site to contractor's own dump at the contractor's cost and risk immediately after completion of the work or even during the progress of work in case of huge accumulation as per instructions of the Engineer – in – charge, failing which LIC reserves the right to remove the debris through any agency and deduct the cost thereof from the contractor's bill without any reference to them and may even impose penalty as deemed fit.

26. **MINIMUM WAGES ACT:-** The contractor shall pay rates of wages and observe hours of work and conditions of employment according to existing rules under Minimum Wages Act. Further, it shall be the contractor's responsibility to ensure that he pay his workmen wages which are not lower than the minimum prescribed by the Union Government and State Govt. from time to time.

27. **MEASUREMENTS :**

- (i) The Contractor shall enter measurement of works executed in the prescribed format issued by LIC.
- (ii) Part or final payment shall be released only after necessary measurement sheets are submitted by the Contractor duly verified/ entered in MB by Corporation's Engineer.

- (iii) Contractor shall ensure that the method of measurement is in accordance with the Contract. The precision in measurement shall be as laid down in IS 1200. Any point of disagreement between the Contractor and the concerned Engineer pertaining to measurements shall be promptly referred to for the decision of the Competent Authority. For painting, no coefficient shall be considered for payment.
- (iv) Extra/ deviated items shall be recorded by the Contractor only after duly authorized by the Corporation's Engineer.
- (v) The work shall be preferably measured in the same sequence as executed. The measurements shall be signed at the end of each session of measurements on the day of recording, as the case may be, by both the parties (i.e. Measurer / Contractor / Site Engineer).

28. CONCEALED WORK : The Contractor shall give due notice to the Site Engineer whenever any work is to be buried in the earth, concrete or in the bodies of walls or otherwise, becoming hidden later on , in order that the work may be inspected and correct dimensions taken before such concealment, in default whereof the same shall , at the opinion of the Employer be either opened up for measurements at Contractor's expense or no payment made for such work. Should any dispute or difference arise after the execution of any work as to measurements etc or other matter, which cannot be conveniently tested or checked, the notes of the Site Engineer shall be examined and the decision of Chief Engineer shall be binding on both the parties.

29. The monthly bills of day to day works of Annual rate contract are to be submitted by the contractor by 7th of the next month. Further, the bills of major works of ARC are to be submitted within 30 days from the date of completion of work. If they fail to do so then their claims are not liable for settlement unless approved by the Competent Authority.

30. **CONTRACT LABOUR ACT:-** If/wherever applicable, The contractor shall be responsible to register themselves under the contract labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970 and rules thereunder and must comply with and carry - out all the provisions and obligations under the said Act and rules and furnish all information to employer as may be required by it and shall also indemnify the Employer against any penalties / claims etc. arising from any default on their part.

31. Materials used in the work should be from the following list of principal makes/brands. In case of non-availability of these makes/brands, Chief Engineer shall allow materials licensed by B.I.S. to bear "ISI" monogram at par with principal makes. They will be allowed to use after approval by Chief Engineer subject to price adjustment.

32. **WATER & ELECTRICITY:-**

The recovery for use of water and electricity if provided by the corporation shall be as under :

- (i) The charges towards use of water and electricity shall be recovered @ 0.50% of gross value of work done from the bill of Contractor.
- (ii) The charges towards use of either water or electricity shall be recovered @ 0.25% of gross value of work done from the bill of contractor.
